

JD Vance Reveals Final Meeting With Pope Francis, Gets in Fiery Clash on The View

Vice President JD Vance found himself defending both his faith and the Trump administration's policies during a spirited appearance on ABC's *The View*, right after new details emerged from his memoir about a final meeting with Pope Francis before the pontiff's death.

The interview touched on topics ranging from inflation and immigration to race, faith and the Epstein files, offering insight into how Vance views the intersection of politics and religion.

According to a report by *The Independent*, Vance's new memoir, *Communion: Finding My Way Back to Faith*, recounts an Easter Sunday meeting with Pope Francis in April 2025, less than a day before the pope's death. Vance wrote that Francis appeared "more fragile than I realized" but remained gracious, giving gifts to Vance's children during the encounter.

The *Independent* also reported that Vance described a meeting with Vatican Secretary of State Cardinal Pietro Parolin in which he became frustrated by what he viewed as vague responses from Vatican officials regarding immigration policy.

According to the report, Vance argued that church leaders discussed moral principles but declined to identify specific U.S. immigration policies they opposed.

Similar issues surfaced during Vance's appearance on The View.

During a discussion about immigration enforcement, co-hosts challenged Vance on the administration's border policies and ICE operations. In response, Vance argued that border security and compassion should coexist.

"The Christian faith," Vance said, "says that you can have borders."

Vance told the hosts that nations have both a right and a responsibility to enforce immigration laws while treating people with dignity. He also argued that failing to secure the border can contribute to human trafficking and exploitation by criminal organizations.

Vance also reflected on his spiritual journey from evangelical Christianity to atheism and ultimately to Catholicism. He also addressed past controversies, including his previous criticism of President Donald Trump.

When asked about his earlier opposition to Trump, Vance said he had changed his perspective after observing what he considered successful policies during Trump's first administration.

"I was wrong about him," Vance said during the interview.

Vance also pushed back against claims that Christians have compromised biblical values in supporting Trump. He argued that media coverage had often misrepresented the president and said his own views evolved after taking a closer look at Trump's record.

These conversations that the vice president has been engaged in point to a broader challenge: how to discuss cultural and political issues while remaining grounded in biblical conviction, truth and grace.

Pentagon Files Reveal Mysterious 'Mother Orb' Releasing Smaller Objects Near US Security Site

A newly disclosed government case involving strange aerial objects near a protected U.S. security site is reigniting public debate over unidentified anomalous phenomena and what may be operating in American airspace.

According to reporting from Fox News, recently released Pentagon and FBI records detail an October 2023 incident in which multiple federal law enforcement personnel observed unusual glowing objects near a sensitive government location in the western United States.

Witnesses described seeing a large orange-colored orb suspended above a ridgeline. During the observation, the object reportedly released several smaller red orbs that moved away from it and traveled independently.

The sighting was reportedly witnessed by more than one federal agent over the course of two evenings. Investigators documented descriptions of the objects moving in coordinated ways while producing no audible sound.

The case is among a collection of newly disclosed UAP files made public as part of ongoing government transparency efforts surrounding unidentified aerial incidents.

Fox News reported that officials examined potential explanations for the incident, including drone activity, atmospheric events, military operations and foreign technology. However, investigators were unable to reach a firm conclusion regarding what the agents observed.

While the Pentagon continues to analyze such reports through official channels, the broader conversation has increasingly captured the attention of researchers and the public alike.

For believers, however, the significance of these reports extends beyond questions of aerospace technology.

The Bible repeatedly emphasizes the importance of spiritual discernment in times of uncertainty. Dinesh D'Souza and Rick Renner Sound Alarm on Deception, Antichrist and the End Times

Prophetic voice Amanda Grace is sounding an alarm over what she believes is a significant spiritual convergence taking place in America this summer.

During a recent broadcast titled "The Iran Deal and Altars Being Raised," Grace pointed to a series of developments—including reports of the latest agreement, the opening of the Obama Presidential Center in Chicago, America's upcoming 250th anniversary celebrations and the FIFA World Cup—as events believers should watch closely through a biblical lens.

"The timing of this Iran deal and something Obama is doing is on a course to completely all converge in this very short period of time," Grace said.

Much of Grace's message focused on the June 19 opening of the Obama Presidential Center. While many view the project simply as a presidential library and museum, Grace argued that it represents something much deeper spiritually.

“There is an altar being built in America out of Chicago,” she said.

Throughout the broadcast, Grace repeatedly referenced biblical accounts involving Baal worship, Gideon and Jehu, drawing parallels between Old Testament spiritual battles and what she believes are modern-day attempts to influence nations and cultures.

She pointed to Judges 6, where Gideon was instructed to tear down an altar to Baal and build an altar to the Lord in its place. Grace suggested this biblical principle remains relevant today as believers seek God's direction for America.

The prophetic commentator also examined reports surrounding a proposed agreement between the United States and Iran. Referencing Persia's role in Ezekiel 38, Grace argued that current developments in the Middle East should be viewed carefully by Christians seeking to understand unfolding world events.

At the same time, she highlighted what she described as an unusual convergence of major events, including the opening of the Obama Presidential Center, international sporting events and national celebrations surrounding America's 250th anniversary.

These developments are not random.

“We need to pray because these components coming together are not an accident,” she said.

Grace also repeatedly emphasized that believers should respond with prayer rather than fear.

She encouraged Christians to seek the Lord for discernment and

to remain grounded in Scripture as they navigate an increasingly complex cultural and political landscape.

“This is why we have to pray for the president. This is why we have to pray for the cabinet. This is why we have to pray and intercede for the nation,” Grace said.

The broadcast concluded with a call for believers to deepen their prayer lives, study God’s Word and remain spiritually alert.

As national and global events continue to unfold, Grace believes the church’s greatest responsibility is not panic, but prayer–trusting that God remains sovereign over nations, leaders and every season ahead.

‘God Still Heals’: Jeremiah Johnston Opens Up About Son’s Supernatural Recovery

For parents facing a frightening medical diagnosis, few words carry more weight than those spoken by doctors about a child’s future. When Christian apologist and author Jeremiah Johnston

heard those words, they became an invitation to trust God for what seemed impossible.

During a recent podcast appearance on Josh Howerton's platform, Johnston shared a deeply personal testimony he says he had not previously discussed on a podcast: the remarkable healing of his son, Abel, who had been diagnosed with chronic scoliosis.

Johnston recalled a difficult season for his family when Abel, the oldest of his triplets, was receiving treatment at Scottish Rite Hospital in Texas. According to Johnston, doctors told the family that the specialized cast Abel wore for 12 hours each day was not expected to heal his condition.

"They told us at Scottish Rite that the cast he had to wear for 12 hours a day would not heal his body," Johnston said. "They said it will just help him from having to get steel rods from his chronic scoliosis."

Faced with that prognosis, Johnston turned to prayer.

"I believe in praying big prayers," he said.

As he prepared to submit a manuscript he had dedicated to Abel, Johnston invited his son to participate in the milestone moment. He allowed Abel to click the mouse that finalized the manuscript submission, then prayed a simple yet bold prayer.

"And I said, 'Lord, will You heal our son?'"

Johnston said the family intentionally kept the situation private, sharing it only with their pastor. Rather than opening the matter to widespread discussion, they chose to quietly trust God while continuing Abel's treatment.

At the center of that decision was Johnston's unwavering belief in God's power to intervene.

"In the Holy Spirit, I believe in a God who heals," he said. "I believe in Jesus, that Jesus heals."

Then came the moment that changed everything.

Johnston said that during a follow-up visit to Scottish Rite, doctors examined Abel's spine and discovered something the family never expected.

"The same week that my book hit the No. 1 New York Times bestseller list, we go to the Scottish Rite, and his spine is as straight as an arrow," Johnston said.

The memory still moves him.

"I have chills telling you this," he added.

The family left the hospital rejoicing.

"We're praising Jesus all the way home."

Today, Johnston says Abel signs copies of the book that was dedicated to him because he believes God honored the faith of a young boy who loves Jesus.

"I believe God honored him, a 9-year-old who loves Jesus," Johnston said.

For Johnston, the testimony is ultimately not about a book, a bestseller list or even his family's journey. It is about pointing people to the healing power of Christ.

"I've been waiting for a big podcast to share that story—that God still heals."

Abel's testimony serves as a reminder that it is critical to

continue to pray for miracles even in the midst of difficult diagnoses and uncertain circumstances. His message to families walking through similar trials is simple: keep trusting God.

FBI Foils Alleged Explosive Drone, Sniper Attack Plan Targeting White House UFC Event

Federal authorities say a potentially devastating attack targeting the UFC event at the White House was stopped before it could be carried out.

According to a report from Fox News, the FBI recently disrupted what officials described as an alleged plot involving drones with explosives that were reportedly intended to target the UFC Freedom 250 held on White House grounds. The event was part of celebrations surrounding America's 250th anniversary and was expected to draw large crowds.

FBI Director Kash Patel announced that law enforcement agencies uncovered the threat days before the event and

launched a coordinated operation to prevent it from unfolding.

Right now, five individuals have been placed in custody, with a total of 23 others considered part of the plot. According to Fox, this plan would have used the drones to “hit buildings near the event, force a mass evacuation and steer crowds toward a pre-staged sniper team.” A “second wave” was believed to be planned, including an attack on the White House.

Is This Lucifer's Greatest Weapon? The Industry That Reaches Billions

As renewed interest in UFO disclosure continues to capture public attention, Donné Clement Petruska believes Christians should be paying attention to something even bigger: the prophetic warnings her father shared years ago.

During a recent episode of Code Breakers Live, Petruska discussed everything from UFO narratives and Aleister Crowley's infamous "Lam" encounter to government disclosures and spiritual deception. Woven throughout the discussion was a recurring theme from the ministry of her late father, prophetic minister Kim Clement.

Petruska noted that many are suggesting Christians could be shaken by growing interest in extraterrestrials and UFO phenomena. She disagrees.

"I don't think so. I really don't," she said.

Instead, she argued that if unexplained entities exist, they may fit more closely within a biblical understanding of the spiritual realm than many realize.

"I do lean toward, if there are some kind of alien beings, that they are interdimensional," Petruska said.

The discussion led her back to one of Kim Clement's most

discussed prophetic words, delivered Feb. 22, 2014, in which he described a time when “scales” would be removed from people’s eyes and hidden realities would begin to come into view.

“I was standing in my garden. Suddenly the Spirit came, removed from my eyes scales,” Clement prophesied.

Petruska suggested current debates surrounding UFO disclosure, government transparency and spiritual questions may be part of a broader unveiling taking place in society.

She also revisited another portion of that same prophecy in which her father spoke of a future leader who would strongly support Israel.

“This man will throttle the enemies of Israel,” Clement declared.

He also prophesied intense political opposition, saying critics would cry, “Impeach, impeach,” while insisting that the effort would ultimately fail.

Later in the broadcast, Petruska played a video compilation highlighting numerous Kim Clement prophecies that supporters believe have been fulfilled, including his well-known statements that “Trump shall become a trumpet” and that a future president would be used by God in unexpected ways.

“Trump shall become a trumpet, says the Lord,” Clement famously prophesied years before Donald Trump entered the White House.

The discussion came as Petruska examined the growing fascination with UFO disclosure and Aleister Crowley’s alleged encounter with an entity called “Lam.” Crowley claimed to have contacted the being during occult rituals in 1918 and later produced a sketch that many have compared to modern depictions of gray aliens.

For Petruska, the similarities raise important spiritual questions. Yet she repeatedly emphasized that Christians should not allow fear to drive their response.

“The enemy would love to fill us with doubt and fear,” she said.

As questions surrounding UFOs, spiritual realities and world events continue to grow, Petruska’s message was clear: the answer is not fear, but discernment—and a willingness to view current events through a biblical lens.
