

Jack Hibbs Urges Christians to Intercede as Alarming California Bill Advances

Pastor Jack Hibbs is calling on Christians to intercede as the threatening California AB-495 Bill has passed the state legislature and is now expected to be signed by Gov. Gavin Newsom.

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In a post on social media, Hibbs wrote:

I AM CALLING UPON ALL CALIFORNIANS TO PLEASE PRAY NOW AS AB-495 HAS ARRIVED ON NEWSOM'S DESK AS OF 4pm. TODAY.

If he signs it into law we together will have him wear it all the way to his presidential run in 2028.

Could the events surrounding Charlie Kirk's tragic death carry a profound prophetic significance?

Amanda Grace pointed out in a recent livestream that Kirk's memorial service numerically echoed the patterns of 9-11 that we've seen displayed throughout the year. Grace notes, "The day of Charlie's actually on a date that contains 9-11. And this has been a continuing theme all year."

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Grace connected the prophetic alignment of dates with the Jewish calendar, observing that September 10 corresponded to Elul 17, while the key decision that led to the assassination may have occurred around Elul 13. She connects this to a word she received earlier this year in February, which warned, "For the super predator is rearing up for a strike within your nation of America." This alignment, she asserts, reveals the enemy's attempt to orchestrate both tragedy and generational harm: "The enemy literally attempted to open a generational door against the children as assignment [needs to be] nullified."

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Adding further weight to this prophetic timeline, the day after the memorial marked the beginning of Rosh Hashanah, or the Feast of Trumpets, which opens a year-long window extending to Rosh Hashanah 2026, coinciding with September 11 of next year. Grace explains, "So we're entering a year, we went from the memorial service that happened on a date that contains 9-11 in it, to Rosh Hashanah, which is a window of a year that then comes to Rosh Hashanah 9-11 on 2026." The timing underscores the spiritual significance of this season and calls believers to vigilance and prayer.

In the midst of grief, forgiveness becomes a crucial spiritual weapon. Erica Kirk, addressing the public so soon after the tragedy, declared, "On the cross our Savior said, 'Father forgive them, for they know not what they do...' That young man, I forgive him." Grace emphasizes the power of this act: "Forgiveness slams the door shut on the enemy to bitterness and resentment, which brings captivity, which brings

bondage...Forgiveness is for your soul. It is for you to be in right standing before the Father.” In doing so, Erica Kirk not only honors her faith but also blocks the enemy from gaining a foothold in generational and spiritual realms.

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Drawing on Acts 9:10–19, Grace likens the Church today to Ananias, called to intercede even for those who have caused harm. Saul, once a persecutor, became Paul, a chosen instrument for God. “We have a chance to cause the scales through Christ Jesus to fall from the eyes of a generation,” she says.

In a season marked by prophetic events, Grace calls for humility, prayer and intercession. The Church, like Ananias, is positioned to witness the transformation of hearts and the reversal of evil schemes. Let’s march toward that calling.

Jonathan Cahn: The Prophetic Message of Charlie Kirk’s

Death and America's Redemptive Turning Point

The assassination of Charlie Kirk has sent shockwaves through America, prompting questions about why it happened and what it signifies for the country. Best-selling author, Jonathan Cahn, delivered a new prophetic message regarding Kirk's assassination and what this means for the future of America.

In this latest video, Cahn emphasized the significance of the location where Kirk died: Utah Valley University, in Orem, Utah. "Could the place in which it happened be significant?" he asked. Cahn explains that the word "Orem," derived from Old English and Norse, translates to "serpent" or "dragon," linking it to the great red dragon described in Revelation 12. "The great dragon was thrown down to the earth, the serpent of old, who was called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world," Cahn cited. He sees the shooting as an act of the dragon, a spiritual enemy waging war against believers.

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Cahn discusses how Charlie Kirk himself was also a symbolic figure in this spiritual conflict. Noting that "Kirk means the church," Cahn said, "The church came to the place of the dragon, and the dragon struck the church." Kirk was a staunch defender of the gospel, Israel and the next generation, making him a prime target for spiritual forces seeking to undermine God's purposes in America.

Comparing Kirk's death to the failed assassination attempt on Donald Trump in Butler, Pennsylvania, Cahn suggests divine

intention behind both events. "Why did God save Trump from an assassination attempt? Because God had a purpose. And for that same reason, he took Charlie Kirk," he said. He explained that while Trump's life was preserved for political and prophetic missions, Kirk's death serves a spiritual purpose: to awaken the church and spark revival.

Anne Graham Lotz, daughter of the late Rev. Billy Graham, recently discussed in an interview with CBN News how current events happening right now reflect God's prophetic end-times plan.

Lotz emphasizes that Christians must know "what time it is" in human history. "We need to know where we are on that timeline... to be prepared for what comes next," she explains, comparing it to having a schedule in daily life.

Reflecting on the recent assassination of conservative leader Charlie Kirk, Lotz describes the tragedy as both shocking and spiritually significant. "Except a grain of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abides alone. But if it falls into the ground and dies, it springs forth much fruit," Lotz says.

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She believes Kirk's untimely death has sparked a wave of spiritual awakening. "I wonder if God... allowed him to fall into the ground... because from his death is springing up just thousands of people's lives who are being impacted and changed," Lotz says.

Israel also plays a central role in Lotz's understanding of the end times. She points to Jesus' parable of the fig tree, noting that it represents Israel: "The fig tree in scriptures represented Israel... the generation that sees that will be the last generation." Lotz emphasizes the prophetic significance of Israel's reestablishment as a nation on May 14, 1948. "The

descendants of our ancient people living in our ancient homeland, speaking the ancient language, using the ancient currency... that was a phenomena," she says. She argues that modern Israel fulfills God's covenant promises, despite resistance from some who dismiss it as merely a political creation.

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Lotz also connects the revival and Israel's restoration to the fulfillment of biblical signs. Referring to Matthew 24, she says, "Jesus gave the signs that would determine the last generation... When you see them increasing in intensity, then you know the end is near." From wars and natural disasters to social unrest, he describes the current "chaos... increasing in frequency and intensity" as the birth pains leading to Christ's return.

She reassures Christians that the end times are a message of hope, not fear. Drawing on Revelation, she emphasizes that Jesus' ultimate triumph over evil will prevail. "Good overcomes evil and love overcomes hate... there is an eternity... there will be a heaven where we're going to live forever with Jesus," Lotz says.

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Ultimately, Lotz contends that Charlie Kirk's death, the spiritual awakening on campuses and the miraculous restoration of Israel are signs that we may be living in the final generation. She concludes, "If Jesus were to come in the next five minutes, he would be coming for me and he would be coming

for you... we need to make sure today we're right with God."

The sound of the shofar has echoed through history, reminding God's people of His power, His covenant and His coming kingdom. At Mount Sinai, Scripture records that a trumpet from heaven sounded as the Creator broke into the world to reveal Himself to Israel. Centuries later, the Bible declares that Jesus will return again at the sound of the trumpet.

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Rabbi Schneider emphasizes that the Feast of Trumpets is more than a Jewish holiday. "The proof that these holy days that are contained in the Hebrew Scriptures are important to you, if you're a Gentile Christian today, is the fact that Jesus timed His earthly ministry to God's holy days," he says. "If Jesus was crucified on Passover, buried on the next holy day called Unleavened Bread, rose on the next holy day called the

Feast of Firstfruits, then gave us His Spirit on Pentecost, which is called in Hebrew Shavuot, that should tell us there's something about these holy days—that everything that God is doing, He's timing to them."

These appointed times carry prophetic significance. This celebration marks the beginning of the seventh month, Tishrei, a holy time of reflection and preparation. "In the seventh month, on the first of the month, you shall have a rest, a reminder by blowing of trumpets," Schneider reads from Leviticus 23:24. "The first thing that we need to do if we want to take this seriously is we want to stop... We have to 'selah.' We have to pause. Why do we have to pause? To create a window for God to speak to us, to create a window for God to impart something to us."

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As Schneider points out, the shofar itself is a divine reminder. "This is what Teruah means—trumpets or blowing. The key is that it's a reminder," Schneider says. "It reminds us... it elevates us to remember that God broke into the the Creator broke into the world and revealed Himself to Israel at Mount Sinai as a cosmic shofar, as the divine shofar blew from heaven." Israel was commanded to prepare for this moment: "The Lord told Moses, 'Say to Israel, I want you to consecrate yourself for three days, because on the third day you're going to meet me.'"

The shofar blast points not only backward to Sinai but forward to the return of Messiah. Schneider declares, "The trumpet sounded, and the trumpet, beloved, has sounded again as we've

entered into the Feast of Trumpets, and God wants you to know that the Creator is alive. He's watching over you and I. We're going to give an account to Him. And Yeshua's going to come back with the sounding of the trumpet, and He's going to reward every man according to what he has done. So let's prepare our hearts and get ready to meet the Creator."

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The continuity of Israel's story testifies to God's faithfulness. Despite dispersion and persecution, the Jewish people have retained their identity and remembrance of God's covenant. And just as the shofar once marked God's revelation at Sinai, it will herald the day when Jesus returns in glory. The Feast of Trumpets calls every believer to pause, consecrate their hearts, and prepare for the trumpet that will announce the King's return.
