

‘The Best Day of Your Life’: Inside the Arizona Baptism That Drew 1,500 People to the Water

When Johnny Chang reached out to George Janko with a simple proposal, to “baptize Arizona,” neither man could have anticipated what God had prepared. Approximately 1,500 people arrived from across the country and beyond.

Children. Adults. Drug addicts. Pregnant women. Broken people. All of them came to the water.

That was the greatest day of my life. – George Janko

Janko described the sacred weight of standing with each person as they went under the water – tears streaming down their faces, hearts pounding so hard he could feel it. He was witnessing something he had no words for: the last look of a person’s old life, and the first look of their new one.

When I’m putting them down into the water and when they come back out of the water, and I look at their eyes, I see different eyes.

Why water means everything

On stage that day, Chang unpacked one of the most striking biblical threads either man had shared publicly – tracing a line from Noah’s Ark to Jesus walking on water to the baptism pool. Water in Scripture carries a double meaning: judgment for the condemned, cleansing for the saved. Being in Christ, Chang explained, means walking above that curse entirely.

Anyone in Him will not be harmed by the curse. It symbolizes that we can walk on top of the curse just like Jesus was walking on top of the judgment.

The week the devil came after him

George's joy on that day didn't come without a fight. For the entire week leading up to the event, he battled crushing fear – terrified he was doing something wrong before God. He broke down weeping in front of his pastor before it began. The response his pastor gave changed everything.

He hugged me. He prayed over me, and then he said, 'Go have the best day of your life.' And that was nothing short besides it.

You can't save yourself – and that's the point

The deeper the conversation went, the more both men returned to the same liberating truth: this was never about what they could do for God.

Chang challenged the idea that repentance means simply feeling bad and trying harder, and called believers toward a fuller surrender, reminding them of the only thing that actually changes a life.

Christianity is not me sacrificing my life for God, me dying for God. It's actually Jesus dying on the cross and sacrificing His life for me. And when I thought about it in that way, it changed my whole perspective of how I moved.

Janko echoed this with raw honesty, describing what it feels like to know his own weakness completely – and to be grateful for it.

If you strip Jesus away from me, in a second, I'm back to the old me. I'm popping off. I'm doing whatever. But yet, it's you, God, who has to take care of me.

For both men, 1,500 baptisms was not a finish line. It was a beginning. The real work – nurturing, discipling, walking with people through fire – starts the moment they step out of the water.

Ancient Secrets Revealed? How the Pyramids Were Built May Surprise You

The knowledge surrounding the pyramids continues to grow, revealing new stones yet to be turned.

A Daily Mail report noted that a breakthrough may have been made in understanding how the pyramids were built and formed.

According to the report, a new study on the Pyramid of Khufu was likely made by “using a hidden spiral ramp running inside the structure.”

Vicente Luis Rosell Roig, a computer scientist, finds it plausible that those who worked on this structure utilized an “edge ramp,” which would slope from the edges of the pyramid and was filled in with each additional layer made.

This, it is believed, would have annulled the need for any external ramps, allowing the workers to move the stones upward at a steady pace. Current simulation models estimate these stones were placed “every four to six minutes,” making this pyramid take between 14 and 21 years to complete, and when transportation and other factors are included, it would take between 20 and 27 years to finish.

Even as new discoveries attempt to explain the engineering brilliance behind the Great Pyramid of Giza, the sense of wonder surrounding it only deepens. Each new theory answers one question while opening the door to countless others.

In a world that often prides itself on having all the answers, the pyramids quietly challenge that assumption, reminding us that there are still wonders yet to be uncovered.

In a report by Fox News, it was noted that the Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy let the world know that Ukraine made a stunning capture of a Russian position in a unique way: using robots.

Missed UFO Disclosure Deadline Sparks Growing Public Suspicion

Questions surrounding government transparency on unidentified aerial phenomena (UAPs) are intensifying after a key Pentagon deadline quietly passed—without clear confirmation that lawmakers received what they were promised.

According to a report from Newsweek, the Department of Defense had been expected to turn over more than 40 classified UFO-related videos to Congress by April 14, 2026. That request was led by Rep. Anna Paulina Luna, part of a broader push for transparency regarding encounters with mysterious objects observed in sensitive military zones.

Yet as the deadline passed, many now have more questions than answers.

Cover-Up Claims Intensify Amid Secrecy

Meanwhile, a separate Daily Mail report has amplified concerns that the government may be deliberately limiting public access to UFO-related information.

The outlet reported that the Pentagon has acknowledged the existence of additional unreleased UFO videos, while continuing to cite national security concerns as justification for keeping them classified.

According to the report, Luna wrote a letter to Secretary of War Pete Hegseth, asking for the release of these files by the 14th, some of which are said to have caught glimpses of these UAPs in both Syria and Iran.

Luna reportedly stated on social media that “No one from the Pentagon had responded until we reached out, and it appears that someone did not pass the letter to the appropriate authorities,” calling this move “convenient.”

Deception, Disclosure and the Days Ahead

As conversations around UFOs and unexplained phenomena accelerate, many believers are watching these developments through a different lens—one rooted not just in national security, but in spiritual discernment.

Scripture warns of a time when deception would increase, and truth would become harder to discern (see Matt. 24:4–5). What we are seeing right here with these UFO files is a reminder that there will come a time when deception plagues our world on an even greater level, and not all will be prepared for it.

Christians must stay grounded—not in speculation, but in the unchanging Word of God. As headlines continue to shift and new information emerges, discernment will be essential.

The statement itself clearly signals the topic of abortion, which has had strongholds in the Democratic Party for years, as they have chosen to be the “pro-choice” party. It also includes some suggestions and undertones regarding the Epstein Files, which continue to be a point of contention for those in government and in Hollywood.
