The first thing that Stone breaks down is that this curse is not one about profanity or some other worldly, surface idea of a curse, but it has to do with biblical obedience and disobedience.

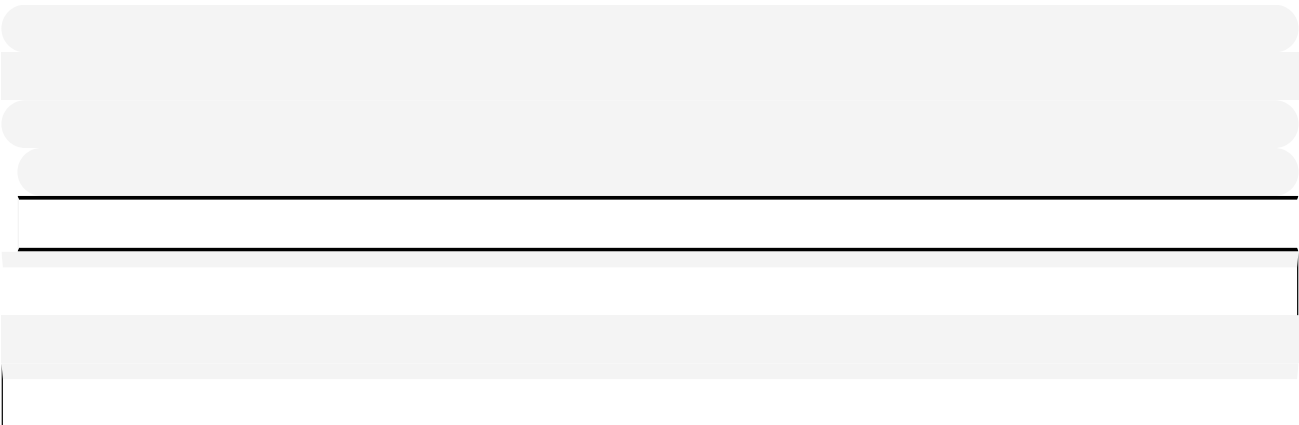

Recently, the Miss USA organization has been dealing with issues after both Miss USA and Teen Miss USA stepped down from their titleholder duties.

As Fox News reported, Miss USA Noelia Voigt and UmaSofia Srivastava, Miss Teen USA, both walked away from their crowns in May. This led to first-runner up, Savannah Gankiewicz of Hawaii, to take over as Miss USA for the remainder of the pageant year.

Voigt left the pageant for her “mental health,” while Srivastava took to Instagram to share her reasoning for exiting the Miss Teen USA world.

“After months of grappling with this decision, I have made the choice to resign from the title of Miss Teen USA 2023,” Srivastava wrote. “After careful consideration, I’ve decided to resign as I find that my personal values no longer fully

align with the direction of the organization.”

When Voigt first won the title of Miss USA, she gave praise to God on Instagram.

“First and foremost, I thank God for all of the trials and tribulations that led me to this enormous blessing. I prayed so hard that His will be done and that I feel peace, confidence, and faith,” Voigt wrote.

"Jesus said,

free.' But you've got to know the truth first," Lucado says.

It is expected that all of us will experience loneliness at some point in time. We all will feel inadequate, seeking after the approval of others. Lucado admits that's something he even struggles with from time to time. However, it is by seeing that God is with us at all times that we can find fulfillment.

"He revealed to me that I still continue to base my confidence upon the applause and approval of people, which is

disastrous because you cannot control the applause and approval of people. So, I needed that reminder and I confessed it to Jesus, and the next day, I was fine. I was back to normal...it was a wonderful gift on His part," says Lucado.
