Prophetic Warnings and a Call to Prayer: What's Coming Next?

As we step into 2025, Perry Stone's prophetic insight offers a timely word for navigating what lies ahead. His message for Joseph Z's New Years Eve prophetic broadcast challenges believers to refocus on spiritual priorities while preparing for the unexpected—a reminder that already feels strikingly relevant.

Stone points out a pattern he's observed year after year: "It's not the things we expect to happen that often occur; it's the things that we did not see coming." This insight became startlingly true almost immediately, as wildfires

Looking ahead, Stone predicts that “great revelation” and “mysteries” will be unlocked this year. Yet these blessings will likely come amid challenges. He calls on the body of Christ to pray for pastors, ministers and leaders, emphasizing the need for unity and intercession during times of spiritual warfare.

Stone’s message appears shockingly accurate as we witness his words about natural disasters already unfolding. But beyond the headlines, his call to stay focused on the gospel, avoid distractions and maintain a pure heart is an invaluable guide for believers in 2025. It’s a reminder to let faith lead the way as we step into the new year.

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Michael Tait and The Newsboys: Why He’s Stepping Away After 15 Years

Michael Tait, the dynamic lead singer of the Christian band Newsboys, has announced that he’s stepping down after more than 15 incredible years with the group. His decision, fueled by prayer and fasting, gives us all something to think about

when it comes to handling life's big moments.

In a heartfelt social media post, he shared the journey that brought him to this major choice. "Fifteen years ago, my life was forever changed when I received the invite to step into the role of lead singer for Newsboys," he wrote. Reflecting on his time with the band, he called it "some of the most fulfilling, faith-filled, and rewarding years of my life." And it's no wonder—under his leadership, the band experienced a major resurgence with hits like "Born Again" and "God's Not Dead," reaching fans all over the world.

Tait's announcement wasn't just a quick decision. "This decision does not come lightly and has been a shock to even myself," he admitted. But he didn't make this call on a whim. "Amidst prayer and fasting, I have clarity that this is the right decision," he said. And here's where it gets inspiring: Tait leaned on Matthew 6:33, a verse that reminded him to "seek first his kingdom and his righteousness." Matthew Barnett, pastor of the historic Angelus Temple and CEO of the Dream Center in Los Angeles, California, is seeing incredible spiritual hunger in the wake of devastating California wildfires that have killed at least 24 people and destroyed more than 12,000 structures.

Barnett, whose organization is feeding and housing those impacted by the inferno, told CBN News he has seen a massive outpouring of resources and volunteer staff—people from all walks of life who are flooding to his campus to help the Christian nonprofit bring relief.

In the process, these people are hearing—and experiencing—the

Christian gospel.

“They’re not just open,” Barnett said of the spiritual fervor unfolding. “They are telling you stuff that you’re not even asking them. I mean, they are volunteering ... their lives ... and, just by listening and asking them questions, and then you say ... ‘God is with you.’”

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Volunteers have been flooding to the Dream Center to help hand out food and resources—people from “every type of demographic you could imagine.”

“As people are working 10 hours a day so joyfully ... I’m talking to them as they’re serving ... we’ll play worship music and ... they’ll be like, ‘I like the song. I never heard before. What is it?’” Barnett said. “And then we’re just talking about God while we’re working together with this whole new community.”

He said prayer has also been on full display, as he and volunteers ask individuals and families coming through the food line if they can pray for them.

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As it turns out, the spiritual needs are as plentiful as the physical.

“Everybody wants prayer,” Barnett said. “It really is kind of a revival in action where people just want to know that God is there, but I’m really seeing it in a very unusual way through a lot of the volunteers rubbing shoulders all day long and asking questions ... like, ‘Why do you do what you guys do?’”

He said some people go through the food line to be prayed for

and to experience the positive, Spirit-driven Dream Center staff and volunteers.

“It really is a gathering place, it’s a revival place, it’s a place where people are being told about Christ, it’s a place of people being prayed for,” Barnett said. “It really reminds me of an Acts 29 type of church in action.”

Throughout his message, Z emphasizes the need for Christians to hold onto a grounded, biblical perspective. He points to Matthew 24:6-8, where Jesus outlines signs of the end times, as a foundation for understanding these unfolding events. “This is a time for the church to rise, walking in God’s love and power.” Z explains.

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Z’s insights carry a sense of urgency, challenging all Christians to view global events through a spiritual lens.

“This is not just about survival; it’s about stepping into the calling of the church during these pivotal moments,” he explains. The challenges ahead, from economic instability to cultural upheaval, are seen not as obstacles but as opportunities for believers to reflect God’s love and truth in an increasingly uncertain world.
