1. "Hostile Alien Threat" or Supernatural Seduction?

When the New York Post reported that Harvard scientists were studying a [mysterious interstellar object](#) that may represent a "hostile alien threat," it made waves across the internet. But DiDio had a stark interpretation: these aren't aliens—they're ancient, deceptive spirits.

Quoting 1 Timothy 4:1, DiDio warned that in the last days, "some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits and doctrines of devils." Rather than distant extraterrestrials, the UFO phenomenon may actually be part of a much older deception—one that began in Eden and now rebrands

itself through science fiction and government disclosure.

“These aren’t little green men from Mars,” DiDio said.

According to DiDio and co-host Evan DiDio, many of the so-called alien encounters are better understood through a biblical lens: as demonic manifestations, or the actions of spiritual beings like angels or watchers.

2. More Americans Believe in Aliens Than in God

Perhaps even more troubling is what this fascination reveals about our culture. According to a Pew Research study referenced by DiDio, 51% of [Americans believe UFO sightings are evidence](#) of intelligent life beyond Earth.

This means belief in aliens has officially surpassed belief in the God of the Bible.

“This is not an academic curiosity—it’s a spiritual crisis,” DiDio warned.

In a time when biblical illiteracy is rising and interest in the paranormal is exploding, Christians must anchor their worldview in the Word. Otherwise, they risk being swept up in what DiDio calls “the great end-time deception.”

3. The Book of Daniel, the Watchers and a Misidentified Reality

DiDio and Evan point to the Book of Daniel as one of the Bible's clearest references to spiritual beings that may be misinterpreted in our modern age as "aliens." Daniel 4:17 mentions "watchers"—celestial beings sent from heaven to decree judgment. The Hebrew Scriptures describe these beings as real and active in human affairs.

The DiDios proposed a fascinating theory: Could King Nebuchadnezzar's [encounters with the divine](#)—such as seeing "one like a son of God" in the fiery furnace—have been misread by ancient eyes, just as modern man might misinterpret angelic or demonic activity as extraterrestrial?

Perry Stone: 4 Signs We Are In the Last Days

Perry Stone recently shared a compelling message through

Daystar, revealing four clear signs that signal the approach of the end times. Drawing deeply from Scripture and current global realities, Stone paints a sobering picture of where we stand prophetically and urges believers to prepare their hearts for what is ahead.

1. A Worldwide Refusal to Repent

Stone's first sign is the growing resistance to the message of repentance. He observes that even after devastating events, [such as catastrophic hurricanes](#), many people remain unchanged spiritually—showing no urgency to turn toward God. Referencing the book of Revelation, he points out that there will come a time when people endure God's judgments but refuse to repent; instead, they curse God and blame Him for their troubles.

He compares this to Noah's generation, which was warned for decades about a coming flood but dismissed it as nonsense. Likewise, today's generation often mocks the idea of Christ's return or ignores calls to repentance, lacking faith and being hardened in heart. Stone believes this rejection will become widespread after an end-time revival, ultimately leading to a generation that no longer responds to calls for repentance.

2. The Filling of the Cup of Iniquity

The second sign centers on the biblical concept of the "cup of iniquity," which symbolizes accumulated sin and rebellion. Stone explains that sin can be seen as falling short or missing the mark, but iniquity is a deeper level of moral corruption and perversity.

Using King David's sin with Bathsheba as an example, Stone emphasizes that some sins penetrate the heart so deeply they block prayers and hinder God's blessings. When the "cup" becomes full—whether for individuals or nations—[it triggers divine judgment](#). Stone warns believers to guard their hearts against hidden sins like bitterness, unforgiveness and deception that can lead to spiritual barrenness.

3. Covenant Breakers Turning Hostile Toward the Righteous

Stone's third sign involves those who once had a relationship with God but have turned away and become antagonistic toward those who follow Him. He points to the biblical account of Sodom, where violent men sought to harm Lot and the angels staying with him.

Today, Stone observes a similar spirit manifesting as attacks on churches, the destruction of Bibles and hostility toward Christians. When former believers or hardened sinners rise up in violence against the faithful, it signals that God's judgment is near. This growing aggression against righteousness serves as a critical warning of the times.

4. A Global Outpouring of the Holy Spirit Led by Youth

Despite these troubling signs, Stone highlights a powerful and hopeful prophetic indicator—a worldwide move of God marked by a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit. This revival, prophesied in Joel and echoed by Peter in Acts, will be led largely by young people across all nations, including places where the gospel has struggled to penetrate.

Stone recalls [historic revivals](#) like Azusa Street and the Jesus Movement as previews of this final awakening. With 75% of Christians coming to faith before age 25, he stresses that

reaching and empowering youth is vital to this last-day revival. He also notes vibrant church growth in parts of the world like Indonesia and Iran, pointing to a global readiness for the Spirit's work.

Jack Hibbs Sounds the Alarm on Teachers in the Pulpit Leading Believers Astray

In today's world, where Christian voices are numerous and teachings often conflicting, discerning truth from error is more critical than ever. [Pastor Jack Hibbs](#), in a recent podcast episode, delivers a timely and urgent message rooted in Scripture: believers must be vigilant against false teachers and deceptive doctrines that threaten the integrity of the faith.

Hibbs gives a sobering biblical warning from 2 Timothy 3:1-5. Apostle Paul wrote to Timothy that "in the last days perilous

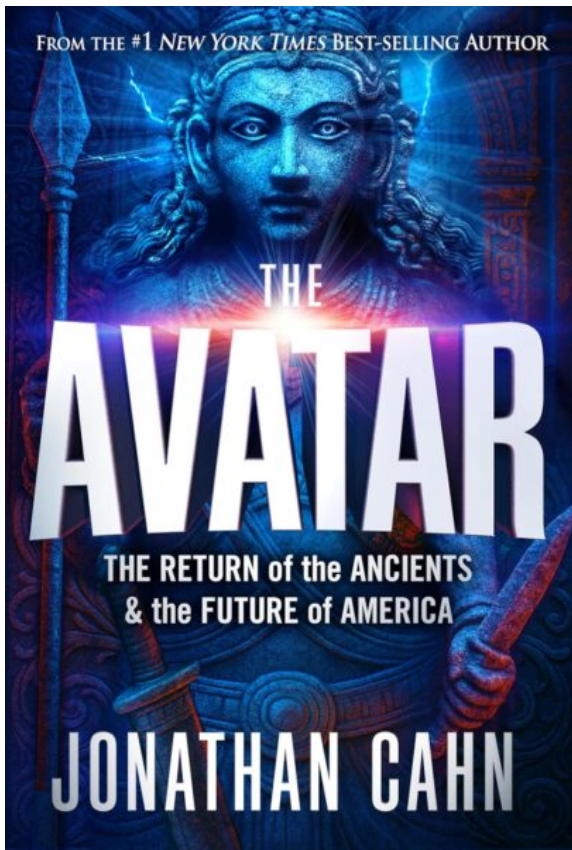

Many ministers, who present themselves as [gospel teachers](#), actually serve themselves or promote false doctrines that deviate from biblical truth. These “idol shepherds,” as Hibbs calls them, cause division, confusion and spiritual harm. He challenges listeners to ask themselves: Who in my world fits this description? Are some people I trust at risk of departing from the faith? Sadly, Scripture reveals that many who appear committed can later fall away because their faith was never genuine.

One major concern Hibbs raises is the popular prosperity gospel, which promises health, wealth and success through faith, often divorced from repentance or true discipleship. It’s important to note that James 3 warns that those who teach the Word will face stricter judgment because of the great responsibility spiritual leaders bear. As believers, Hibbs encourages us to “research for ourselves” and not blindly follow anyone simply because they are [popular or charismatic](#).

Finally, Hibbs stresses that true faith does not reject reality. Denying illness or financial hardship in the name of faith is not biblical wisdom but can lead to ruin. God calls us to be grounded in Scripture, balanced in faith and [discerning in all things.](#)

Bible Prophecy Shows Why Jesus Could Come Back Any Minute

On a recent episode of Countdown to Eternity, [Pastors James Kaddis](#) and Tom Hughes offered a sobering and timely reminder: Jesus is coming soon—and we must be watching, waiting and prepared.

“Christ could come at any moment,” Kaddis opened. “And yes indeed, Jesus is coming soon.”

Hughes followed with a reading from Luke 12:35–40, where Jesus tells His disciples to “let your waist be girded and your lamps burning.” The command is clear: believers are to live in a state of expectancy, ready for the return of the Master at any hour—even the third watch of the night.

“Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching,” Hughes emphasized. “There’s a reward for watching.”

However, watching isn’t passive. [As Kaddis explained](#), “You can watch till you’re blue in the face, but if you’re not sober, then you’re in trouble.” He referenced 1 Thessalonians, where believers are instructed to “watch and be sober,” highlighting the urgency of spiritual alertness in these prophetic times.

Both pastors warned against the widespread apathy in the

modern church toward Bible prophecy. “Most pastors say, ‘Don’t pay any attention to these things,’” Hughes said. “But Jesus says, ‘Watch and be ready.’ It’s an act of obedience.”

Kaddis likened the coming of the Lord to lightning—sudden, unmistakable, yet easy to miss if one isn’t looking. “When lightning happens, you recognize it, but if you’re not paying attention, you can miss it.”

Drawing from Luke 12, [Hughes unpacked Jesus’ metaphor](#) of the second and third watches. “If He doesn’t come in the second watch, and you’re still watching in the third, there’s a blessing. But if you’ve fallen asleep spiritually—if you’re not grounded in Scripture—you’re going to miss it.”

The problem, they agreed, lies in how Bible prophecy is often sensationalized or ignored altogether. “A lot of prophecy guys don’t teach the Bible. They don’t teach the whole counsel of God,” Kaddis said. “They make predictions without proper biblical grounding, and when those predictions don’t come to pass, people lose heart.”

Instead, Kaddis pointed to the days of Noah and Lot—not for their wickedness, but for their indifference. “People were eating, drinking, marrying,” he said. “They saw the symbol of God’s judgment and ignored it.”

Kaddis said, “God was giving them a sign, and they mocked it. And we’re doing the same today. Jesus said the signs would be like the days of Noah. They saw the signs and still didn’t care.”

Both men called for a return to faithful, Bible-based teaching of prophecy that includes the gospel message of [repentance and hope](#).

“If a quarter of the Bible is prophecy and the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy, shouldn’t we be proclaiming it?” Hughes asked.

Science of Miracles: How Faith Unlocks Your Body’s Healing Power

In a groundbreaking interview on The Deep End with Taylor Welch, Dr. Chris Cormier offers an eye-opening [perspective on healing](#), combining spiritual insight with emerging scientific

principles like quantum neurology, cellular optimization and energy frequency.

With a background in kinesiology and a doctorate in chiropractic care, Cormier's work challenges conventional medicine's approach to treating illness by instead reigniting the body's natural ability to heal.

From the start, Cormier contends that the human body was designed by God with an inherent power to regenerate. "If they cut off your leg, your brain will spend the rest of its life trying to grow it back," he says, underscoring the untapped potential of self-healing. He argues that major pharmaceutical companies intentionally suppress this truth, promoting dependency on pills rather than encouraging wellness at the cellular level.

Cormier's mission revolves around [restoring communication between the brain and body.](#) Using methods that increase oxygen, water and light energy in cells, he explains that healing begins with basic yet often overlooked necessities. A healthy cell, he notes, contains about 65% oxygen—but due to chronic shallow breathing, most people have under-oxygenated cells, creating an environment ripe for disease.

Another critical element of his work is frequency. According to Cormier, every organ in the body has its own electromagnetic frequency, and when these are disrupted—whether by trauma, stress or even Wi-Fi—the nervous system loses coherence. He draws parallels to the teachings of

figures like Joe Dispenza, who speak of “retuning” thoughts and bodily systems, but Cormier takes it a step further by incorporating light technologies and other physical tools. He describes the nervous system as a power grid, and frequencies as the current flowing through it.

Trauma, especially emotional or subconscious trauma, also plays a major role in disrupting nervous system health. Cormier points out that unresolved guilt, loss or shame can weaken the body’s ability to heal, even if the [physical conditions are ideal](#). “Whatever the trauma is, could be doing something bad they don’t forgive themselves for. There’s so much on the emotional side that can go wrong.” He also notes that, “The nervous system can be drained just by being around people with weaker energy.”

Through his clinic, Cormier uses tools like low-level light devices, hydrogen-infused water and frequency-based diagnostics to bring patients’ bodies back into balance. The results, he says, have reversed failing organs and chronic illnesses—often in defiance of medical expectations.

In the end, Cormier insists that faith and energy alignment are just as crucial as physical treatments. This new approach—what Cormier calls the “science of miracles”—invites a holistic shift. It’s a call to not just mask symptoms, but to place faith our faith in Jesus that He can do the impossible.

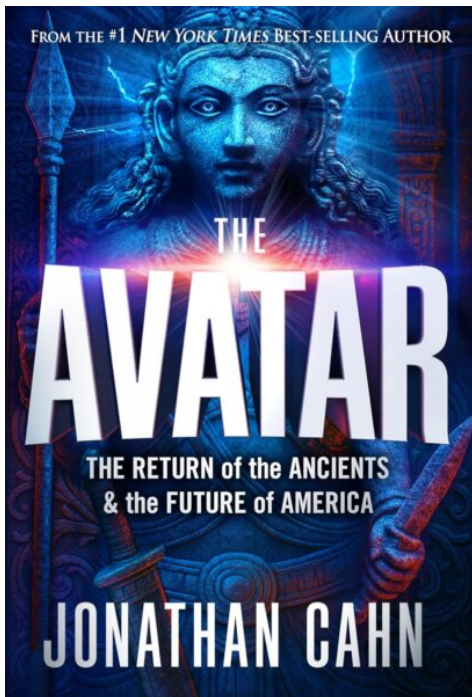
Perry Stone's Prophetic Tsunami Visions: Are Catastrophic Waves Coming to America?

Prophetic minister Perry Stone has issued a sobering warning based on years of dreams and visions involving devastating tsunamis across the globe. In a recent update, Stone emphasized that what the world has witnessed so far is only a precursor to [greater shaking still to come](#).

Stone began by recounting a recent 8.8 magnitude earthquake that struck Russia's peninsula region—only slightly smaller than the 9.1 quake that devastated Indonesia in 2004. The tremor generated minor tsunami waves and triggered alerts in Hawaii and on the U.S. West Coast. But according to Stone, this event mirrors past visions and represents a birth pang rather than the main event.

These dreams, he insists, are not symbolic metaphors for trouble but contain specific details involving people, geography and real-life consequences. “One of the things I’ve seen multiple times is a wave on the West Coast, possibly 80 to 100 feet high,” he warned.

In these dreams, people fled inland toward the mountains of Southern California as the water surged in. "It wasn't just imagery—it felt like a spiritual alert," Stone explained. He also described prophetically [seeing water come two to three feet inland](#) on the East Coast, particularly from Baltimore, Maryland to Charleston, South Carolina. In those scenes, residents moved to upper levels of their homes to escape the flooding below.

Although these events have not yet occurred, Stone said they have stayed with him in a way that marks them as spiritually significant. Drawing from Daniel 10 and Luke 21, he emphasized that dreams from the Lord don't fade with time but remain persistent, stirring a sense of urgency and prayer.

"The Lord showed Daniel [troubling visions](#), and he fasted for understanding," Stone said. "That's how you know it's from God—it doesn't leave your spirit."

Stone urged coastal residents to take practical steps for preparation: know escape routes, have emergency bags ready and store small cash amounts in case digital systems go down. He noted how traffic congestion, gas shortages and power outages are often overlooked dangers during such events.

But he also cautioned against panic, instead calling believers to spiritual readiness. “Jesus said that men’s hearts would fail for fear of the things coming on the earth,” Stone said, quoting Luke 21:26. “But for those who trust in Him, this is a time to remain alert, not afraid.”

Ultimately, Stone believes [these natural events](#) are part of the escalating signs leading to Christ’s return. “This isn’t the tsunami I saw,” he clarified. “But it’s the birth pang before the bigger one.”

Amanda Grace: The New York City Shooting and Tisha B’Av

In a sobering broadcast, Amanda Grace unpacked a chilling connection between the recent shooting in New York City and a larger spiritual conflict unfolding across the globe. The attack, which claimed four lives including a heroic NYPD officer, has been described as more than a senseless act of violence. Many believe it was a spiritually calculated event, [filled with dark symbolism and hidden agendas.](#)

The shooter, identified as Shane Tamura, allegedly drove from Nevada—home of “Sin City”—to another “Sin City,” New York. Armed with an assault-style rifle, he entered a 44-story building at 345 Park Avenue, which houses the NFL headquarters. The attack occurred at 6:30 p.m. on the 33rd floor. Those numbers, as Grace points out, is six days before Tisha B’Av, at 6:30 p.m., and 33 (3+3=6)—appear to align with the enemy’s watermark of 666.

[Tisha B’Av, falling on August 2–3](#) this year, is the saddest day on the Jewish calendar, commemorating the destruction of both the First and Second Temples. Grace notes that it’s also the anniversary of numerous calamities in Jewish history, including expulsions and massacres. The shooting’s timing and symbolic layers are believed to mock God and serve as a dark spiritual “statement.”

More prophetic clues emerged when examining the names involved. Shane means “gift from God,” while Tamura is Japanese—just as Japan recently signed a historic trade deal and issued a tsunami warning. The fallen NYPD officer’s name, Didarul Islam, translates to “treasure of Islam.” His

sacrifice is described by Grace as a ritualistic offering in a high place, reinforcing a larger agenda of claiming spiritual territory.

These events align with several prophetic words [released by Amanda Grace](#) in recent years. A word from July 18, 2025, warned: “They shall attempt an attack in New York City to sculpt a hero out of the mayor’s race.. The enemy has claimed rights to such and places disciples upon such a seat.”

Even more chilling is the numerical alignment of these events. Trump Tower, located at 502 Park Avenue, and the Blackstone building at 345 Park Avenue share the same Midtown strip. Add their addresses together and you get 847—interpreted as eighth month (August), 47th president (Donald Trump). Just months earlier, former FBI Director James Comey posted “8647,” raising speculation that this could have been a cryptic countdown or signal.

From the precision of numbers to the strategic timing before Tisha B’Av, Grace warns that this shooting is a sign of something deeper—a spiritual war being waged over New York City, with implications for the nation. 'Enough Is Enough': Prophetic Word for August Calls Believers Into Authority

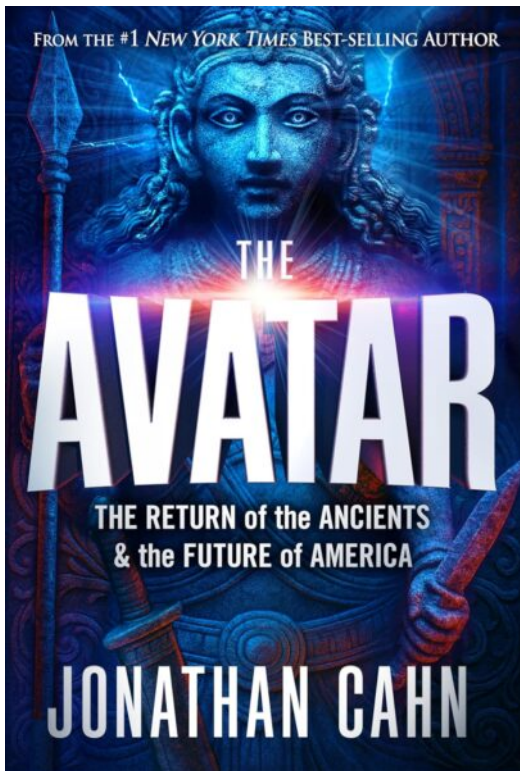
In a moment of urgent intercession, a powerful word from prophetic voice Tomi Arayomi is ringing out to the world: "Enough is enough."

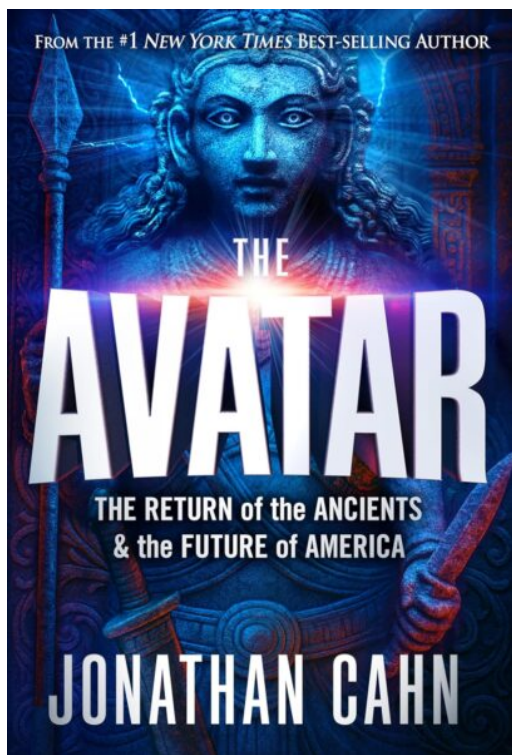

Stone delineated the three heavens Paul referenced in 2 Corinthians 12. The first heaven encompasses Earth's

atmosphere. The second heaven includes the sun, moon, stars and galaxies—a region Stone described as Satan’s domain of aerial authority. The third heaven is paradise, the dwelling place of God.

Quoting from Job 1 and 2, Stone pointed to how Satan was given limited access to attack Job through “fire from heaven” and a great wind—both of [which destroyed lives and property](#). He argues these were not acts of God but supernatural weather events instigated by Satan himself.

Weather as a Weapon

Stone believes that certain extreme weather events are not simply natural disasters, but spiritual attacks aimed at disrupting the work of the Church.

“I have experienced the weirdest weather patterns at certain occasions,” he shared. “I believe that bad weather can certainly hinder the gospel—not necessarily the preaching of it, but people being a part of it.”

Stone recounted several events in his ministry where unusual weather suddenly threatened revival meetings, including a funnel cloud that nearly took down a tent in Virginia and powerful winds that disrupted a February tent revival in Tampa. On another occasion, he witnessed 40 lightning strikes hit the property of a church in just 15 minutes—right before a major warfare conference.

“Every time I would go to Tampa... we would have lightning strikes coming out of nowhere,” Stone recalled. “So I quit going to Tampa in the month of June.”

Stone believes these weather disturbances are not just coincidences but are linked to demonic interference—particularly during moments of spiritual breakthrough. “We’re having storms out of season. We’re having floods that come out of nowhere. This is really getting

weird.”

Lightning, Fire and the End Times

The connection between lightning and spiritual warfare also surfaced in Jesus’ words in Luke 10:18: “I beheld Satan fall like lightning from heaven.” Stone speculates that lightning serves as a symbol—and even a literal manifestation—of spiritual transitions, including Jesus’ return.

“In a vision I had... when [Jesus] shot His left hand out, lightning went that way. When He shot His right hand out, lightning went that way,” Stone said. “And the lightning carried everybody from around the world back to where He was.”

He reinforced his point with Revelation 13, where the false prophet calls fire from heaven—a sign that even demonic forces will wield control over nature in the last days.

Elijah and the Hidden War

One of the most compelling portions of Stone’s teaching centered on Elijah’s encounter with wind, earthquake, and fire in 1 Kings 19. “But the Lord was not in the wind... the earthquake... or the fire,” he emphasized.

Stone believes those events were [demonic in origin](#)—attempts by Satan to kill Elijah after the prophet, in a moment of despair, asked God to take his life. “Satan heard it and said, ‘I have authority now because of what he said with his mouth to try to take him out.’”

He warned, “Watch what you say with your mouth. The enemy will take it against you.”

A Spiritual Battle Behind the Forecast

As floods, fires, tornadoes and weather extremes increase, Stone challenges believers to look beyond meteorological explanations. The invisible war in the heavens—between God’s angels and demonic powers—is more than theological metaphor. It may be affecting the very air we breathe and the storms we endure.

Stone concludes that America’s increasing weather instability is more than climate change—it is climate warfare, rooted in spiritual conflict. “There is an invisible side to the freaky weather patterns,” he said, “and we’re about to get into that.”
