

Pastor Travis Johnson: Why Bold Christianity Is Surging Again Across America

Are we getting closer to the coming of the Antichrist?

In a recent interview with Charisma Media, Pastor Billy Crone warned that current geopolitical developments may mirror patterns described in Scripture about the last days.

Crone pointed to the concept of a global peace structure forming outside traditional institutions, specifically referencing the recently created Board of Peace.

“That is the event that will start the seven-year tribulation. That guy who does that will be the actual Antichrist,” Crone said, connecting the idea of a future peace covenant involving Israel to Daniel 9:27.

While Crone emphasized that he was not labeling any current leader the Antichrist, he stressed the prophetic urgency of establishing the Board of Peace. “I’m not saying Trump is that guy. I’m just saying, here we have a board of peace put together, circumventing the UN and all these other ones that have been around that can’t get the job done.”

Crone further said Christians should not be surprised by rapid geopolitical shifts. “It’s almost like we’re living in the last days, and it’s time to get motivated. God told us this in advance for a good reason.”

He explained that the Antichrist will broker a covenant with Israel that will trigger the seven-year Tribulation period.

For Christians who hold to a pre-tribulation rapture view, he said this suggests the church's departure could be drawing near. "The good news for you and I as a born-again Christian is we're not going to be there... the rapture which happens prior has therefore logically, biblically got to be getting close."

The conversation also turned to long-standing tensions over Israel's land and peace negotiations. Crone issued a strong warning rooted in his reading of biblical promises. "You do not divide the land. That land belongs to Israel. It's always been their inheritance. It came from God." He noted that global attempts to force peace solutions have repeatedly failed and, in his view, will continue to fail until a single future leader successfully brokers a deal.

Another major point of the discussion centered on the possible prophetic significance of global leadership consolidation. Referencing Revelation 17, Crone highlighted the passage describing ten kings or leaders who eventually give their authority to the Antichrist. "The 10 horns you saw are 10 kings... They have one purpose, and they will give their power and authority to the beast."

Crone also connected technological advances to prophetic concerns, especially regarding artificial intelligence. "You need AI to pull it off," he said, referencing the infrastructure he believes could support a future global economic control system described in Revelation 13.

Despite the warnings' intensity, Crone repeatedly emphasized that prophecy should motivate spiritual readiness, not fear. He urged Christians to stay grounded in Scripture as global events accelerate. "It's going to happen because God said it's going to happen."

Chaos Erupts as Towering Baal Statue Set on Fire Amid Roaring Crowds

Iranian protesters have made it clear where they stand on Israel, America and Judaism.

In a report by the Hindustan Times, it was noted that Iranians gathered together to celebrate the 47th anniversary of the Islamic Revolution by burning what they called a “Baal effigy.”

The full video of the Baal burning was posted on X, where the image of the giant calf can be seen with red eyes and the Star of David on its head. The number “666” is also seen near the statue’s feet, an Israeli flag along the bottom, and hieroglyphics on one of the posts nearby. Protesters then began throwing stones at the statue. An image of Donald Trump can be seen next to it as well, before it was set ablaze.

The statue was then knocked down after having the fire put

out, and crowds cheered. The video concluded with a written message:

We, the monotheists of the world, by the help of God, will bring down the worshipers of Baal, the worshipers of Satan, and the arrogant oppressors.

The imagery and messaging surrounding this demonstration appear to send a direct geopolitical and ideological signal.

For decades, Iranian leadership and state-aligned movements have used the terms “Great Satan” to refer to America and “Little Satan” to refer to Israel, framing both nations as primary spiritual and political adversaries. The meaning was made clear: Jewish and Christian worldviews are not welcome by the Islamic-run Iranian government.

From a biblical prophecy perspective, moments like this align with patterns described in Scripture about nations rising in opposition to Israel and to the values historically associated with Judeo-Christian foundations. The Bible repeatedly calls Christians to remain watchful, rooted in truth and grounded in faith during times of deception and global upheaval.

Events like these act as reminders that there really is a spiritual war happening, the world will turn away from Israel,

and the events of the end times will take place.

New Era in North Korea? Kim Jong Un Announces Successor

North Korean dictator Kim Jong Un has finally announced who will take his place in power.

In a BBC report, it was noted that Jong Un has selected his teenage daughter, Kim Ju Ae, as his heir. She previously went with her father to visit Beijing.

As the national intelligence service (NIS) noted, a “range of circumstances” was taken into account in this decision, including her growing presence at North Korean events. The BBC noted that the NIS plans to “keep close tabs on whether she will attend the North’s party congress later this month.”

Lee Seong-kwen, a lawmaker, stated that Ju Ae has finally reached the “successor designation” stage of her training with her father.

UFO Document Reveals Decades-Old Government Secrets

Chuck Pierce Reveals the Biblical Key to Unlocking Blessing and Breakthrough

For many, Scriptures like Isaiah 54:17 are familiar territory. They are quoted in prayer, posted on social media and spoken during difficult seasons. In a recent video, Katie Souza urged Christians to move beyond simply reciting these verses and to truly believe in and apply them as spiritual weapons.

At the heart of Souza's message is the connection between faith, hearing the Word of God and walking in the authority Christ has already secured. As Souza emphasizes, transformation begins internally before it manifests externally. "Once you start really believing... you're going to start to see stuff break off of you that has been there for a long time."

Central to this teaching is Isaiah 54:17: “No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper.” Yet the message challenges listeners with a piercing question: Do believers actually live like they believe that promise?

“Do we really believe that there’s no weapon that can prosper... that the enemy can bring against us?” Souza asks. “I don’t think we do.”

Rather than passively reacting to spiritual attacks, she urges Christians to actively stand in Christ’s finished work. Souza stresses that victory is rooted not in personal goodness, but in Christ’s righteousness imputed to believers. “My righteousness is not from me. It’s from the Lord,” Souza declares. “And guess what? Now, none of these weapons... cannot prosper. It will fail because I am righteous in Christ.”

This framework shifts spiritual warfare from striving to standing. Instead of begging God to act, believers are called to enforce what Jesus has already accomplished through the cross. “Stop asking God to take care of everything for you because He’s given you the power,” Souza says. “He wants us to mature as believers.”

She also ties spiritual authority to repentance and alignment with God. Believers are encouraged to ask God to reveal any spiritual “landing strip” that might allow the enemy access. “If there’s something in me that’s allowing this weapon... show it to me right now. And I cover it with the blood.”

Beyond defense, the teaching also addresses God’s promises and blessings. Drawing from James 1:17 and Ephesians 1:3, Souza emphasizes that God’s nature is to give good gifts—and that delays do not equal denial.

“Every good gift and every perfect... gift is from above,” she quotes, adding encouragement for those waiting on promises. “If God spoke to you, then He’s going to give it to you... But He’s going to give it to you in His perfect time.”

She further encourages Christians not to abandon hope when fulfillment seems delayed. Instead, they are called to actively “war with the prophetic word” through faith declarations. “I won’t stop believing and decreeing,” Souza says. “Every perfect, free, large, full gift is from above... and they’re coming.”

Ultimately, Souza’s message returns to Christ’s finished work as the foundation for both victory and blessing. Faith is described as legal ownership of God’s promises—even before manifestation. “Faith is the title deed,” she says. “And I release my faith through my decrees.”

The call to action for Christians is unmistakable: Study Scripture deeply, believe it fully and wield it boldly.

Is the Modern Church Losing Spiritual Discernment? Pastor Warns of Unhealthy Christian

The late David Wilkerson didn't hold back when he spoke about the Great Deception that would be coming for the church.

In a previous message, Wilkerson gave a dire warning from 1 Timothy 4, which he said had been "burning" in his spirit: the last days will be marked by a relentless, spiritual pull away from Christ.

Reading from Scripture, Wilkerson declared, "Now the spirit speaketh expressly that in the latter time shall some depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits and doctrines of devils" (1 Tim. 4:1). Then he explained what "expressly" means: "outspoken clarity...leaving no doubt that in the last days, the days in which we live right now, there is going to be a departing from the faith. There's going to be a great seduction taking place."

Wilkerson believed this end-time seduction wouldn't just be seen in blatant wickedness, but in an "overwhelming satanic seduction" designed to creep into the church—slowly, subtly—until hearts are cold and consciences numb. He pointed to Jesus' warning about deception so intense it could "deceive the very elect."

"Just look around you," he said, describing how modern technology can become a pipeline for temptation. "You don't have to go to a house of harlotry...But right there in your home is that pornography and that evil right there. A wicked wonder."

But Wilkerson insisted the devil can't simply barge into a believer's life without an opening. "Satan cannot seduce you

until he sees you peeking over the wall," he warned.

In his message, he painted a vivid picture of God's protection as a spiritual boundary: "He shall be to her...a wall of fire roundabout in the glory therein." The safest place, Wilkerson said, is not flirting with that boundary, but living near the center—close to Jesus.

And what causes believers to drift toward the wall? Wilkerson was blunt: "The seduction begins with a spiritual laziness, becoming careless about reading the Word of God and neglecting His Word and prayer, neglecting going to the house of God." He testified that when people finally tell the truth about their backsliding, it almost always comes down to that neglect.

Then he delivered what may be the message's most memorable line: "This is the best defense against satanic seduction. Because when you are satisfied with Jesus, the word spreads all through hell. Don't go near him. Don't go near her. That person's satisfied."

Yet Wilkerson warned that once someone toys with sin, the enemy often supplies "a doctrine" to justify it—spiritual-sounding excuses that shift blame and promise an easy return. "If you've got that hook in you now," he cautioned, "I'm telling you that is the biggest lie you have ever bought." Why? "Every time you sin, your heart gets harder and harder...until finally you won't come back."

Still, he ended with hope and urgency. "Don't wait another day," Wilkerson pleaded. "Lay it down and run to Jesus tonight." He prayed for God to "break the power of seduction" and to restore what sin tries to steal—"the music of peace and rest and joy...and bring the light of the gospel back."
