

# Kim Clement: A Prophetic Word About the White House

At the heart of Brewer's vision for 2025 is a sobering call to repentance. He outlines three specific sins within the church that he says God will judge severely:

1. **Blood money and corruption.** Brewer cautions that financial exploitation and misuse of resources in ministry are offenses God will no longer tolerate.
2. **Sexual exploitation and abuse of power.** The pastor calls out the abuse of authority in the church, particularly in relationships, as a grave issue.
3. **Child abuse, including trafficking.** Brewer's ministry rescued 11,000 children from trafficking in 2024, and he stresses that these atrocities are a critical focus for God's judgment.

"The time for ignoring these sins is over. God is calling us to clean house," Brewer declares.

He also tied these points to the prophetic significance of the altar in 2025. "The word for altar in the Hebrew lexicon is linked to 2025. It's time to return to authentic worship and build altars that honor God," he says, emphasizing the need for sacrifice and genuine devotion.

For Brewer, the church's response is crucial. "We have to align ourselves with God's side," he urged. "Fasting, praying and addressing the issues of pornography and exploitation are non-negotiables. Repentance isn't optional."

Yet amid the warnings, Brewer offers encouragement for believers to delve deeper into prophetic understanding. “God uses patterns, numbers and events to speak to us. He’s a God of incredible detail, and if we’re paying attention, we’ll see His hand at work everywhere,” he says.

Pastor Brewer’s vision for 2025 is both a challenge and an invitation. As the church stands at the threshold of what he describes as an invasion from God, he implores us to “Seek God’s heart, understand His ways and prepare for His presence.”

## **Do Our Pets Go to Heaven?**

Wildfires continue to rage across Southern California, the devastation described as “apocalyptic,” leaving a trail of unimaginable destruction. Homes and businesses have been reduced to ash, lives disrupted and hope shaken. Yet, even amid the smoke and ruin, there is a profound opportunity for the church to rise and demonstrate the transformative power of God’s love.

Pastor Jack Hibbs of Calvary Chapel, Chino Hills, is urging believers to see beyond the destruction and recognize an opportunity for God to move powerfully.

“The devastation is absolutely apocalyptic in scope,” Hibbs said. “It’s as though an atomic bomb had gone off—the loss of animal life, the loss of property, the loss of business, the

loss of homes and for some, maybe even the loss of their faith because they may have built their life as it were on the sand. We pray not.

“Unless the Lord builds the house, they that labor do so in vain,” Hibbs reminded listeners. He encourages the church to pray for millions in the Los Angeles area, asking God to turn this ash heap into a foundation for spiritual awakening.

“This is a plea,” Hibbs continues. “Will you pray? Will you pray for California? Will you pray for the devastation in Southern California? We give it to You now, Lord, and we pray by leaving it at Your feet in Jesus’ name.”

In the Echo Park region of Los Angeles, the L.A. Dream Center is hard at work providing aid as a 24-hour shelter for those impacted by the wildfires.

Alongside outreaches like the Dream Center, celebrities such as Chef Andrew Gruel have raised funds and supplies for the ministries, delivering pallet after pallet of food to those in desperate need of help.

## **5. Focus on Jerusalem**

“Jerusalem is becoming a burdensome stone for all nations,” Hughes says, quoting Zechariah 12:3. He highlighted the growing tension surrounding Israel’s capital, including international disputes over its sovereignty. “This is exactly what the Bible said would happen in the last days,” he affirms.

## **6. Ezekiel 38 Players in Position**

Hughes details the alliances forming between nations mentioned in Ezekiel 38, including Russia, Iran and Turkey. “These nations are aligning in ways that only make sense if you understand Bible prophecy,” he argues. “This coalition will come against Israel, and we’re watching it unfold.”

## **7. Destruction of Damascus**

Turning to Isaiah 17, Hughes speaks about the ongoing war in Syria and the looming threat of Damascus’ destruction. “The Bible says Damascus will become a ruinous heap,” he explains. “With the current geopolitical tensions, this prophecy could be fulfilled any day.”

## **8. Knowledge Increase and Movement**

“Daniel 12:4 foretold that knowledge would increase and people would move to and fro,” Hughes states. He emphasizes how exponential advancements in technology and global travel are clear signs of the times. “We’re living in the fulfillment of this prophecy,” he adds.

## **9. Donald Trump’s Re-election**

Hughes describes President-elect Donald Trump’s re-election as

a “pivotal moment” that has reshaped global dynamics. “He stands as a bulwark against the globalist agenda,” Hughes says, linking this to prophetic warnings about world governance in Daniel 7.

## **10. Globalist Agenda and New World Order**

“The push for a one-world government is accelerating,” Hughes observes, referencing Revelation 13 and the 10-kingdom system in Daniel 2. He argued that the ongoing efforts to centralize power align perfectly with biblical prophecy.

## **11. Calls for Peace and a One-World Leader**

Finally, Hughes addresses the increasing calls for peace in the Middle East and the emergence of a potential global leader. “The Bible warns of a false peace and the rise of the Antichrist,” he explains, citing 1 Thessalonians 5:3: “For when they say, ‘Peace and safety!’ then sudden destruction comes upon them.”

Pastor Hughes’ prophetic roadmap for 2025 serves as a wake-up call for sleeping believers. While the signs may be unsettling, they also point to the hope of Christ’s return. “These things must come to pass,” Hughes reminds us. “But we are not to fear. Instead, we are to lift up our heads, for our redemption draws near.”

# 9 Powerful Signs of Revival and Kingdom Growth Coming in 2025

Chris Garcia of Father's Glory International shared a prophetic roadmap for 2025 during a recent interview with Charisma Media. His nine points offer guidance, encouragement and challenges for Christians heading into the new year. Each point is backed by Garcia's insightful words, calling believers to rise to the occasion.

## 1. 2025 Will Be a Year of Revival

Garcia emphasizes that revival begins with intimacy with God. "The Holy Spirit is inviting us into the secret place," he says. This revival won't just be seen in large gatherings, but will flow from individual believers' hearts into their communities.

### **3. The Kingdom of God Will Face Resistance**

“The kingdoms of this world will rage against the kingdom of God,” Garcia warns. Despite opposition, he assures us that, “God’s purposes will prevail.” Believers are encouraged to stand firm, knowing our faith is anchored in Christ.

### **4. God Will Release Fresh Discernment**

“This year, we need to see with eyes of the Spirit,” Garcia says. With challenges ahead, we must rely on God’s wisdom rather than human understanding to navigate the complexities of life.

Prince’s analysis of 2 Timothy 3:13 is particularly striking: “Evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived.” He highlighted the Greek word for “impostors,” which he translated as “enchanters,” tying it directly to practices of magic and sorcery. “Why do people enchant?” Prince asked. “What does that speak about? Magic, witchcraft, sorcery.” The surge in such practices today—not only in entertainment but in everyday life—reveals how deeply entrenched the occult has become in our world.

Revelation 22 adds another layer to Prince’s message: “He who is unjust, let him be still unjust; he who is filthy, let him be still filthy; he who is righteous, let him be still righteous,” (Rev. 22:11). Prince described this as a “parting of the ways,” where the righteous grow holier while the wicked grow more corrupt. This moral polarization is evident in today’s permissive culture, where societal norms no longer restrain behavior. Social media platforms amplify both extremes, with influencers promoting righteousness and others openly embracing witchcraft, spell-casting and rebellion against God and His values.

Prince turned to Daniel 8:23 for a chilling prediction about the Antichrist: "When the transgressors have reached their fullness, a king shall arise, having fierce features, who understands sinister schemes." He explained that human rebellion against God must peak to release the Antichrist. The cultural embrace of the occult, coupled with increasing corruption and rebellion, align disturbingly with this prophecy. "The corruption that's been at work in society ever since Adam fell is increasing," Prince declared. "And there's no way to reverse it."

Yet, Prince's message was not one of despair but of hope. He emphasized that God's solution is not to reform the corrupted but to create something entirely new. "God's remedy is a new creation. He doesn't try to patch up the old, or improve it, or reform it. He says, 'Away with it. I'll bring forth something new that's uncorrupted, that's pure, that has its origin in God.'"

As we navigate a world increasingly drawn to the occult, Prince's words challenge us to live as witnesses of God's power and truth. His call to righteousness and spiritual discernment is more urgent than ever. In a society captivated by the supernatural but devoid of biblical grounding, the church must rise to demonstrate the greater power of the Holy Spirit—a power that overcomes deception and prepares hearts for Christ's return. Prince's message from 1989 serves as both a warning and a call to believers today: stand firm, grow in holiness and resist the tide of spiritual darkness that seeks to engulf the world.

# New World Order Map 1942: Prophetic Echoes in Trump's North America Vision

In 1942, in the turmoil of World War II, Maurice Gomberg envisioned a world reordered by the victors, a vision encapsulated in his "Outline of the Post-War New World Map." Today, as we navigate our own era of shifting geopolitical landscapes, one can't help but wonder if there's a prophetic undertone to these historical blueprints, especially in light of recent statements by President-elect Donald Trump concerning the potential acquisitions of Canada, Greenland and the Panama Canal.

## Echoes of Expansion

- **North American Union:** The 1942 map proposed an expansive United States that included Canada, Mexico, Greenland and numerous islands. Trump's recent musings about annexing Canada and acquiring Greenland for strategic reasons mirror this ambition.
- **Strategic Territories:** Both the map and Trump's ambitious goals emphasize control over strategic points. The Panama Canal, mentioned by Trump as needing to be reclaimed, was a focal point in Gomberg's map,

indicating its importance in both historical and contemporary geopolitical strategies.

- **National Security:** Justifications for territorial expansion in Gomberg's map were rooted in post-war security. Similarly, Trump's interest in Greenland is explicitly tied to national security concerns.

## **Current Global Tensions and Israel**

The 1942 map proposed a "Hebrewland" encompassing not only modern Israel but also Jordan, parts of Syria, and Saudi Arabia, suggesting a significant expansion. Today, Israel faces ongoing conflicts, particularly with Hamas in Gaza and Hezbollah in Lebanon, which may be interpreted through a prophetic lens as key identifiers of end-time prophecies in the Bible about the expansion and defense of Israel's borders.

With Israel's defensive and sometimes preemptive military actions, there's merit in the conversations among some Christian communities about whether these conflicts might lead to a redefinition of Israel's borders, echoing the map's vision in a prophetic sense. The ongoing debate over settlements and land rights in Judea and Samaria further fuels this speculation.

## **Biblical Parallels**

Many Christians look to the books of Daniel and Revelation for insights into end-time scenarios, where visions of kingdoms rising and falling, and a world under one governance, lends credibility to the idea of a "New World Order" that would eventually usher in the system of the beast. The 1942 map's

concept of a unified global political structure under major powers could be seen as aligning with these biblical prophecies on how the end times might look, geopolitically.

These discussions often turn to the figure of the Antichrist, who many believe will establish a one-world government. While the map and Trump's statements are secular in nature, they do spark debates about whether such political moves could be steps toward fulfilling this prophecy.

In the end, the question remains: Are we witnessing the unfolding of a prophetic script, or are these just the natural ebbs and flows of political power? Only time will reveal the answer, but in the meantime, let us ponder, pray and prepare.
