Here are the defining characteristics of a resurrected life:

## 1. Love for Others, Even the Difficult Ones

“You walk in love, genuine love. You're patient, kind towards people, even those who are difficult or challenging.”

This kind of love goes beyond emotions—it's about living like Jesus when it's not easy.

## 2. Boldness in Faith

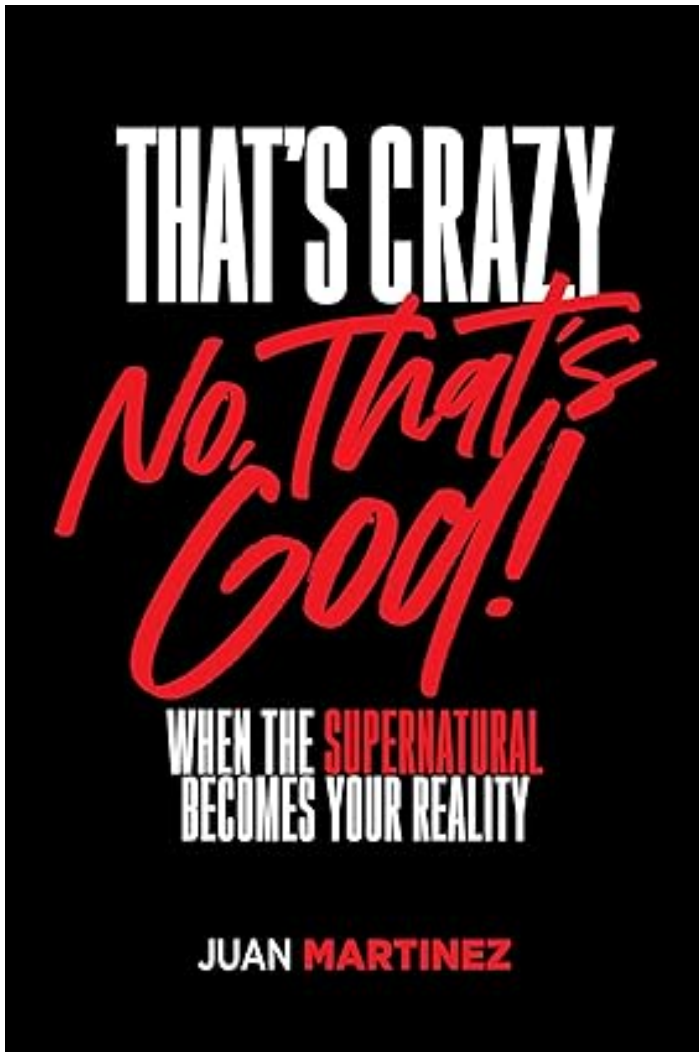
“You speak and you act bold for Christ even in uncomfortable and intimidating circumstances.”

Martinez challenged the timid: “In the beginning, it's going to sound kind of crazy. You do it again and again and again and again.”

### 3. Supernatural Peace

“You remain calm and you trust God deeply during trials and uncertainty.”

According to Martinez, this peace isn't natural—it's resurrection-level calm in the middle of life's chaos.

### 4. Joy in Serving Others

“You volunteer to do unnoticed tasks. You serve behind the scenes. You find joy in simply blessing someone else.”

It's not about being seen, he said: “It's a joy for you to do

it. It's not a job."

## 5. Self-Control Under Pressure

"I listen to him and I look like I have a lot of self-control. Really, he has all the self-control."

Martinez was clear—discipline isn't willpower; it's the fruit of surrendering to Jesus.

## 6. Joy During Suffering

"Maintaining joy and hoping in Christ even when it's painful because you reflect trust in God's sovereignty."

Resurrection life doesn't erase pain—[it gives purpose in the middle of it.](#)

## 7. Authentic Community and Unity

"You build meaningful relationships marked by vulnerability, transparency, and mutual encouragement."

He emphasized quick forgiveness and peacemaking: "You're either dividing or bringing it together."

## 8. Full Access to Every Room

Martinez compared our lives to a house: "Jesus, You could be like right here. Like, don't go right. Don't hold on my relationship. Don't talk to me about it. It's messy right now, but I'mma hold it."

The resurrected life invites Jesus into every

corner—especially the parts we try to hide.

## So How Do You Get There?

Martinez said it starts with surrender. “Holy Spirit, what are You saying to me?” he urged listeners to pray. “Your decision is you actually living the resurrected life.”

This isn’t about achieving perfection. It’s about letting the risen Christ live fully through you, one surrendered step at a time.

“Don’t leave this place exactly how you came in,” Martinez said. “Have an encounter with the living Christ.”

Amen to that.

## Even Demons Believe: This Is a Wake-Up Call for Passive Christians

In a recent livestream teaching, [Isaiah Saldivar continued his verse-by-verse journey](#) through the New Testament, covering James chapters 2 and 3.

Using the New King James Version, Saldivar focused on the connection between faith and works, the warning against

showing favoritism, and the responsibility that comes with our words.

“True faith and partiality should not go together,” Saldivar said, referencing James 2:1. He acknowledged the challenge of treating everyone equally, especially in a culture that tends to elevate people based on wealth or influence.

“Favoritism is not just bad manners—it is sin,” he added, quoting James 2:9. “God does not value the wealth of a person or the popularity of the person.”

Saldivar also pointed to the example of Abraham and Rahab in James 2 to emphasize that faith is shown through action.

“Faith without works is dead,” he said, quoting verse 17. “Real saving faith is demonstrated by your works.” He cautioned against a belief system that stops at intellectual agreement. “Even the demons believe—and tremble,” he said, citing James 2:19.

In James 3, Saldivar turned to the power of the tongue. “The tongue is set on fire by hell,” he said, reading from verse 6.

He stressed the importance of [using speech to build up rather than destroy](#), warning that blessings and curses shouldn't come

from the same mouth. “We bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men,” he said. “My brethren, these things ought not to be so.”

He left viewers with a reminder about godly wisdom found in James 3:17. “The wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy,” Saldivar said.

Corey Russell, a well-known speaker and author, shared a gripping testimony of deliverance and transformation through Jesus during an interview with Pastor Vlad Savchuk.

“I screamed the name Jesus,” Russell recalled, “and it was like God came and breathed inside of me. And all I could say for the next five minutes is, ‘I’ve got air.’” His radical encounter began after a friend who had experienced deliverance told him, “Corey, it’s heaven or hell. You have to make a decision.”

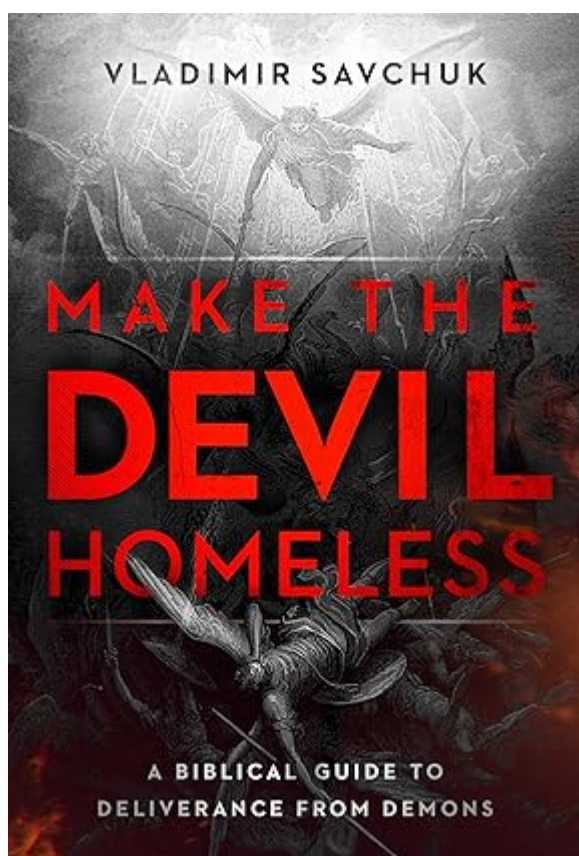

On Feb. 18, 1997, Russell said he was born again, instantly freed from drugs and sin, and filled with the presence of God.

“Get on the pavement and give me your life. You’re mine,” Russell said God told him. That moment would define the rest of his ministry.

## Power in Tongues and the Spirit Realm

Russell emphasized [the transformative impact of praying in tongues](#): “I just said, God, I’m going to pray in tongues until peace comes.” He shared that during a season of intense warfare in his family, praying in the Spirit brought healing, peace and restoration. “We would feel presences enter into our room... and I would see peace come on our family.”

Describing his daily practice, Russell said, “I will begin to pray in tongues out loud for about 20 minutes where I am now putting my eyes on the throne room of God... I am magnifying God

with my spirit.” He called it a “three-part rhythm”: bless God, make requests and return to tongues or Scripture.

## **Mysteries and Strength in the Spirit**

When it comes to tongues, Russell said many people resist because it “offends the mind” and requires faith: “Possibly look like an idiot for a second.” But he insists it unlocks deeper revelation and alignment. “He who prays in tongues edifies himself... that is going to bring into alignment your thought life... your emotions... your desires... and your body.”

Pointing to 1 Corinthians 14, he emphasized that tongues is a gift meant to build up the believer, not to be dismissed: “In no way is he [Paul] removing these gifts and saying they don’t matter. He’s actually establishing the glory of it.”

## **The Secret to Sustained Fire**

[Russell compared the gift of tongues to a spiritual well.](#) “It would well up, but I would not allow it to be released... I was so afraid... that fear, judgment, and pride” became the blockers. But once released, “those wells begin to just spring up... and you’re almost like you’re living in that fresh first love.”

To those hungry for more of God, Russell offered a simple prayer: “Father, I ask you in the name of your son to fill me with the Holy Spirit. I want to speak in tongues. I want to

prophesy. I want everything you died for, Jesus.”

## **This Pastor’s Real Preaching Led to Real Conviction**

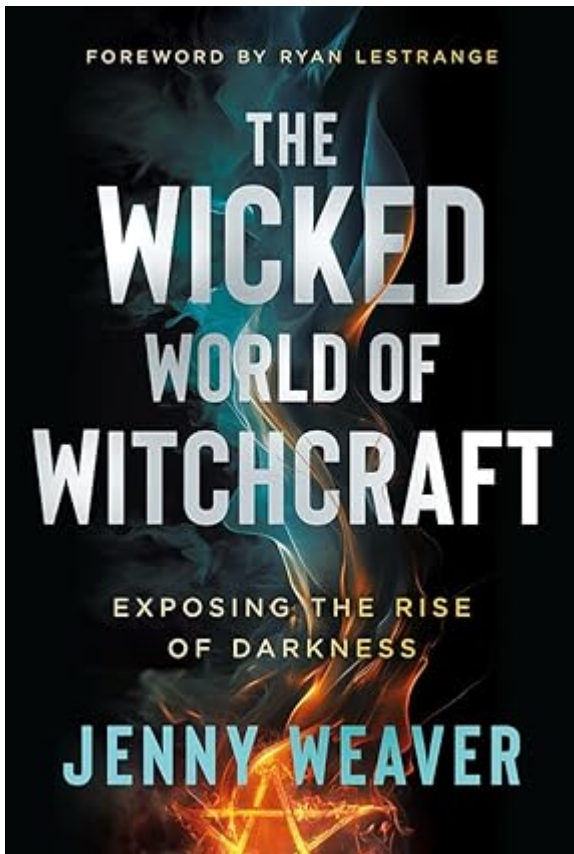
“This sermon had people walk out because they got way too convicted,” Nik Keswani said in a recent video recap.

The message, delivered by Pastor Philip Anthony Mitchell at 2819 Church, wasn’t filled with polite encouragements or soft-spoken life tips. Instead, it was a direct call to repentance that hit like a spiritual wake-up call.

“He addressed [sin] directly and unapologetically,” Keswani explained. “He spoke about the hidden sins that lukewarm Christianity likes to excuse as well as the cultural practices that it flirts with, but most importantly [the spiritual counterfeits that people entertain](#) while still claiming Jesus.”

Those counterfeits included what Mitchell called demonic practices: “Your little tarot cards, your little sage, your little crystals, your little readings, all that stuff is... demonic. It’s demonic.” He continued, “How you praying to God and got crystals next to your Bible at the same time? How you trying to send up the incense of prayer and got sage burning at the same time?”

## Spiritual Adultery and False Peace

Pastor Mitchell didn't stop at identifying occult practices, he explained the spiritual deception behind them. "These demons that been watching you since you was young... they whisper in the ear of the psychic, they tell your age and the last boyfriend you had and what city you was born in because they've been watching you."

The issue, Mitchell said, isn't just ignorance. It's mixing the holy with the profane. "This isn't consecration. It's confusion," he declared. ["Spiritual adultery dressed as self-care."](#)

Keswani noted, “The early church didn’t flirt with idols. They burned them. They didn’t consult mediums and then go to prayer meetings afterwards.”

## **The Evidence of Real Faith**

The conviction intensified when Mitchell challenged the very definition of a Christian. “You can’t find the description for Christian in the Bible,” he said. “It was a derogatory term that was given to us.” He continued, “Anybody in society could put Christian in their profile, but we checking for... fruit.”

Mitchell wasn’t trying to please the crowd. “I ain’t up here to get your approval. I don’t care if half of y’all don’t come back next week. The Lord... your blood is not going to be on my hands in the judgment.”

Keswani closed the video with a powerful reminder: “This is real accountability in preaching. No pandering, no entertainment, just a call to holiness.”

If that kind of preaching offends you ask yourself why: “Is it because it was actually harsh or because God is trying to convict you and you’re resisting Him?”

## **Jack Hibbs Exposes Satan’s**

# Greatest Lie, and Why It Still Deceives Millions

In a powerful continuation of his podcast series on spiritual warfare, Pastor Jack Hibbs dove deep into the realities of Satan, demons and the unseen war happening all around us. [His message? Don't be deceived](#)—darkness is real, but so is Christ's victory.

“All angels were created to serve the Lord,” Hibbs began, pointing to Isaiah 14 and Ezekiel 28 as critical passages that expose Satan's origins. “Satan, Lucifer, had a special spot... he was the worship leader in all of God's heaven.” Hibbs described the fallen angel as having “pipes,” “tambourines” and even music built into his very being: “The Bible says... when he brings his hands together, they are as timbrels.”

But that beauty and purpose twisted into pride. “He wanted to be a god. Beware of anybody who tries to convince you that you too can become a god. It didn't go over well with Satan,” Hibbs explained.

Hibbs emphasized that Satan's fall happened “before Adam and Eve were in the garden,” and firmly rejected the idea that demons are simply fallen angels. “I believe that demons are the spirits of those who drowned in the great flood who were known as Raphaim or Nephilim... they were not angels nor were they humans, they were something else.”

Even now, Hibbs warned, "Satan is loose to be about this world and he has his demon powers working for him." However, "he is limited in power... he's not omnipresent. He's not omniscient. He's not omnipotent. He is not omni anything."

Still, Satan's power of deception remains active. "He's the ultimate influencer," Hibbs said. "Jesus said he's the father of all lies." He shared that Satan cannot read minds but "can shoot things into your mind," which is why believers must "bring every thought under the captivity of Jesus Christ."

In a chilling moment, Hibbs recounted a personal encounter with a demon-possessed man. "This man's eyes turned black in his head like black marbles... his voice changed... and he said, 'Stop talking about Jesus. Don't say the name anymore. I will not hear it.'" Hibbs boldly replied, "Jesus Christ is coming back... he's the Lord... he rose again from the grave... he's the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords."

The spirit responded with pure blasphemy: "Jesus Christ is in hell. He's rotting and we're eating his flesh." Hibbs didn't flinch: "Jesus Christ is seated at the right hand of God the Father."

On the prophetic timeline, Hibbs believes [Satan's strategy includes preparing a counterfeit messiah.](#) "I think every generation Satan has had to have an antichrist waiting in the wings." And today, Hibbs said, the world is primed: "The book of Daniel tells us that the Antichrist is going to arise when the world cries out for peace and prosperity."

Despite the darkness, Hibbs reminded believers that "Satan is a defeated foe. He has no power over the believer. He only has power to sway the unbelievers."

The final act? “He tries to throw everything in the kitchen sink at Jesus in what is called the battle of Armageddon... and it’s going to flop on him.”

The podcast closed with hope and conviction. “Jesus Christ is the Word. He’s God... second person of the Holy Trinity. And He is not threatened or rivaled by Satan.”

The battle is real, the enemy is cunning, but the victory belongs to the Lord.

## **You Are Called: John and Lisa Bevere Reveal How to Discover God’s Purpose for Your Life**

John and Lisa Bevere want believers [to know something simple but deeply transformative](#): “You are called.”

That’s not just the title of their new book—it’s the core message of their ministry and latest podcast episode.

“Every single Christian, every single Christian, gift,” Lisa emphasized. “So you talked about the calling, the gifts comes with a gift. Yes. To accomplish the calling.”

They also emphasized that God's voice requires tuning in. "God is always broadcasting. He's always speaking," Lisa said, "I'm just not tuned in." John added, "You were aware that God was still with you, but you weren't hearing His voice because of sin."

The Beveres urged listeners not to underestimate everyday

faithfulness. “Just do what you do know. Just serve,” Lisa said. “What is in your hand, what is in your life, do your next.” John echoed, “Your calling right now is to serve your pastor and your local church and you stay with it.”

## **Prophecies of Energy and Earthquakes: Kim Clement’s Warnings Come Into Focus**

In a powerful and fast-paced conversation between Donné Clement Petruska and Trey Smith on the House of Destiny Network, a recurring prophetic theme from the late Kim Clement took center stage: energy, earthquakes and volcanoes as [signs and instruments of coming change.](#)

Smith brought up the discovery of a lithium deposit in the U.S. valued at over \$1.5 trillion and tied it to Clement’s words: “He saw an issue with nuclear, he saw a weapon, he saw a forest, a giant forest in this country. They were hiding a weapon, a mustard color, he saw.”

According to Smith, Clement’s prophecies also involved a divine use of natural disasters. “There will be the two great E’s,” Clement declared, referencing earthquakes and eruptions. “Though the earth will be scorched in some areas, it won’t do the damage they had anticipated. They will say it is just a volcano, [but it is not—it is a sign.](#)”

Smith emphasized that Clement “went over this numerous times,” saying, “The nations of the earth stand waiting for the earth to shake.” He continued, “This means they know. Even Putin said to Biden, ‘You’ve handed Trump scorched earth.’”

Donné acknowledged the prophetic layers tied to these geological warnings. “I was thinking fruits and vegetables,” she said in response to Clement’s word about the earth yielding its produce. “But all of the dialogue surrounding that is about energy...it’s all about energy.”

As talk of earthquakes, energy independence and even mining grows louder on the global stage, Clement’s prophetic voice continues to echo, perhaps now more clearly than ever.

## **They’re in the Church: John Eckhardt Exposes Demons Hiding in Plain Sight**

In a recent teaching, Apostle John Eckhardt dove into the principles of spiritual warfare and deliverance, drawing heavily from the works of Win Worley and biblical examples of demonic confrontation.

“Deliverance is for believers,” Eckhardt said. “True deliverance is a ministry for born-again Christians.” He explained that [Christians can be under the influence of demons](#)

without being possessed. “‘Possessed’ in the Greek is the word ‘daimonizomai,’ which literally means to be demoned or under the influence of a demon.”

He emphasized the importance of understanding spiritual terminology. “It’s translated ‘possessed’ in the King James Version, but I always say that’s an unfortunate translation because it denotes the fact that the devil can own you. We know that’s not true if you’re a born-again believer.”

Eckhardt taught that demons have specific names and functions. “Demons do have names. Remember in Mark chapter 5, Jesus said, ‘What is thy name?’ And he said, ‘My name is Legion, for we are many.’” He added, “Almost every sin has a corresponding demon: fornication, adultery, hatred, anger, rage, murder. I call them sin spirits.”

Addressing the process of deliverance, Eckhardt said, “Deliverance is not passive. It involves spiritual confrontation and boldness.” [He also noted that deliverance is often ongoing,](#) stating, “The more deliverance we get, the more we grow, the more we can possess. Your body is like a land. Your body is your land. He will clear the land.”

Biblical authority remains central to Eckhardt’s teaching. “Mark 16:17, ‘These signs shall follow them that believe. In my name shall they cast out devils.’ Luke 10:19, ‘Behold, I give you power over all the power of the enemy.’”

He explained the power of renunciation prayers: “By renouncing it, it tended to break the power of darkness and actually facilitate the deliverance.” Sample declarations included, “I renounce all involvement with witchcraft, divination and occult practices in the name of Jesus Christ.”

Eckhardt encouraged using scripture and the blood of Jesus during prayer. “Demons hate the blood because the blood is the foundation of our deliverance, our redemption. They hate the Word of God. Declare Scriptures aloud to dismantle strongholds.”

He stressed the importance of discernment and the word of knowledge during deliverance. “Ask God to reveal to you the names of spirits or how they came in. Sometimes in deliverance, where you cast demons out like this: ‘You demon that came into them when they were a teenager...’”

Reflecting on his journey, Eckhardt said, “I learned so much from Win Worley about deliverance. It really changed my life.” He continued, “This message of deliverance has crossed denominational lines, and there are many people that operate in this, many preachers around the world. So thank God for this.”

## **Why the New ‘Daniel’ Film Is**

# Powered by the Holy Spirit, Not Hollywood

When filmmaker Daniel Kooman talks about his upcoming biblical epic Daniel, he doesn't open with industry stats or box office predictions. [He starts with the Holy Spirit.](#)

"I don't think you can make a Bible story without the Holy Spirit, at least not accurately," he told The Christian Post. That perspective is more than just a personal conviction – it's a mission statement for the future of faith-based entertainment.

As reported by The Christian Post, Daniel is shaping up to be one of the most anticipated Christian films in years. It's not just because the project raised \$1.2 million through crowdfunding – a rare feat for independent productions – but because it represents a return to reverent, biblically accurate storytelling led by people of faith.

"The failure of a lot of these other Bible films that came out is that they weren't done by believers, and they weren't done with an honor to the text. Which is paramount," Kooman said.

The film will cover the first dramatic chapters of the book of Daniel – from the Babylonian siege of Jerusalem to the unforgettable moment in the fiery furnace.

"They were going into Babylon, which was hell, and when they encountered the fiery furnace, that was like going into hell inside of hell," Kooman said. But the goal isn't just cinematic excellence. It's spiritual impact. "If it doesn't make people want to pick up and authenticate it through the Bible, I think you've completely missed the mark," he

emphasized. “Our goal is that people will have a hunger for the Word and actually get into the book of Daniel and into the rest of the Bible. That would be an incredible win.”

The production is a visual and theological undertaking. Filmed on location in India using converted military compounds and palatial structures that mirror ancient Babylon’s golden grandeur, the project also boasts a gritty, reimagined version of Awesome God by Michael W. Smith – designed to drive home the emotional weight of the fiery furnace scene.

“The lyrics are perfect for the fiery furnace,” Kooman said. “It’s been a really cool collaboration.”

Kooman isn’t shy about why he believes Daniel and other projects like The Chosen and House of David are resonating with believers.

“At the end of the day, [we’ve been starved of faith-based entertainment,](#)” he said. “There’s such a small percentage that are faith movies – especially biblical movies.” For too long, the Christian audience has been underserved in mainstream media. But the success of these Spirit-led projects is changing the narrative – and the industry is taking notice.

Even pastors and scholars are praising Daniel for its faithfulness to Scripture.

“We have a Hebrew Old Testament scholar who reviewed the script and said it was the most accurate of any of the films they had reviewed,” Kooman revealed. That kind of endorsement

doesn't come from flashy effects or clever marketing – it comes from prayer, careful study, and a team committed to honoring God with every frame.

With a 2026 release date, Daniel is the first of what Kooman hopes will be a series of films unpacking the biblical account chapter by chapter. But he says this movement won't grow without grassroots support.

“If people of faith want to see more of these kinds of films, they have to come behind us and support us,” he said. “We're going to be doing campaigns to get churches and youth groups to go and book out a theater.”

In an age where media shapes minds and culture more than ever, the church cannot afford to sit on the sidelines.

“Our goal is sincerely to see people open the Word and be brought into the Word in a new way. And for this generation, that means film. That's how people are absorbing media – on their phones, in theaters, on TV. If we can pack that with faith-based content, we'll be showing that there's a demand – and that's only going to help in the future,” says Kooman.

The hunger is real. The audience is ready. And with Spirit-filled creators leading the way, Daniel could be the start of something far greater than a single movie – it could be the spark of a revival in biblical cinema.
