

Troy Brewer Warns the Church in 2025: 'Repentance Isn't Optional'

In his recent interview with Charisma Media, Pastor Troy Brewer painted a vivid picture of what he believes lies ahead for the church and the world as we move from 2024 into 2025. His reflections on 2024 as the "Year of the Open Door" and his vision for 2025 as the "Year of the Open Window" carry profound implications for believers seeking to understand the times.

Reflecting on 2024, Brewer described it as a year marked by unprecedented opportunities and invitations from the Lord. "2024 has been a time of God opening doors for us to step into His plans," Brewer says, referencing key prophetic events such as the Great American Eclipse. He pointed out the eclipse's connection to breakthroughs for the United States and Israel, specifically citing the fall of the Iranian president 40 days after the celestial event.

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But while 2024 brought an invitation, Brewer warns that 2025 brings something far more consequential. "2025 is not about us stepping into God's plans; it's about God invading our space. It's the 'Year of the Open Window,' where heaven begins to pour out blessings, judgments and interventions," he explains.

Do our pets go to heaven? It's a question that pulls at the heartstrings of animal lovers everywhere. Kelly Kopp and Ryan Edberg from Kingdom Movement and Kelly Kopp Ministries took on this emotional topic in a recent video. While the Bible doesn't give us a straight answer, their discussion sheds

light on what Scripture says—and what it doesn't.

First, they point out an important distinction: humans and animals are different. They explain that Genesis tells us God created animals and called them "good," but only humans were made in His image. This sets us apart as spiritual beings with a unique connection to God. Animals have flesh and a soul (mind, will and emotions), but they don't have a spirit, which ties us to eternity.

"Something unique happens when God creates humans," the ministers explain. "God created human beings in His Image. I didn't see it say that about animals. This is an important distinction. Humans are set apart from the rest of God's creation because they are made in His image."

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That said, the Bible shows God's deep care for animals. Psalm 36 highlights His love for all creation, and Psalm 1:48 even pictures animals praising Him. It's clear they matter to Him.

"What this verse shows us is that God has a deep love for animals, all of his creation. God is a loving caretaker for both humans and animals this should bring you some comfort," they reveal.

Then the ministers also point us to Romans 8, which talks about all creation groaning for the day when the curse of sin is lifted. This gives hope that animals could be part of God's big plan for restoration. After all, if creation itself is redeemed, why not our furry friends, the duo asks?

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Here's the thing, though: the Bible doesn't say for sure if pets will be in heaven. But the two pastors remind us of God's goodness and His ability to bring joy. If having your pet with you in eternity would make you happy, isn't it possible He could make that happen?

Losing a pet is heartbreaking. Death is a painful part of life in this fallen world. But as believers, we have the promise of a new creation, free from pain and loss. Whether pets are there or not, we can trust that God will make everything right.

Trump's Historic Comeback to Conclude with National Prayer Service

President-elect Donald Trump has announced the official schedule for his inauguration festivities, set to begin Saturday, Jan. 18, and conclude on Tuesday, Jan. 21, with a National Prayer Service. The events reflect a clear commitment to placing God at the center of the incoming administration, a defining feature of Trump's vision for America's future.

"President Trump is dedicated to uniting the country through the strength, security and opportunity of his America First

agenda,” committee co-chairs Steve Witkoff and Kelly Loeffler said in a press release. “The 2025 inaugural celebrations will reflect President-elect Trump’s historic return to the White House and the American people’s decisive vote to Make America Great Again.”

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The schedule includes patriotic celebrations, a renewed focus on honoring America’s founding values and the highlight: a National Prayer Service dedicated to seeking God’s guidance for the nation. This emphasis on faith sets the tone for Trump’s second term, signaling a sharp contrast to the outgoing Biden administration, which advanced policies that often contradicted biblical principles.

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Is the Pope Engaged in Spiritual Warfare Against Donald Trump?

The recent appointment of Cardinal Robert McElroy as the archbishop of Washington, D.C., raises significant concerns about a potential agenda being pushed by the Vatican in America.

Pope Francis' decision to elevate one of his most progressive allies to this influential position has drawn criticism from those who see the move as part of a broader spiritual battle—not only against biblical truth but also against former President Donald Trump and his second term.

McElroy, who previously served as the bishop of San Diego, has been an outspoken critic of Trump's policies, particularly on immigration and the border wall. 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A Progressive Ally in a Key Position

McElroy's elevation to cardinal in 2022 and now to Washington, D.C., clearly shows Pope Francis' commitment to reshaping the Catholic Church's leadership in America. Known for his pro-

LGBTQ stance, McElroy has openly supported greater inclusion for LGBTQ individuals within the church, a position that many conservative Catholics rightfully point out is a departure from biblical teachings.

These positions align closely with Pope Francis' own progressive agenda, which has often clashed with more traditional interpretations of Scripture. Meanwhile, the Pope has taken steps to remove conservative voices within the church, such as Bishop Joseph Strickland, who was known for his outspoken opposition to the Pope's pro-LGBTQ policies and his defense of traditional Catholic values. Strickland's removal, juxtaposed with McElroy's promotion, highlights a troubling pattern: a Vatican increasingly hostile to Scripture and more aligned with society's views.

A Questionable Legacy

McElroy's record also includes troubling allegations of mishandling abuse cases within his diocese. Critics argue that his history makes him an odd choice to lead one of the most visible and politically significant archdioceses in the United States. The Archdiocese of Washington has faced its own scandals, including decades of abuse by clergy and a reckoning with transparency. For McElroy to take the helm in such a sensitive position—while carrying unresolved questions about his past leadership—raises eyebrows among both faithful Catholics and outside observers.

A Broader Agenda?

This appointment cannot be viewed in isolation. It comes at a time when the Vatican appears to be aligning itself against not just Trump as an individual but the broader anti-woke agenda he champions. Trump's presidency was marked by policies that many Christians viewed as biblically grounded—from defending the unborn to supporting religious freedom and appointing judges who upheld traditional values. For many,

these actions are seen as evidence of God's hand in Trump's leadership.

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By contrast, the Vatican under Pope Francis has embraced radically progressive politics, often at the expense of clear biblical teaching. From prioritizing climate change to emphasizing social justice over doctrinal truth, the Vatican's shift has alienated many conservative Christians. The appointment of McElroy is a direct challenge to the agenda many Americans voted for and believe is God-ordained.

For Christians, the question is not merely political but deeply spiritual. Is this appointment part of a larger battle against biblical truth and the values that underpin a God-honoring society? By elevating leaders who prioritize progressive ideologies over Scripture, the Vatican makes itself vulnerable to the lies and deception of Satan and his demonic forces.

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Rise of the Occult: Derek Prince Reveals What Will

Bring the Antichrist

In October of 1989, the late Bible teacher Derek Prince delivered a sermon in Bromley, England, titled “True and False Christ.” Now, decades later, his message resonates with alarming relevance as society witnesses an explosion of occult practices and permissive moral decline. Prince’s Scriptural insights offer a sobering perspective on the cultural climate that prepares the way for the Antichrist—a perspective that feels startlingly prophetic in today’s world.

Prince began by referencing Paul’s warning in 2 Timothy 3: “Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so do these also resist the truth.” He noted that Jannes and Jambres, the magicians of Egypt, were practitioners of the occult, emphasizing that “the battle was not on the level of theology; it was on the level of power.” This distinction shows us a critical reality: as this age draws to a close, theological arguments alone will not suffice. Instead, believers must demonstrate a power greater than that wielded by the enemy, the power of the Holy Spirit. Prince’s observation holds a mirror to the present, where supernatural themes saturate popular culture, from movies and TV shows to social media trends like “WitchTok,” a TikTok community centered on witchcraft and occult practices.

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“One of the major features of this period is an explosion of the occult,” Prince warned. He described a society characterized by “the deterioration of human character, a lot of nominal Christianity that doesn’t exhibit its power, and an explosion of the occult.” These words echo in today’s widespread fascination with the supernatural. Celebrities openly engage in rituals, tarot readings and astrology, while television series and films glamorize witchcraft, demonic

possession and sorcery. This normalization of the occult mirrors the cultural shift Prince foresaw—a shift that undermines biblical values and invites spiritual deception.
