

Historic and Divisive: Pope Leo Hosts First Female Archbishop of Canterbury at the Vatican

In a culture where end-times preaching is routinely dismissed as fear-mongering, Atlanta pastor Philip Anthony Mitchell isn't backing down. In a new interview with Bryce Crawford, Mitchell sounded an alarm he believes is both prophetically urgent and scripturally grounded.

The Antichrist Could Be Alive Right Now

Mitchell does not speak abstractly about the coming man of perdition. Drawing from Daniel and Revelation, he describes the Antichrist as a handsome, politically gifted figure who will sign a seven-year peace treaty with Israel – but only after conflict has already destabilized the region.

“I wouldn't be surprised if he's alive right now. I wouldn't be surprised if he's working his way through the political ranks. I wouldn't be surprised if he's in college somewhere. You can feel his spirit in the earth,” Mitchell said.

For Mitchell, the ongoing war in the Middle East is not just geopolitical – it is a prophetic setup. “There is no need for a peace treaty if there's no war,” he said plainly. “Anytime Israel's at war, we should be paying attention.”

AI and the Talking Image of Revelation

Mitchell also pointed to Revelation's account of the Antichrist setting up a talking image in the temple that causes people to worship – and asked the question out loud: is that AI?

“AI is going to be part of the end-time prophecy. A talking image – is that a hologram? Is it AI? AI is going to have a lot to do with that,” he said.

“Things are getting so real right now,” Crawford responded, “you can't even tell the difference.”

The Urgency of the Gospel

Mitchell frames evangelism not as a program but as a moral emergency. Meditating on both Revelation 20 and the parable of Lazarus and the rich man, he drew a picture of conscious, eternal suffering that he says should drive every believer to their knees in intercession.

“If men knew how graphic eternal separation from God is,” he said, “I think we would care more about people who are not saved.” He reminded listeners that the person most at risk on Judgment Day may not be the atheist, but the churchgoer who assumed they were fine.

“The people calling him Lord are people who think that they are okay with God. And that's going to be the person I feel the most sorry for,” Mitchell said.

God Is Echoing Through Every

Willing Voice

Perhaps the most striking moment of the conversation came when Mitchell reflected on why so many unconnected voices – across denominations, cities and generations – are all sounding the same end-times alarm at the same time.

His answer was simple: it isn't a coincidence. It's God.

"Maybe God is trying to use any willing, non-compromising, non-afraid, non-punk voices to speak the truth. Because when God speaks, he echoes. I'm using every available voice to sound an alarm. I am coming, and I'm coming very soon," Mitchell stated.

Mitchell's closing was a reminder that Jesus' return is much sooner than we may believe. "It's the fourth quarter. We got three minutes left to go, and we're down by seven. That's the urgency we need right now."

There's no question about it: The bride of Christ needs to wake up before it is too late.

Disturbing 'Christian' Manifesto Discovered After Suspect's Attempt on the President's Life

In a culture consumed with the temporary, one message is rising with urgency: eternity is far more significant than most people realize.

"You are going to spend % of your existence somewhere and most of you have almost no idea where," Randy Kay says in a recent video.

"The years you get on this earth, the school years, the career years, the years you spend arguing with your spouse and raising your children and chasing some version of what you thought mattered... are not the story. They are the prologue."

The Explosion of Near-Death Content

Online platforms have seen a surge of near-death experience (NDE) testimonies, many drawing millions of views. Titles describing encounters with heaven and God have captivated audiences worldwide.

But Kay issues a clear warning about what lies beneath the surface.

"A lot of them, and I say this carefully because I do not want to accuse the innocent, but a lot of them are not real."

He explains that some accounts are generated artificially or fabricated for profit, while others present a misleading picture of eternity.

“What they describe is a light with no Jesus in it. A heaven with no holiness. A God shaped like the spirit of the age. No judgment, no cross, no repentance, no name.”

A Spiritual Battle for Truth

The issue, Kay says, is not merely cultural—but spiritual.

“All of it... is designed, whether the people producing it know it or not, to drown out the real ones, especially the Christian ones.”

He points to a deeper reason behind the surge.

“The enemy does not flood a market he does not fear.”

“He floods it because he knows what a true heaven testimony does. It pulls people off the ledge. It wakes up the lukewarm. It pierces the armor of the intellectual.”

Referencing Scripture, Kay adds:

“Second Corinthians 11 tells you exactly what he does. He masquerades as an angel of light.”

‘Take Back the Narrative’

In response to what he describes as widespread confusion, Kay says he received a clear directive:

“Take back the narrative.”

He explains that this assignment goes beyond media strategy and speaks to restoring a true understanding of God.

“The narrative he meant was the narrative of himself. Who he is. What he is like. What happens when you stand in front of him.”

A Collection of 140 Testimonies

This calling led to the creation of Heaven Encounters, a book compiling 140 near-death testimonies.

"What you are about to hold in your hands is 20 years of my life. 140 other people's lives."

Kay emphasizes that the project is unique in its scope and intent.

"One story is a testimony. 140 is a testament."

He explains that these accounts, when viewed together, form a broader picture of eternity.

"140 whose accounts when you lay them next to each other begin to describe... the shape of the thing itself."

A Consistent Picture of Eternity

Across the testimonies, recurring themes emerge, including the reality of heaven, the warning of hell and the significance of one's life choices.

"The God who emerges from the 140 is more merciful than the fundamentalists feared and more holy than the universalist hoped."

Kay adds that these accounts point to a God who is deeply personal and unmistakably real.

"He is simply Himself. And He has been waiting for a long time to be recognized."

A Timely Message for a Searching Generation

The release of the book comes at what Kay describes as a critical moment.

“We are standing at a convergence. You feel it.”

He points to rising spiritual hunger, growing deception and global uncertainty as factors driving people to search for answers about eternity.

“People who have not set foot in a church in 30 years are searching for heaven at 3:00 in the morning.”

A Call to Live With Eternity in Mind

Ultimately, the message is not about death—but about how people live now.

“This is not a book about dying. It is a book about how to live.”

Kay stresses that the purpose of these testimonies is to bring clarity in a time of confusion and to point people back to truth.

In a generation flooded with voices, the need for discernment has never been greater. Scripture warns that deception will increase, even appearing as light (2 Cor. 11:14). Yet God continues to call people back to Truth through His Word and through testimonies that align with it.

As Christians, we must test what we hear, hold fast to what is true and live with eternity in view. Because if this life is only the prologue, the decisions we make now carry weight far beyond what we can see.

‘This Runs Deeper’: Amanda Grace Reacts to White House Correspondents Dinner Gunfire

A moment of national tension has ignited a fresh prophetic warning from Amanda Grace, who is calling believers to heightened spiritual awareness following the shooting at the White House Correspondents Dinner.

“This is breaking and a serious prophetic alert,” Grace declared. “...shots were fired at the White House Correspondents Dinner... It occurred at the Washington Hilton Hotel. This runs way deeper than you think.”

The event, which took place at the historic Washington Hilton, immediately drew comparisons to a chilling moment in American history.

Echoes of Reagan: A 45-Year Parallel

Grace pointed to the striking connection between the reported incident and the attempted assassination of Ronald Reagan on March 30, 1981—also outside the same hotel.

“Forty-five years ago... President Reagan, they attempted to assassinate him in front of the same hotel, the Washington Hilton Hotel,” she said.

According to Grace, the 45-year gap between the two events carries prophetic weight, particularly in light of Donald Trump’s presidency.

“Forty-five years separates these two events. President Trump was the 45th president. He’s also the 47th president.”

Patterns and Numbers: A Prophetic Framework

Central to Grace’s message is what she describes as a series of meaningful numerical patterns tied to current events.

“His presidencies equal 9/11. Four plus five is nine. Four plus seven is eleven—911,” she explained.

She also pointed to the hotel’s address as significant.

“The address of the Washington Hilton Hotel... is 1919 Connecticut Avenue Northwest. 911 is within the address.”

Grace further connected global events and calendars, adding, “Rosh Hashanah, the Feast of Trumpets, is set to begin on 9/11, September 11th.”

She emphasized what she believes is a prophetic window of time: “The two-year window... 2025 to 2027... equals 911.”

A Spiritual Battle Over America

Beyond numbers and parallels, Grace’s message centered on what she described as a deeper spiritual conflict unfolding behind

the scenes.

“These are serious times we’re in, and I’m telling you the enemy is attempting to stop the rededication of this nation back to God,” she said.

According to Grace, the incident is not isolated but part of a broader pattern.

“I believe this is the first event of a few that we are going to watch attempt to unfold like this,” she warned.

She also pointed to rising geopolitical tensions, referencing a wider “ conflict paradigm” as part of the unfolding picture.

A Call for the Church to Rise

In response, Grace issued a clear and urgent call to believers across the nation.

“The church needs to rise up, spiritually armor up, fight this war right now on those grounds,” she urged.

Her message concluded with a focus on faith and spiritual discipline:

“Continue to be in the Word of God every single day. Keep the faith.”

In times of uncertainty, we are being called not to fear—but to stand firm, pray boldly and remain anchored in truth.

‘Super El Niño’ Forecast Points to Unpredictable and Extreme Summer Weather

Meteorologists are closely watching developing conditions in the Pacific Ocean that could signal the emergence of a powerful El Niño weather pattern.

The Daily Mail reported that rising ocean temperatures have prompted concerns among scientists about the possibility of a “super El Niño,” a stronger-than-normal version of the climate cycle known for intensifying global weather extremes.

Forecast Points to Heat—and Instability

The report noted that the potential system could bring contrasting weather conditions. A stronger El Niño would increase the likelihood of:

RT Kendall Says ‘The Charismatic Movement Is Dead,’ Warns Historic Awakening Is Near

Few images in Scripture are more dramatic – or more misunderstood – than the Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse.

In a powerful sermon, messianic rabbi and #1 New York Times bestselling author Jonathan Cahn dismantled centuries of confusion and offered a startling, Scripture-rooted interpretation that connects ancient prophecy to today’s headlines.

It Starts Before Revelation Even Opens

To understand Revelation 6, Cahn says you must first understand the four living creatures of Revelation 4 – a lion, a calf, a man and an eagle – who each summon one of the horsemen. These angelic beings echo directly the cherubim of Eden, the seraphim in Isaiah 6 and the four-faced creatures in Ezekiel 1.

“The Bible is so consistent. It’s amazing. But that’s what you expect of God,” Cahn observes. He also notes a striking parallel to the four Gospels: Matthew portrays Yeshua as the lion-king, Mark as the servant-ox, Luke as the perfect man and John as the heavenly eagle.

The First Horseman: Not Jesus, but the Antichrist

The white horse and crown have led many commentators to identify the first rider as Christ. Cahn firmly disagrees.

“The first horseman is just one of four beings. Messiah is never just one of four beings. He’s the one. Period,” Cahn says.

Instead, Cahn argues the rider represents the Antichrist – the false messiah who will mimic Christ so convincingly that even the elect could be confused. “The very fact that this has confused commentators where they think it could be Messiah is kind of a sign that that’s what the Antichrist is going to do.”

Red, Black and Pale: War, Famine and Death

The red horse – whose color Cahn traces to the Greek pyrrhus, meaning “fire-red” – signals war and destruction. He draws a remarkable linguistic connection: Revelation’s “wormwood,” the star that poisons the waters, literally translates in Russian as Chernobyl – site of history’s worst nuclear disaster. “Uranium,” he notes, comes from the Greek word for “heavens” – the same word used in prophecies about the powers of the heavens being shaken.

The black horse speaks of famine: one day’s wages for one day’s food – a picture of economic collapse and scarcity. The pale horse, from the Greek chloros (the color of a decaying corpse), is named Death itself, given authority “over a fourth of the earth to kill with sword and famine and plague.”

“For the first time ever, man has the power to destroy the world – which is in Revelation in some form,” he states.

The Colors on Today’s Flags

Perhaps Cahn’s most striking claim: the four colors of the horsemen – white, red, black and green – appear together in the flags of nation after nation historically opposed to Israel, including Libya, Sudan, Syria, Iraq, Jordan and Afghanistan. “They don’t know it, but they’re waving the flag of the four horsemen – the flag of judgment,” Cahn says.

Israel’s flag, by contrast, is blue and white – the colors of the sky, modeled after the Jewish prayer shawl. “The flag of Israel is actually linked to the garment of Jesus Yeshua,” Cahn notes, pointing to the biblical command to wear blue fringes.

No Fear for the Redeemed

Cahn closes with a word of assurance: “We who are in God, who are born again – there’s no judgment. We don’t have to worry about the four horsemen.”

The seals of Revelation describe the world’s judgment, not the fate of those who belong to the Messiah who will ride in – not at the beginning of the apocalypse, but at its glorious end.
