

Palantir, PayPal and Prophecy: Pastor Connects Billionaire Peter Thiel to End-Time Signs

As technology, surveillance and global control continue to dominate headlines, many believers are asking whether today's innovations are laying the groundwork for the Antichrist.

In a recent video, Pastor Kap Chatfield addressed growing speculation around tech billionaire Peter Thiel, highlighting eerie parallels between Thiel's work and [prophetic warnings found in Scripture](#).

"Is this tech billionaire Peter Thiel the Antichrist?" Chatfield asked. "A lot of people all over the internet are asking this question, especially after this interview came out where he openly talked about transhumanism and he kind of hinted at the fact that he's not totally against the idea of depopulating the globe."

Thiel, co-founder of PayPal and Palantir, has made public comments about the Antichrist and the rise of global surveillance. In one interview, Thiel speculated: "The Antichrist will talk about Armageddon all the time. He'll scare people then offer to save them."

Chatfield pointed to 1 Thessalonians 5:3: "For when they say, 'Peace and safety!' then sudden destruction comes upon them..." He suggested that while Thiel appears to be issuing warnings, it's worth asking whether he is also contributing to the very system he seems to fear.

“Could you possibly be creating the very technology that you’re warning everybody about?” Chatfield said. “When you say, ‘Oh peace and safety, this technology is for your good,’ and then sudden destruction comes upon everybody when the surveillance state is created.”

Palantir, the company Thiel co-founded, develops surveillance systems used by governments and law enforcement, including ICE. The company's name is derived from the "Palantír," a mystical seeing orb used by evil forces in The Lord of the Rings. Chatfield questioned the symbolism: "Is it just poetic? [Or is there a spirit behind what they're doing](#) that they might not even be aware of?"

He also referenced Daniel 11:37, which says the Antichrist will "regard neither the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women." Thiel was raised Lutheran and is in a same-sex marriage. "He hasn't publicly professed his faith and he's

also living a godless lifestyle,” Chatfield said. “So is he a guy who doesn’t regard the God of his fathers?”

Despite these concerns, Chatfield urged viewers not to attack or condemn Thiel but to pray for him. “People like this are people that Jesus paid a high price for on the cross,” he said.

Rather than stir fear, Chatfield said his purpose is to equip believers to respond biblically to the times. He laid out five key biblical responses to help Christians remain spiritually grounded and alert.

5 Biblical Responses to the End Times

1. Be Discerning and Not Deceived

“Stop scrolling more on social media than you’re spending time in the word of God and in prayer and in the house of God,” Chatfield said. Citing 2 Thessalonians 2:3, he emphasized the need to stay rooted in Scripture: “Let no one deceive you by any means, for that day will not come unless the falling away comes first and the man of sin is revealed...”

2. Stay Filled with the Holy Spirit

Chatfield explained that the Holy Spirit is currently restraining the rise of lawlessness in the world. “The Holy Spirit of God, the third person of the Godhead in the church, the people of God is what is restraining the full rise of evil,” he said, referencing 2 Thessalonians 2:7.

3. Live Holy and Ready

“We gotta live holy and ready,” Chatfield urged. Referencing 1 John 3:3 and Matthew 25:6, he added: “Behold, the bridegroom is coming... Go out to meet him.” He warned viewers not to delay

obedience or take sin lightly.

4. Focus on the Mission, Not the Mayhem

Pointing to Luke 19:13, Chatfield encouraged Christians to stay mission-minded: “Do business till I come.” He challenged believers to stay active in the work of the gospel. “Get off your butt. Stop scrolling. Go to church. Go to your job. Make disciples. Preach the gospel. Lay hands on the sick. Cast out devils. Raise the dead.”

5. Look for Jesus, Not Just the Beast

“My challenge to you is to look for Jesus. Don’t look for the beast,” Chatfield said, quoting Titus 2:13: “Looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ.” He reminded viewers that prophecy is meant to prepare, not to paralyze.

“He’s not telling us this stuff to scare us,” Chatfield concluded, “but to prepare us.”

Bishop Alan DiDio: We Are Living in the Days of Noah

Bishop Alan DiDio joined Joni Lamb on a recent episode of Joni

Table Talk to discuss the prophetic signs of the end times, warning viewers that we are living in a moment strikingly similar [to the days of Noah and Lot](#) – yet encouraging believers that they do not need to fear, because God offers safety through Jesus Christ.

“You don’t need to be fearful about this because God is going to keep you safe in the ark of safety, His son, Jesus Christ,” DiDio said. “All you have to do is say yes to Him... Jesus, I’m all yours.”

Referencing Matthew 24, DiDio pointed out that just as Noah and Lot were supernaturally rescued from judgment, God has a plan to rescue His people – what the Bible refers to as the rapture. “This is what the rapture is about,” he said. “God wants to see you so bad that before He has to do all this stuff on the Earth, He’s going to take you to be with Him in heaven.”

DiDio also spoke about the story of Enoch, describing it as a biblical example of rapture: “The Bible said he walked with God so closely that God said, ‘I need you here in heaven with me.’ I want that to be your testimony.”

During the program, he addressed Jesus’ parable of the 10 virgins, noting a symbolic meaning in the five wise and five foolish virgins. “The virgins are not the bride,” he explained. “They are to prepare the bride. Is this dealing with the five-fold ministry office gifts? The apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, and teacher? That there are five who will prepare the bride to meet the bridegroom – and five who won’t.”

DiDio encouraged viewers to remain spiritually prepared, filled with the Holy Spirit, [and focused on Christ's imminent return.](#) "We've got to stay full of the Holy Spirit. We've got to stay full of that oil."

He also highlighted an overlooked truth about the book of Revelation. "The number one subject in Revelation is the number seven," DiDio said. "If you understand the number seven, the fear gets removed from the book of Revelation. It means divine perfection and completion... God is going to finish His work."

He passionately advocated for a renewed focus on eternal life and biblical hope. "Preachers have been sold a lie that if they talk about this, people will turn off – and that's not the case. Forty-two percent of Americans, not just Christians, believe they're living in the last days."

DiDio tied together current global developments with biblical prophecy, suggesting that both revival and apostasy are increasing simultaneously. "Joel 2 says, 'I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh in the last days.' We're in that time. It's the two-minute warning."

Despite the sobering signs – technological advances, gene splicing, and societal indifference to judgment – DiDio offered reassurance. "Let not your heart be troubled. Jesus has prepared a place for you and He's just about to come and get you."

“The second coming final phase is Jesus coming back with His church,” he added. “But He can’t come back with His church until He comes back for His church.”

DiDio’s message clearly shows us that the time is short, the signs are evident, but those who trust in Jesus Christ can live in hope, not fear.

Perry Stone: Shaking in the Church Reveals Who Will Stand in the End Times

At the International Prophetic Summit, evangelist Perry Stone delivered a sobering message about the shaking taking place in churches and ministries, connecting current global unrest to [prophetic events leading to Jesus’ return](#).

Referencing Hebrews 12:25-29, Stone emphasized that God is allowing a shaking “so that that which cannot be shaken will remain standing at the very end.”

Stone warned that the world is seeing the fulfillment of several end-times signs, each pointing to the nearing end of the age and the return of Jesus Christ. He cited four prophetic events described in Scripture that are converging:

1. Global Preaching of the Gospel

Stone pointed to Matthew 24:14, which states, “And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.”

“This is not just local,” Stone said. “It’s global. The gospel of the kingdom will be preached around the world globally, and then the end will come.” He emphasized the expansion of evangelism through technology and media, calling it a major prophetic indicator.

2. Worldwide Outpouring of the Holy Spirit

Referencing Joel 2:28-29, Stone quoted the Lord’s promise: “I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh.”

“This is happening actually,” he said. “All flesh indicates that it’s global—it’s every nation of the world. That is part of what is about to happen and is already happening.”

3. The Great Falling Away

Turning to 2 Thessalonians 2:1-3, Stone discussed the prophesied apostasy: “That day shall not come, except there come a falling away first.”

“The primary meaning of ‘apostasia’ is for someone to revolt against something or for there to be a defection from absolute truth,” Stone said. “There will be... a final departure from truth so severe that in Luke 18:8 Jesus makes this statement: ‘When the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?’”

4. Widespread Offense and Betrayal

Drawing from Matthew 24:10-12, Stone described an atmosphere of offense, betrayal, and lawlessness that will affect believers. “There is this season of betrayal and offense that becomes so great around the earth that it affects people spiritually,” he said.

He also warned of widespread deception, noting, “Deception is mentioned four times in Matthew 24. It means to roam away from—to slowly begin to step away from truth, the presence of God, and the Word.”

Stone argued that many believers are not abandoning their faith in God but are losing faith in people who claim to represent Him. “Most people who were ever offended in a church were never offended by God nor were they offended by the Holy Spirit nor were they offended by Jesus,” he said. “But they were offended by somebody in the church acting a certain way toward them.”

He also emphasized the danger of invisible sins in the church: “Sins of the spirit are just as negative and bad as sins of the flesh. It’s not what you’re eating—it’s what’s eating you.”

As false prophets rise and deception grows, Stone encouraged believers to remain rooted in biblical truth. “Everybody that wants to be a prophet—you better understand something: no prophet in the Old Testament was ever appreciated,” he said. “Sometimes those who really carry a word are not going to be popular.”

Stone reminded listeners that knowledge will increase in the last days, fulfilling Daniel’s prophecy: “God has reserved the revelation of many prophetic mysteries for the time of the end, a time when knowledge shall increase.”

Are Fallen Angels Behind Today's Technological Explosion?

In a recent episode of Prophecy Watchers, host Brandon Holthaus sat down with Josh Peck to discuss the rapid rise in spiritual deception [and technological advancement](#), warning that both may be linked to demonic influence.

Peck, who came out of the New Age movement, noted that many who interact with the spiritual realm, whether through psychedelics, occult practices or meditation, are receiving what they describe as downloads of advanced knowledge. As this restraint lifts, manifestations of the supernatural, such as UFO sightings and reports of cryptid creatures, are

becoming more common and harder to dismiss.

Red Heifer Burned in Israel: What It Means for Bible Prophecy

A recent event in Israel has caught the attention of the world, again. A red heifer was burned in Samaria, an act that, [while not official temple protocol,](#) echoes the ancient purification rites detailed in Scripture and points toward significant prophetic implications.

Though the heifer used was disqualified from being the actual one used for future temple purification due to minor

imperfections, the ceremony itself was carried out according to the biblical guidelines found in Numbers 19. In this passage, God commands that a red heifer “without blemish and upon which never came a yoke” be offered, with its ashes used to ritually cleanse and prepare the priests for service in the temple.

This practice run is not just symbolic, it reflects growing momentum within Israel to reestablish the conditions necessary for the restoration of temple worship.

Since 2022, five red heifers have been brought from Texas to Israel. The recent burning, conducted under rabbinic supervision, is seen by many as a tangible step toward reviving the ancient purification system [required for priestly service in a future third temple.](#)

Why does this matter to Christians? Because key end-times prophecies point to the existence of a third temple during the tribulation period. Could Iran Become a Beacon of Christianity in the Last Days?

As tensions continue to swirl in the Middle East, a surprising spiritual movement may be quietly unfolding [behind the borders of Iran](#). Best-selling author and Middle East expert Joel Rosenberg believes a powerful biblical prophecy is taking shape that could place Iran at the center of a global Christian awakening.

As reported in the exclusive video, Rosenberg believes the prophecy began its fulfillment in 1979, when millions of Iranians fled the country following the rise of Ayatollah Khomeini. “They fled out of Iran to all ends of the earth. There wasn’t a country to which Iranian people did not flee to get away,” he said. This, he contends, mirrors the scattering foretold in verse 36: “I will scatter them to the four winds.”

But it’s not just dispersion and judgment that Jeremiah foretells. The final verse of the passage offers hope: “In the last days, I will restore the fortunes of Elam.” Rosenberg interprets this as a promise of revival.

“More Muslims have come to faith in Jesus Christ in Iran than all Muslims who’ve ever come to faith in Jesus in the last 14 centuries combined,” Rosenberg said. “Iran is basically going to become a Christian country, not a backslidden, corrupt Christian country, but the most dynamic, exciting, spiritual, Spirit-led country on the planet.”

Rosenberg acknowledged the current reality of persecution in

Iran but believes that God will transform even that suffering into spiritual fire. “That revolutionary fervor that Iranians are famous for... the Holy Spirit is going to flip it... into taking the gospel to the ends of the earth.”

In the face of hardship, the gospel continues to flourish. God’s work is not confined by regimes or repression, it advances boldly in the very places meant to silence it.

Dr. Phil’s Media Company Files Lawsuit Against TBN Amid Bankruptcy

On the same day it filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy, [Dr. Phil McGraw’s](#) media venture, Merit Street Media, launched a breach of contract lawsuit against the Trinity Broadcasting Network, alleging sabotage and financial misconduct that the company claims led to its financial collapse.

The lawsuit, filed in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Texas, accuses TBN of failing to meet contractual obligations and intentionally undermining the

partnership.

Merit Street, a joint venture formed in 2023 between McGraw's Peteski Productions and TBN, launched Merit TV in April 2024 with the goal of becoming a major player in the cable and streaming landscape through programming [like Dr. Phil Primetime.](#)

As reported by Ministry Watch, the complaint claims that TBN failed to provide the promised national distribution of Merit Street's content, which was allegedly "the linchpin of the agreement." The suit further states that TBN's actions "were a conscious, intentional pattern of choices made with full awareness that the consequence of which was to sabotage and seal the fate of a new but already nationally acclaimed network."

The filing also accuses TBN of abusing its position as majority stakeholder by imposing unsustainable financial obligations on Merit Street and failing to provide adequate production services. Examples cited include "comically dysfunctional" production support such as faulty video editing equipment and malfunctioning teleprompters.

Merit Street claims these issues contributed to significant operational disruption, leading to the June 2025 layoff of 40 employees and the hiatus of its flagship show.

The case will continue in bankruptcy court, where Merit Street is also pursuing claims against TCT Ministries, another TBN-affiliated entity. A separate hearing will determine whether a \$25-million promissory note assigned to TCT was an improper preferential payment. Proceedings on that claim are expected to continue through the end of July.

Pastor Troy Brewer: Texas Floods Are a Prophetic Warning for America

In a recent episode of The Pulse, Pastor Troy Brewer shared a powerful prophetic perspective on [the devastating Texas floods](#), declaring the event to be “a word for the United States of America.” Brewer emphasized the timing of the flooding on July 4 as a divine signal, saying, “Whenever this thing happened on July the 4th... this is not just about Texas. “This is the place where the heavens cross,” he said, referring to the intersection of the October 2023 and April 2024 solar eclipses over that region. [“Our hope is in Jesus. Our hope is in the resurrection power of the Lord Jesus Christ.”](#) He further noted the prophetic meaning of the flood victims’ rescue count: “Do you know that there are 888 people rescued out of that river?... 888 is the number of Jesus.”

Beyond the symbolism, Brewer warned of a spiritual war being waged against the nation’s children. “The wolf is after our children. The woke demonic agenda to sexualize our children and to sweep them away is something that we see happening on a daily basis.” He believes this tragedy, though heartbreaking, may serve as a catalyst for national revival.

House Swept Downstream With Family Inside: Harrowing Texas Flood Survival Story

In a gripping interview with CBS Austin, Jason Mcham shared the terrifying story of how his home was swept away during the recent Texas floods—with his entire family still inside.

“The house broke loose, hit the tree, spun around, and floated down here,” Mcham told CBS Austin. “And so we’re floating inside the house.”

It all began early in the morning when his family received a flash flood alert. “We got a notification that a severe flash flood was coming our way,” he recalled. “I got up and looked out the window and I said, ‘Hey, there’s a little bit of water on the street,’ which is very typical in this neighborhood. I’ve lived here all my life.”

But within moments, things turned deadly. “Then the electricity went off. I opened the back door and water was already over the top of our AC unit outside fixing to come in the house. I shut the door. We got everybody up, got clothes on, and then the next thing we know, our house is filling up with water.”

The floodwaters dislodged the house from its foundation, turning it into a vessel adrift in the darkness. “It was dark, so we didn’t know exactly where we were going to end up,” Mcham said. “And of course, the house was falling apart. Water’s pouring in from everywhere. Tree limbs poked through the back wall back there. Tore out the whole back corner of

the house.”

With his wife and two daughters by his side, Mcham said they climbed to the highest point they could reach. “All we did was get up here by this window,” he said. “We were scared and we were doing a bunch of praying.”

After about three hours trapped inside the crumbling home, [the family was rescued by emergency responders around 8:30 a.m.](#) “Everybody down here, we couldn’t get out. It was a raging river coming through here,” Mcham said. “We had waited in about waist-deep water and got out. The fire department got us all out and took us to the community center.”

When he returned later in the day, the scope of devastation left him speechless. “We were like, ‘Oh my gosh, we were devastated,’” he said. “I knew my place was bad, but I didn’t know how bad my dad’s house was on the corner and all these other places.”

Yet in the midst of destruction, Mcham said he was overwhelmed by the outpouring of support. “All the neighbors, they’ve been so good to us,” he said. “My boss that I work for, all my co-workers, all my subcontractors, they have all been calling me, my builders that I work with, all calling me wanting to come help. It just breaks my heart to see how many people down here helping all of us, just giving us their free labor. Man, it’s amazing. It’s amazing.”

Though Mcham and his family were spared, [many others across Texas are mourning lost loved ones](#) and destroyed homes. “We

need help,” he pleaded. “A lot of us are homeless. We have nowhere to go. Some of them have flood insurance, some of them don’t.”

In the chaos and confusion, Mcham credits prayer for guiding them through. “We were doing a bunch of praying... watching the water rise and saying our prayers that nobody died.”

Jewish Worship Returns to the Temple Mount: A Prophetic Milestone Unfolds in Real Time

[For the first time since the destruction of the second temple](#) nearly 2,000 years ago, Jewish worshippers are being allowed to sing and dance openly across the entire

A Key Step Toward the Third Temple

The restoration of Jewish worship on the Temple Mount [aligns directly with several key biblical prophecies](#). In the book of Revelation, chapter 11 describes a time when a temple will once again stand in Jerusalem, a place where worshippers will gather and where the outer court will be given over to the Gentiles for a time. This vision implies the existence of a functioning temple that, until now, has remained only a prophetic promise.

Similarly, in Matthew 24, Jesus speaks of the “abomination of desolation” standing in the holy place, a reference to a future desecration of a restored temple. While the second temple was destroyed in A.D. 70, that event appears to have been only a shadow of what is to come. The restoration of worship on the Temple Mount is seen by many as the first visible step toward the eventual rebuilding of that third

temple.

The prophet Daniel also wrote of a future ruler who would make a covenant for seven years, only to break it halfway through by putting an end to temple sacrifices. This, too, presumes that a temple and sacrificial system will be in place, further emphasizing the significance of renewed Jewish worship on the mount.

Setting the Stage for the Final Events

The apostle Paul, in 2 Thessalonians, warned of a coming "man of lawlessness" who would exalt himself above every god and set himself up in the temple of God, claiming to be God. This ultimate act of desecration is central to end-times prophecy and again requires a functioning temple in Jerusalem.

What was once thought impossible due to political and religious opposition now appears increasingly plausible. With Jewish worship reinstated, the spiritual and governmental climate in Israel is shifting in a way that could soon allow for the physical rebuilding of the temple.

These aren't symbolic or metaphorical trends, they are real, measurable events playing out on the world stage just as Scripture foretold.
