Stuck in a Spiritual Battle? 3 Revelations That Will Set You Free

In a recent live stream from Alwyn Uys, viewers were reminded that the mysterious workings of their lives are not governed by chance, but by the sovereign hand of God. Uys shared a heartfelt testimony and prophetic encouragement for those who have been experiencing turmoil, uncertainty and unexplainable challenges in their homes and personal lives.

"There's this phrase that's been coming up a lot lately," Uys shared. "You're not lucky, you're favored." While seemingly simple, the statement holds deep spiritual truth. "For us as Christians, we don't believe that there is such a thing as luck. We know that God orchestrates the steps of a man."

Uys recounted returning home after two and a half weeks of ministry travel to find his door wide open. Given that he lives in South Africa, his initial reaction was fear–concern that someone had broken in. But everything was untouched.

“I saw my TV is there, the iPad is there–everything is still in its place,” he said. “I got this cold feeling over my whole body... but nothing was missing. Nothing was gone.”

What appeared to be a dangerous oversight was instead a powerful display of divine favor. “Immediately, I realized that it’s not luck. It’s favor. It’s God’s protection.”

He encouraged viewers to consider the many ways God might be shielding them without their awareness: “Car accidents have been avoided, house break-ins have been avoided, illnesses have been avoided because of the protection of God.” Referencing Job’s story, Uys reminded listeners that just because we can’t see what God is doing, doesn’t mean He’s not at work.

For those experiencing breakdowns in their finances, relationships or daily peace, this word was especially poignant. “It just feels like you’re working, you get your salary, and before you know it, it’s just gone. It’s like there’s a hole in your pocket,” he said. “Father, I pray that you cover up this hole.”

Two scriptures served as anchors in Uys' heartfelt message.

First, Psalm 91:11—"For He shall give His angels charge over you to keep you in all your ways."

Second, Zechariah 2:5—"For I, says the Lord, will be a wall of fire all around her, and I will be the glory in her midst." Uys encouraged viewers to declare these verses and meditate on them daily as declarations of divine security.

In a world full of chaos and confusion, this prophetic reminder shines clearly: you are not at the mercy of random events—you are covered by the hand of God.

Shocking Vision: Golden Dome Dream Foretells America's Future

Could there be a prophetic implication behind the presidential pardoning of Todd and Julie Chrisley?

In a recent video, Amanda Grace of Ark of Grace Ministries shared what she believes is a prophetic timeline connected to the surprise pardon of reality TV stars Todd and Julie Chrisley by President Donald Trump. Grace points to the biblical significance of this moment, emphasizing how it aligns with the Jewish calendar and God's redemptive timing.

“Within the past week, President Trump has given a full pardon to Todd and Julie Chrisley,” Grace said. “There is something very prophetic about the timeline of what happened to them according to the Jewish calendar.”

Grace draws a connection between the Chrisleys’ conviction in 2022 and imprisonment in early 2023 with the Jewish year 5783. “The letter Gimmel represents a man walking... walking in the direction of the next letter... Dallet, which comes from a root word meaning weakness and poverty,” she explained. “So abundance and blessing was walking into weakness and poverty.”

According to Grace, this reflects the Chrisleys’ real-life trajectory—once living in abundance, then falling into imprisonment. But she believes the tide began to turn in the following year.

“[Year] 5784 was the year the prison doors would open to Joseph,” she said, referring to the biblical figure who was imprisoned unjustly and later elevated to a place of authority. “I had said publicly on multiple occasions that the year 5784 had business to finish in 5785.”

That “business,” she claims, was fulfilled when President Trump issued the pardon in May 2025—during the fifth month of the Hebrew year 5785.

“In 5785, in the fifth month... they are pardoned, fully pardoned, and the prison doors fully open to Joseph,” Grace

declared. “Pharaoh pardoned Joseph. The same way our leader, President Trump, brought Todd and Julie Chrisley up out of the prison and pardoned them.”

She further emphasized the symbolic nature of the timing: “Todd and Julie Chrisley were granted double grace from the sword and given their lives back.”

Grace concluded with a word of encouragement for believers to remain spiritually alert and prayerful. “The Lord isn’t going to waste what happened to them. He will use it in their lives if they so pick up that torch and run with it... Pray for the Chrisleys after all the trauma they’ve been through. Keep the faith. Be in the Word of God every single day.”

Is This Chilling Putin Prophecy Coming to Pass?

Perhaps there is a prophetic act that all of us can take against the schemes of the enemy.

In a powerful teaching based on Zechariah 10:4, John Eckhardt unveils a striking revelation: “Out of Judah comes the nail.” Judah, meaning praise, is the spiritual key that anchors, stabilizes and equips believers to overcome spiritual warfare.

“Praise will establish you and set you and make you firm in your walk with God,” he declares.

The nail, drawn from the prophetic symbolism of Zechariah 10:4 and Isaiah 22:23, represents stability and divine establishment. “You can be a nail in a sure place. You can be set by God in a stable place,” Eckhardt encourages. But this isn't just about standing firm—it's about striking back.

Praise, he teaches, is more than adoration; it's warfare.

To illustrate this truth, he draws from Judges 4, the story of Jael. Sisera, a military commander and symbolic principality, fled into Jael's tent to rest after a battle. She gave him milk and a place to sleep—but while he was at rest, she took a tent peg and a hammer and drove it through his temple. "She took a hammer and a nail and drove it through the temple of Sisera. God used that to bring deliverance from the enemies of Israel."

This unexpected victory reveals how God uses unlikely weapons—like praise—to dismantle the enemy's authority. "The head of Sisera, the oppressor of Israel, was crushed by the nail in the hand of a woman," he says. The tent peg in Jael's hand is a prophetic picture of praise in the mouth of the believer.

"The sound of Judah, praise before the battle, the hammer of worship in your hand, the peg of prophetic praise striking the head of your adversary," says Eckhardt.

The head represents authority, and praise has the power to strike and break the authority of spiritual darkness. "Praise will release a nail in your hand that will smite the head of the enemy." This is not carnal warfare—it is spiritual. "We wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities... against spiritual wickedness in high places."

Eckhardt urges believers to rise up with the mantle of Jael. "Let the worshippers arise and smite the head of the

oppressor.” He emphasizes, “Your praise is like a hammer that drives the nail through the enemy... your worship will drive the peg through the skull of your adversary.”

This message is a call to prophetic praise. It’s a reminder that we are not helpless or weaponless. “Out of Judah comes the nail. Out of your praise comes victory. Out of your song comes the strike.”

In this prophetic season, Eckhardt’s message is clear: your praise is not passive—it is powerful. It establishes, anchors and strikes with divine authority. As you lift your voice in worship, you’re not just singing; you’re engaging in spiritual warfare.
