

Taylor Swift and Travis Kelce Are Engaged: How Does Faith Factor Into Their 'Love Story'?

Pop star Taylor Swift said yes to boyfriend Travis Kelce.

Swift announced her engagement to the Kansas City Chiefs tight end on Instagram with the caption, "Your English teacher and your gym teacher are getting married."

In a deeply moving vision, Rabbi Kirt Schneider recounts being among 200 worshippers, all eyes fixed on Messiah and passionately calling for His return. Amid the anointed worship, the Spirit allowed him to see beyond the sanctuary into the streets—a world weighed down by fear, responsibility and spiritual oppression. In that moment, the Lord spoke: "What you have that those outside need is hope."

As we draw closer to the return of Christ,

what we need most is the hope found in Jesus that we can cling to as the world continues to get shakier during this time. Jesus Himself warned that before His return the world would resemble the days of Noah and Lot: people living as though nothing would change, while immorality and violence pervaded society.

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Schneider explains that at Jesus' first coming and as the gospel spread, demonic influence over cultures was restrained. But as society increasingly rejects biblical values and enters a post-Christian era, those same forces of darkness have returned with

greater intensity.

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Referencing Matthew 12:43–45, Schneider illustrates this principle:

“When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, it passes through dry places seeking rest but finds none... Then it goes and brings with itself seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there. And the last state of that man is worse than the first. So shall it be also with this evil generation.”

He clarifies that Jesus wasn't speaking only about individuals, but about entire cultures:

the demons that were expelled at Christ's first coming will return to humanity, even fiercer than before. The moral and spiritual gains made when the gospel first spread are being undone, and now the darkness is reasserting itself. This intensifying spiritual oppression is evident in modern culture, from moral decay to public displays mocking biblical faith, showing just how far humanity has drifted.

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Schneider stresses that there's no political or social solution that can reverse the tide; our only hope is the return of Christ. Jesus' final words in Revelation weren't given just for theological debate but

to prepare believers to endure until His coming. The world's current turbulence is only the "birth pangs" of what's ahead. Schneider recalls another vision where, after a grueling military assignment at sea, an officer warned him: "If you think the last assignment was hard, the next one will be even harder." Likewise, life on earth will become increasingly difficult, making it vital for believers to be spiritually anchored.

The call to action is urgent: Are we ordering our steps after the Lord daily? Are we rooted in prayer and worship morning and night? Only a life tethered to Jesus will stand firm as the end times intensify.

Schneider closes with a promise and hope: Jesus is coming soon. The "blessed hope" is not

just doctrine; it is the ultimate fulfillment of every soul's deepest hunger. Believers are urged to join the cry of the Spirit and the Bride: "Come, Lord Jesus."

Did Moses Leave a Message? Jonathan Cahn Breaks Down Sinai Discovery

Jonathan Cahn, New York Times best-selling author and prophetic teacher, is pointing to a remarkable discovery

he says connects directly to Moses and the Bible.

For years, he says, "Some critics claim the name Moses, which has a Hebrew meaning, does not even appear in the Egyptian language. And for years, critics of the Bible have charged that Moses didn't exist. Just legend. They'll say there's no archaeological evidence that connects Moses in the Bible to, for instance, Sinai."

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Cahn explains why skeptics have often dismissed the biblical account: "There's nothing found in Sinai where Moses spent much of his life. Now, because Moses spent

much of his life in the wilderness, we might not expect there to be inscriptions. But they made this charge that there was nothing for ages and ages."

According to Cahn, that just changed. "An inscription was found in the Sinai Peninsula, the very place where Moses would have been. And the words were etched on the walls of an ancient Egyptian mine in the Sinai desert. And the one who wrote the words, the archaeologists identified it as a Semitic person. That's as in Jewish or Israelite. The language of the inscriptions appear to be an early form of a Semitic language closely related to biblical Hebrew. They use[d] high resolution images and 3D scans."

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Nearby, other carvings added to the intrigue. "Near the inscription, they found what appears to be the name 'EL' in Hebrew, the name of God, the God of Israel. And there's also what appears to be the name of an Egyptian goddess, Hathor, but the name of Hathor is defaced, scratched out, but the name of EL, God, remains."

Even more striking are the themes recorded in the inscriptions that point back to the biblical account of the Israelites' time in Egypt. "The inscriptions around there also speak of slavery and they speak of slave masters. And here it's in an Egyptian mine."

As James Kaddis noted,
recent reports reveal
artificial intelligence
programs across the
internet claiming to be
Jesus Christ himself,
offering prayer,
guidance and even
confessions—blurring
the line between divine
truth and human-created
imitation. As Kaddis
warns, “Whether or not
you see it or whether
or not you can perceive
it to be the case, we
are looking at the
spirit of Antichrist on
full display.”

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The term “anti” in
Antichrist does not
mean “against,” but

“instead of.” These AI chatbots are not merely imitating Christ—they are assuming His role. People are taking a tool, like AI, and “they are now beginning to use it to put into effect the spirit of Antichrist,” he says. Programs like AI Jesus, Ask Jesus and Text with Jesus have already gained thousands of users, with one app reporting 30,000 active users within just three days. These programs are designed for profit, relying on advertising and premium subscriptions while presenting themselves as divine guides.

A recent study by Anne Verhof, a professor of philosophy, highlights the dangers of these chatbots. Responses on key spiritual questions vary widely depending

on programming, algorithms or user-selected faith traditions. For instance, when asked if hell exists, AI responses differed dramatically: "AI Jesus replied, 'Yes, there is a hell. It is a place of eternal torment and suffering where the souls of those who have rejected God and his teachings will go,'" while another AI softened the response, saying, "The concept of hell can be quite a heavy topic. God's desire is for all people to come to him and experience his love and grace." Unlike God's Word, which is absolute, AI adapts based on popularity or coding, essentially rewriting spiritual truth.

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Even some churches are using AI to generate sermons, replacing the guidance of the Holy Spirit with machine-generated messages. As Kaddis warns, "The major problem... is the fact that a chatbot cannot be led by the Holy Spirit." Spiritual discernment, insight and guidance come only from God. Just as we see the rise of false prophecies and false teachings rise during the end times, AI acting as God can take us straight into that pit of deception. Jesus promised His Spirit would teach and guide believers into all truth. Leaning on AI instead of the Spirit echoes the original rebellion in Genesis. Adam and Eve sought knowledge apart from God, and humanity today risks building a modern Tower of Babel by leaning on AI to replace divine

guidance.

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The solution is a return to God's abundance and guidance. Walking in obedience to His Word connects believers to unlimited spiritual provision and wisdom. "Instead of going to the fake, let's go to the real. Instead of leaning on that which simply is a tool that man created, why don't we go to the Spirit of God that was designed in order to minister to us," Kaddis reminds us.

True discernment requires a personal relationship with God, prayer and attentiveness to His Word—something AI can never replicate.

"There is a responsibility even in the midst of chaos. And so [Jesus] says. 'I want you to make disciples,'" Evans

continues. “Your engagement beyond your individual life and your family and your churches is strategic for the culture.”

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It is unclear right now as to whether or not Evans will pick up his pastoral role again at Oak Cliff Bible Fellowship.

Victory Over Major Lawsuit

Grand Canyon University is celebrating their victory after defeating a huge lawsuit with the Federal Trade Commission (FTC).

As Fox News noted, the school, which is the largest Christian University in America, provided an update that the FTC dropped the suit against them. Previously, the FTC sued the school, its president Brian Mueller, and their marketer Grand Canyon Education Inc. for “deceptive advertising and engaged in illegal telemarketing.”

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The FTC said that the university misguided

students seeking a doctoral program about the length of time an accelerated program would take, their status as a nonprofit, and calling prospective students who did not desire to be contacted.

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The school's president, Brian Mueller, said that the charges dropped marks the finality of "years of coordinated lawfare by the government the largest Christian University in the country."

As CBN News further quoted Mueller, he said, "As we have stated from the

beginning, not only were these accusations false, but the opposite is go above and beyond what is required in our disclosures and are recognized as a leader in this area.”

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This victory for Grand Canyon University is more than just a legal triumph—it is a testament to God’s faithfulness in defending His work. This outcome serves as a reminder that God honors those who walk righteously, even when faced with powerful opposition, and that His purposes for advancing His Kingdom through institutions like GCU cannot be hindered by worldly challenges.

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Blue Wild Pigs Spark Concern: Is Nature Sounding an Alarm?

The increase of pestilences in nature continues to grow in resounding ways.

According to Science Alert, game hunters in California recently discovered something no one could ever imagine: wild pigs with bright, neon blue insides.

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Dan Burton, who owns a wildlife control business, told The Los Angeles Times that there were not “a

little blue," but "neon blue, blueberry blue.

Local investigations concluded that this happened to the pigs through rodenticide poisoning, though this type of poison has been restricted in the state of California since last year.

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California Department of Fish and Wildlife pesticides investigations coordinator Ryan Barbour noted that "Hunters should be aware that the meat of game animals, such as wild pig, deer, bear, and geese, might be contaminated..." and that

“Rodenticide exposure can be a concern for non-target wildlife.”

The appearance of wild pigs with neon blue insides is a stark reminder of the unusual phenomena increasingly being observed in nature, and it resonates with biblical accounts of the end times. Scripture speaks of pestilences, strange occurrences and disturbances in the natural order as signs preceding the return of Christ.

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As we witness wildlife exhibiting unprecedented changes, from pigmentation anomalies to behavioral shifts, it aligns with the broader pattern of creation groaning under the weight of corruption and warning humanity of spiritual

As Cahn points out,

Trump confronted a woman with an anti-biblical agenda, Hillary Clinton, rising as a “Jehu,” doing this not once but twice in 2016 and again in 2024. Against all predictions, Trump prevailed, fulfilling the biblical archetype of a figure rising against a king and a corrupt queen.

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Trump’s political timeline is deeper than commonly known, however. As Cahn discusses, Trump first entered the political stage in 2000, running as a reform candidate and winning the California primaries. “Most people would say 2015–16. No, it was

2000... Almost nobody knows this," says Cahn. If this trajectory continues, his last full year of political influence could be 2028, matching Jehu's 28-year reign—a symbolic parallel that highlights divine orchestration.
