

6 Prophetic Events That Will Usher In the End of the Age

Chaos in the world today has filled some people with trepidation about future days, but do not fear, Jesus has already claimed victory.

He also told us to be prepared for His return, and the Bible informs us [what the days leading up to this monumental event](#) will look like.

In a recent podcast episode, Ricky Scaparo, founder of End Time Headlines, laid out six things that must take place before we will see the end of the age:

1. The gospel of the kingdom has to be preached into all the world as a witness to all nations. “This has to happen,” Scaparo implores. “We, the church, have been given the stewardship the responsibility to take this gospel and preach it around the world.”

2. The cup of iniquity will become full. “You can find a first reference of this all the way back in in the book of Genesis in chapter 15,” Scaparo reveals. “Picture a cup, okay, and every time the nations commit these acts of defiance against God they’re committing these abominations, it just it keeps filling up this cup.

“...this is what’s going to introduce the Antichrist,” he adds, referencing Paul’s words in 2 Thessalonians chapter 2.

3. The Rapture is going to happen at the end of the “Church Age.” “Now, why is it going to happen at the end of the church age?” Scaparo asks. “The wrath of God has become full, and God

is about to to turn

that cup over, and he's about to pour out His indignation and wrath.

"He pours it out during a seven-year period on Earth called the 'Tribulation period' and your Bible just so happens to say in 1 Thessalonians chapter 5 verse 9, 'for God did not appoint us the church to wrath but to obtain salvation to our Lord Jesus Christ,'" he continues.

4. There is a set number of Gentiles who will be saved. "This is another end time trigger for the 'End of the Age,'" Scaparo says. "Now this will likely coincide with Matthew 24:14 where when this Gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world. [There's a set number of Gentiles that comes into the kingdom.](#)

"Why?" he adds. "So that all Israel be saved," (Rom. 11:25-26).

5. All of the prophecies that have been spoken of regarding Israel must be fulfilled. "Israel must be reborn as a nation, May 14, 1947, Israel. The capital Jerusalem must be restored, Six Day War, was fulfilled. Israel must blossom again. It was fulfilled through what prophet Isaiah said. The Jews would begin to come back to their land just as...Ezekiel talked about, that they would return back into their homeland," Scaparo says.

"All of these prophecies concerning Israel, nearly everyone has been fulfilled."

6. The end of days, latter day outpouring of the Holy Ghost. "We're presently in this. Just because we don't see this happen in America doesn't mean it's [not] happening," Scaparo

says. "I believe that God is pouring out [His] Spirit where there is willing hearts where there is recipients that are wanting it. That are hungry for God. That [are] hungering and thirsting after righteousness."

As followers of Christ, we are called to discern the signs of the times with spiritual vigilance, understanding the urgency of the days we live in. While the world grows darker and confusion abounds, we must stand firm in the truth of God's Word, not as passive observers but as active participants in His mission. Jesus commissioned us to go and make disciples, sharing the hope of the gospel with boldness and love. Let us not shrink back in fear but rise up in faith, bringing light to the darkness and pointing others to the eternal hope found in Christ alone.

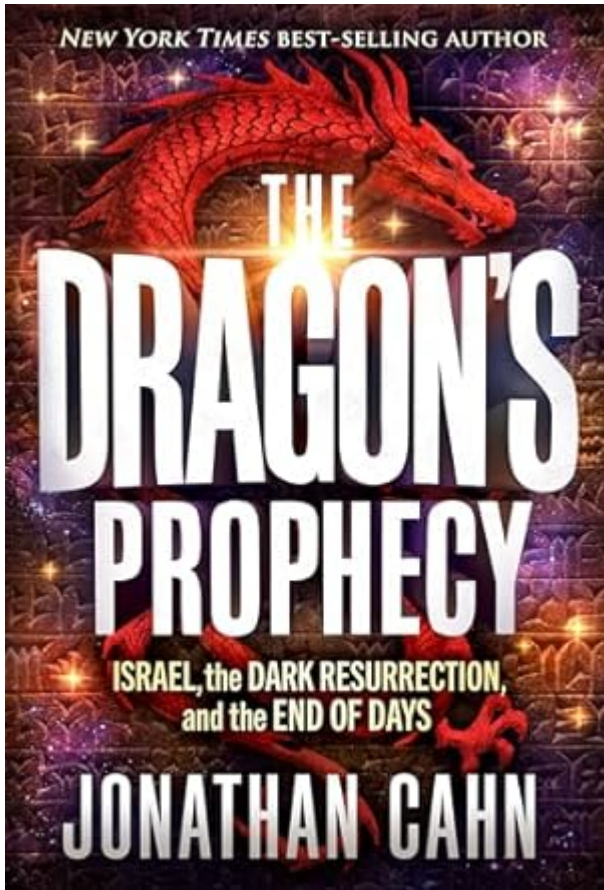

3. Russian Troop Deployments

Russia's strategic positioning near Israel's border raises alarms, particularly in the context of Ezekiel 38. Morris warns, "You've got Russian troops positioned on the border of Israel in Southwest Syria...The boldness of Russia to do that—now why is that a big deal? After the Rapture, Russia comes down on Israel."

4. Pope Francis' Provocative Remarks

Morris criticizes Pope Francis for suggesting Israel's actions in Gaza could constitute genocide. He contrasts this stance with Hamas's documented atrocities, stating, "Notice he didn't say a thing about [what Hamas did]."

5. Biblical Evidence in Archaeology

Artifacts like a recently unearthed First Temple-era seal affirm Israel's historical claim to the land. "It's comical hearing people say there's no Israeli tie to the land...bit of evidence after bit of evidence every single week," he observes.

6. Natural and Celestial Events

Morris draws connections between natural disasters, such as a bomb cyclone on the U.S. West Coast, and biblical prophecy. He also highlights celestial phenomena like asteroids and past

blood moons, remarking, “The heavens were saying, ‘I died for you; I’m coming again.’”

The Christian Influence Behind SpaceX's Journey to Mars

In an era often described as post-religious, Dr. Steve Turley's recent commentary on SpaceX's Starship Flight 6 offers a compelling counter-narrative.

Beneath the sleek façade of technology and innovation, Turley argues, lies a "profoundly mystical vision" [driving Elon Musk's interplanetary aspirations](#)—a vision deeply rooted in historical and spiritual traditions.

Turley begins by placing Musk's SpaceX endeavors within the context of mythic times. Drawing from Oswald Spengler's observations on civilizations under threat, he notes how such eras often elevate heroic figures to carry their hopes and ideals.

"We are living in the midst of what German scholar Oswald Spengler called mythic times," Turley says, asserting that Musk and his contemporaries, including [President-elect Donald Trump](#), have assumed the roles of modern-day "heroic avengers" fighting to preserve civilization.

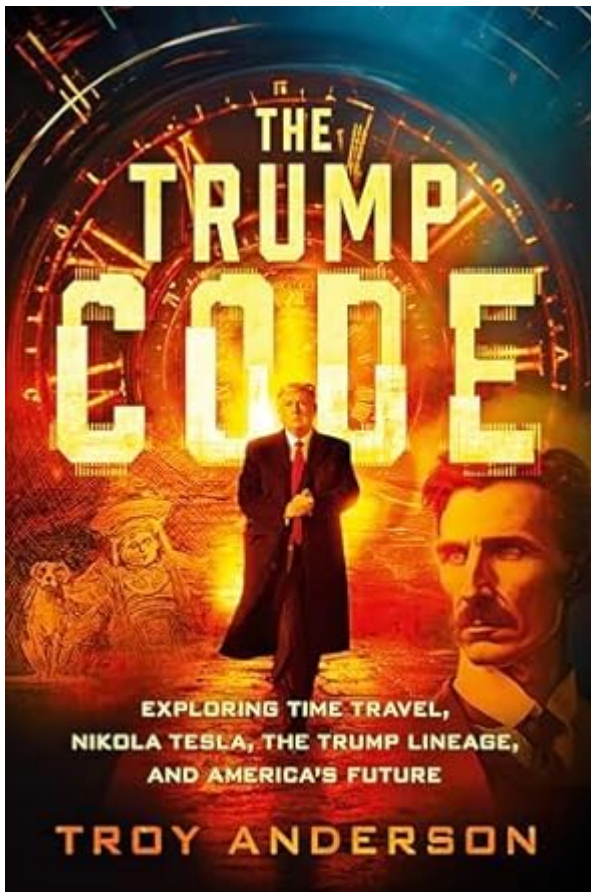

Central to Turley's argument is the legacy of Wernher von Braun, the German rocket scientist who became a pivotal figure in America's space program. Von Braun, Turley explains, saw space exploration not merely as a scientific endeavor but as a moral mission.

“We knew that we had created a new means of warfare,” von Braun is quoted as saying, “and the question is to what victorious nation we were willing to entrust this brainchild of ours.” For von Braun, surrendering such power to a nation guided by biblical principles was essential to ensuring global peace.

But Turley delves deeper, tracing this spiritual thread to Nikolai Fyodorov, a 19th-century Russian Orthodox visionary. Fyodorov’s “cosmic theology” reimagined science and technology as extensions of Christ’s Resurrection, tools for renewing creation on a cosmic scale. Turley vividly describes Fyodorov’s belief that space exploration could “literally propel that redemptive vision into the vast expanse of the cosmos, transforming humanity into a multiplanetary species and awakening the praise of God’s glory over the whole of creation.”

This spiritual lineage, Turley argues, profoundly influenced von Braun and other early pioneers of rocket technology, such as Konstantin Tsiolkovsky. Tsiolkovsky, another admirer of Fyodorov, famously declared, “Earth is the cradle of the mind, but one cannot live in the cradle forever.” Musk’s recent reposting of this quote underscores how such visionary theology continues to resonate, even in the ostensibly secular world of modern space exploration.

The narrative takes an almost prophetic turn when Turley highlights von Braun's 1953 novel, "The Mars Project." In it, von Braun envisioned a Mars colony led by a representative democracy under a presidential figure named "Elon." For Turley, this coincidence is not merely serendipitous but emblematic of a grand design.

"Von Braun," he says, "was deeply influenced by Fyodorov's cosmic theology," suggesting that Musk's rise fulfills a vision decades in the making.

Turley ties these spiritual dimensions to the broader MAGA movement, which he sees as another embodiment of a mythic age. "We are truly experiencing an utterly epic and mythical moment," he declares, linking the aspirations of figures like

Musk and Trump to a divine unfolding. For Turley, the launch of Starship Flight 6 is more than a technological milestone; it is a symbolic act that “rockets” humanity closer to its spiritual destiny.

By weaving together theology, history and contemporary events, Turley offers a vision of space exploration that is as much about the heavens above as the heavens beyond. Whether one agrees with his interpretation or not, his insights challenge us to see technology not merely as a tool but as a vessel for humanity’s deepest spiritual yearnings.

Laken Riley’s Stepfather Shares Emotional Letter to Her Future Husband

Another chapter is winding down in the tragic story of [22-year-old nursing student Laken Riley’s murder.](#)

On Wednesday, Nov. 20, her murderer, illegal immigrant Jose Ibarra, 26, was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole.

Ibarra “was convicted on three counts of felony murder and counts of malice murder, kidnapping with bodily injury, aggravated assault with intent to rape and ‘peeping Tom’” according to NBC News.

Judge H. Patrick Haggard found Ibarra guilty of all 10 counts he was facing.

Riley's stepfather, John Phillips, shared a heartbreaking letter written by Riley to her future husband shortly before her murder. The journal entry, written on Dec. 17, 2023, according to Phillips, showcases her strong Christian faith, as well as her dedication to living a life that glorifies the Lord.

Here are the words Phillips read before the courtroom prior to Ibarra's conviction:

To my future husband, as silly as I feel writing this, my old small group leader once recommended it, so here I am.

To my future husband, I want you to know that I'm thinking about you.

I'm working every day to become the best wife I can be by working through my current relationships to best prepare me for ours and our kids one day.

I am focusing on God and what He defines as a faithful Christian wife so that I can best embody those

characteristics.

I pray that you know that is with my full faith and trust in God, that I know this relationship has been handcrafted by Him.

I pray that we continue to glorify the Lord, prioritize Him in every aspect of our lives, and raise our family, our future family, to be God-fearing Christians as well. I pray God is the center of our relationship as it is a gift from Him.

I thanked Him for you before I even knew you and can't wait to love you in the best way I know how for the rest of our lives.

I pray you know and feel the importance of my love and hopes for our relationship. No matter what challenges we face, I pray that our trust in God and love for one another overrules the obstacle.

May our relationship last forever, your future wife, Laken.

7 Billion Lives at Risk Amid Growing Nuclear Tensions

As Russia and Ukraine mark their 1,000th day of war and Western leaders give the greenlight to use long-range missiles they provided, [spearheaded by President Joe Biden](#), the world is on the brink of nuclear war.

No, this isn't fear-mongering to rile up the masses, this is the threat NATO faces as Russian President Vladimir Putin has said if these missiles are used against Russia, he will consider it an act of war upon Russia by NATO forces who supplied the armaments.

"This is now the time where we really start praying," says prophetic voice Joseph Z of Z Ministries. "I've been praying about this because...the defeat that they experienced, and who is they? I'm talking about the Dems and these wicked lizard overlord...mafia-types, that have, honestly, acted like they are going out peacefully and kind.

"But suddenly, permission is given to this nation...and getting permission to send these spears, javelins, arrows, missiles, into the former Soviet Union. And these are USA provided," Z continues.

But what could be the point of this? Why on earth would the current administration knowingly instigate and antagonize a nuclear-capable Russia who has said they are willing to cross that red line?

“So what they are trying to do is hand WW3 to 45/47, and there’s even calls now for Biden to step down...and there’s calls to say ‘put her [Kamala Harris] in,’” Z reveals.

In times of war, we need a wartime leader. Israel had King David. The United States had General George Washington. If the past three years are any indicator, the Biden-Harris administration is lacking a wartime leader, and the American people just voted to bring one into the White House

Z points to the repeated warnings from Putin about the potential consequences of the West’s actions, and has built a reputation as a man who carries out the threats that he makes.

“[Putin] has said you have, basically, until the holidays, until Christmas. ‘If you don’t stop, I’m going to push the button,’” Z says, believing that Putin is trying to wait as long as possible, because he knows who will assume the mantle of President of the United States next. Donald Trump has also made a name for himself as a man who is willing to use action over words.

“I have a great concern about this,” Z shares. “...I gotta tell you, [if they push too fast too soon, they could let one off the leash](#). And the outcome of this, is devastating.”

Playing right into Z’s worst fears, Ukraine has reportedly continued to launch long-range missiles, this time using British-made ‘Storm Shadow’ missiles, into Russia.

According to the UK’s media outlet, “The Mirror”:

British-made Storm Shadow missiles have allegedly been fired into Russia for the first time today, just hours after British officials joined their U.S. counterparts and suggested they may lift an existing missile ban.

Unconfirmed reports on Russian Telegram channels cited by the Kyiv Post have alleged that 12 of the missiles flew over the

border from the Kursk region today. The claims come less than a day after Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer vowed that Ukraine must have “what it needs” to counter the threat posed by Russia.

“The concern I have is what I’ve seen,” Z says, “this is why we’ve got to pray.... now we’re in a place where suddenly they’re going to try to trigger something that could turn into a domino effect.”

The potential destruction from such a trigger event is staggering, according to Z. Revealing information from analysts with whom he has communicated, an estimated death toll from a nuclear-driven World War 3 event would reach upward of 7 billion lives lost.

“This is on our front step. This is serious,” Z warns. “That they could let these tactical nukes go, or bigger ones, or any of it. I believe this is something the church, just like we had to pray about the hurricanes, just like we had to pray about the election, just like we had to pray about everything, now we’ve got to pray about this. Because this is very serious.”

Evangelist Overcomes Violence and Jail, Continues Proclaiming Jesus

Hatun Tash, a former Muslim turned Christian evangelist, has faced violent persecution for her bold proclamation of the Gospel. From being chased by angry mobs to enduring stabbings, unlawful arrests and the constant threat of death, Tash's story is a chilling reminder that even in a nation like England, [standing for Jesus can come with a high price.](#)

Tash embraced Christianity after moving to England. Her conversion began with a critical examination of Islam and the life of its prophet, Muhammad. "As I read [Muhammad's] biography, it was very disturbing to me. So, the man you grew up to love and honor suddenly turns out to be like, yeah, not good, not good. And I decided, I can't be Muslim," Tash explains, as reported by CBN News.

Her search for truth ultimately led her to the Gospel, where she discovered a God unlike any she had known. "As you dig into it, you get to meet with a God who is not silent or far or distant from you, but you meet with a God who loves you, who pours out Himself on you. And not only that, He just puts Himself on the cross and then says, 'I love you from everlasting to everlasting, Come to Me,'" she says.

Driven by this newfound hope, Tash often took her message to Speaker's Corner in London's Hyde Park, a well-known hub for vigorous debates on faith and philosophy. There, she openly challenges Islam, declaring Muhammad a false prophet and exalting Jesus as the Son of God. Her words often spark intense reactions. In one instance, a man slashed her face

with a knife, leaving her physically scarred but spiritually resolute.

While police have compensated her for wrongful arrests, such as a humiliating strip-search and jailing two years ago, they have yet to apprehend those who have attempted to kill her. Andrea Williams of Christian Concern, which has defended Tash, criticized the lack of justice. "The truth is that those who have attempted to kill her have been caught on camera. The police know who they are, but they have not been arrested. She is feared by and targeted by Muslim groups because she is fearless for the Gospel. She loves Jesus so much that nothing will halt her."

Tash's determination remains unshaken. She continues to stand outside mosques, debating with Muslims, even as danger lurks. "I would simply stand in front of the mosques, and I'd say, 'Muhammad is a false prophet. Jesus Christ is the Son of God. Tell me, what are your objections?' Hundreds of Muslims just stop and then they want to talk to you. Sometimes you get harmed, sometimes it gets dangerous. Sometimes you end up in hospitals, sometimes you end up in people's homes for a cup of tea," she reveals.

Her mission is simple: [to share the Gospel regardless of the cost.](#) "I don't care whether people reject me or not. They need to hear the Gospel," Tash stated.

Tash knows her life is in constant jeopardy but finds solace in her faith in Jesus Christ. "Things are dangerous. Should I choose to stay silent? Like when people are spending 5,000 pounds to buy a gun, to shoot you and shoot your loved ones? The Gospel is so glorious, I cannot be silent. And the Lord is the giver of life. So, when it's my time, He will take me

home. But until He gives me breath, we continue to preach.”

Tash’s story exemplifies the promise Jesus made to His followers: persecution is inevitable for those who live and speak the truth of the Gospel. She stands as a modern witness to Jesus’ words in John 16:33: “In the world you will have tribulation. But be of good cheer. I have overcome the world.”

While Tash’s bravery inspires Christians to declare their faith boldly, it also serves as a sobering reminder of the persecution that often accompanies it. In a world hostile to truth, she clings to our Savior who endured the ultimate persecution so that others might find eternal life.

7 Powerful Tips for Aspiring Preachers

[Pastor Vlad Savchuk of HungryGen Ministries](#) has shared a stirring and practical message for aspiring preachers, offering guidance rooted in his own journey and the teachings of the apostle Paul.

In his video, Savchuk highlights the foundational aspects of a preacher’s calling, emphasizing humility, grace and a Christ-centered focus. Drawing from Scripture and his own personal experiences, he outlines essential steps for those feeling the call to proclaim the gospel, while providing encouragement for navigating challenges such as self-doubt and the pressures of

ministry.

Here are Pastor Savchuk's seven essential tips for aspiring preachers:

1. God wants to reveal Jesus to you so that He can reveal Jesus in you. "Paul says in Galatians that 'God revealed,' meaning he experienced the gospel through the revelation of Jesus. He didn't learn Jesus, he actually encountered Jesus and it's important that your ministry, your call of preaching, starts with the revelation of Jesus Christ," Savchuk shares.

2. God has separated you for this call from you mother's womb. "I think every preacher, every man, woman of God carries this sense or carries this idea even they have this conviction that God had this thing for me to preach. God had this thing for me to be devoted to this call way before even I heard the call to salvation. This doesn't mean that you were saved from your mother's womb. It's just [that] God already had a plan for your life," Savchuk explains.

3. The calling to preach is through grace, not works. "It's difficult for some people to feel that when you went to six years of college and you have a degree, and you're like 'yeah, I'm called to preach because I have a master's degree' or 'I have a bachelor's degree,' that's amazing that you have a degree, but that is not why you're called to preach. You're called to preach through God's grace and if you ever forget that, you will become proud and entitled and you won't make a difference in the world," Savchuk says.

4. Preachers must preach JESUS. "If you're a preacher, Jesus is your subject. If you don't preach Jesus, you're preaching something else, you're missing your calling, you're not fulfilling your assignment," Savchuk reveals.

5. God wouldn't use you to preach to the whole world, but He is sending you to reach part of that world. "In chapter 2 of Galatians, he [Paul] talks about that Peter has this grace with the Jews, and I have this grace with the Gentiles. You will have a limit to your preaching calling and within that limit, God's going to give you enormous grace and favor that will come easily," Savchuk says.

6. God calls you to prayer as He is calling you to preach. "I want to encourage every person who is called to preach to begin to balance your preaching with your Arabia [Paul's] experience. This is your withdrawing to spend time with God not just in the mornings but taking these times. A day, two, three, where you spend a quality extended period with God your Bible and just fellowshiping with Jesus," Savchuk implores.

7. Don't be so desperate to join circles of influence that you forsake the calling of being faithful to God. "Do you want to be a motivational speaker or the preacher of the Gospel?" Savchuk asks. "If you want to be a preacher of the Gospel, don't use the world's techniques, branding and trying to build your name and build your brand. It's not about your name, it's about Jesus"

In his heartfelt message, Pastor Savchuk reminds aspiring preachers that the ultimate goal of ministry [is to glorify Jesus Christ, not oneself.](#) By prioritizing time with God, embracing humility and leaning on His grace, preachers can find the strength and clarity needed to fulfill their calling. Whether preaching to a small group or a large congregation, the focus remains on revealing Christ to others. Savchuk's words challenge and inspire, urging preachers to remain anchored in their faith as they walk in their God-given purpose.

Stone begins by revisiting the 2016 presidential election, where Trump became the 45th president of the United States. Drawing on his expertise in Hebrew studies, Stone explains that Hebrew letters carry numerical values, and the numbers 40 and five correspond to the letters “Mem” and “He,” respectively. Together, they form the Hebrew word “Ma,” which translates to “what.” Stone recalls the widespread astonishment following Trump’s victory, saying, “My prediction on the election of 2016 was people after the election will say, ‘What? How did this happen?’” He notes that even Fox News anchor Megyn Kelly echoed this sentiment the next day, stating, “What? How did this happen?”

Stone ties this insight to a prophecy he shared in his 2021 book, where he likened Trump’s presidency to the biblical

story of Nebuchadnezzar in Daniel 4. In the prophecy, Trump is symbolized as a tree cut down but with roots left in the ground. Stone elaborates, "The Trump stump and roots are deep in the soil of America, and in time, with humility and wisdom, he will either return to an important position, form a new political party or watch a new tree grow out of the Trump stump."

Building on this foundation, Stone analyzes the number 47, which could represent Trump's return as the 47th president. He explains that 47 corresponds to "Mem" (40) and "Zayin" (seven). When combined with 45, they form the Hebrew word "Mes," which Stone says means "a gift from God." He reflects on the significance of this discovery, asking, "How would him being reelected be a gift from God?"

For Stone, the answer lies in what he describes as a divine reprieve. He defines a reprieve as a judicial act that halts impending judgment. "Many people believe that the gift from God for us would be that we have received reprieve," he says. Stone cites biblical examples, including Hezekiah's extended life and Nineveh's spared destruction, to underscore the possibility of a similar reprieve for America.

However, Stone warns against complacency, [urging viewers to recognize the spiritual battle ahead.](#) "The battle is not over. The cultural, spiritual, moral battle of America is only starting," he says. He also calls for humility, repentance, and national unity, adding, "We need to ask God to forgive us of our national sins, personal sins, sins within the church, and just really humble ourselves before God."

Through his exploration of Hebrew numerology and prophecy, Stone presents Trump's presidency as part of a larger divine

narrative, leaving viewers with both a challenge and a call to action. “We believe, now here’s the question: What do we do with the reprieve? Do we just sit back on our hands and do nothing? No, we have to continue to fight.”

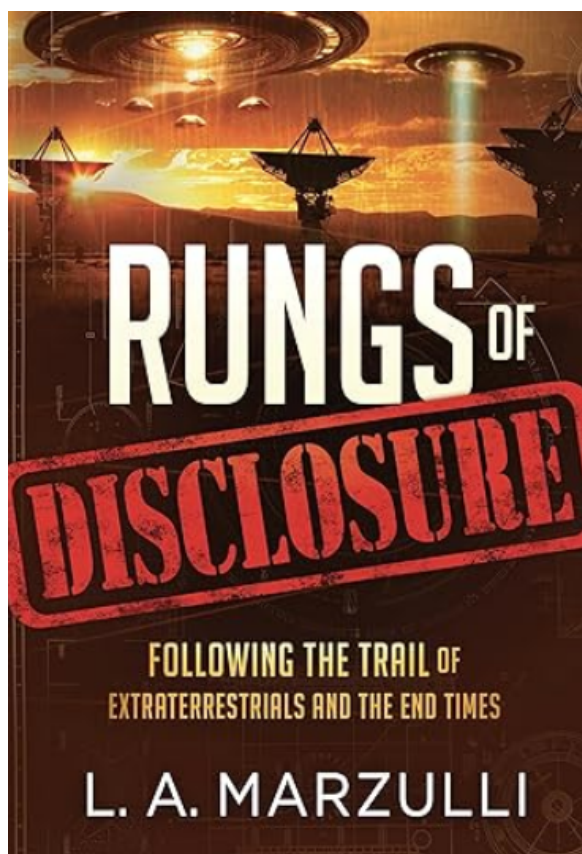
Demons and Paranormal Phenomena: L.A. Marzulli’s Spiritual Warning

L.A. Marzulli, a prominent Christian researcher and author, has long warned against seeing UFOs and extraterrestrial phenomena as harmless or merely speculative. In a recent interview with Charisma Media, he [challenges both believers and skeptics to consider an unsettling proposition](#): what if UFOs are not distant visitors from another galaxy, but manifestations of a darker, interdimensional reality?

Marzulli’s perspective, rooted in biblical interpretation and years of investigation, asserts that UFOs are not evidence of friendly “space brothers” but rather, [“interdimensional beings with a very nefarious, dark agenda.”](#) He ties this phenomenon to biblical warnings, suggesting that these entities are actually manifestations of demonic forces. “Men faint for fear for what’s coming upon the Earth,” he quotes from Luke 21:26, underscoring the gravity of what we can expect in the end times.

The timing of Marzulli's comments aligns with heightened public interest following the U.S. government's Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena hearings on Nov. 14. While some hoped the hearings would unveil irrefutable evidence, Marzulli believes they only advanced what he calls "the [rungs of disclosure.](#)" Referring to whistleblower David Grusch's claim that [the U.S. has retrieved "nonhuman biologics"](#) from crash sites, Marzulli notes, "That's a major rung on the ladder, but we haven't moved up much further yet."

Yet Marzulli warns against celebrating disclosure as progress. He frames the UFO phenomenon as a spiritual battle rather than a scientific puzzle. Drawing from his own experiences and research, he explains how the supernatural realm interacts with humanity.

“These aren’t your average fallen angels,” he says. “These are principalities—entities in charge of entire areas—and they have a very specific agenda to deceive.”

One of Marzulli’s most compelling points involves the power of invoking the name of Jesus in confronting these entities. He recounts stories of individuals facing UFO-related phenomena and experiencing immediate relief after calling on Christ.

“It doesn’t matter what form these beings take—they all bow to the name of Jesus,” Marzulli asserts, emphasizing the spiritual authority believers have in these encounters.

For Marzulli, the UFO narrative is not just a curiosity; it’s a tool of deception preparing the world for a counterfeit revelation. He recalls hearing explanations for the Rapture during his New Age days—claims that “space brothers” would remove those unfit for humanity’s golden age. “They’ve already explained the Rapture away,” he warns. “This narrative is designed to deceive, even the elect, if that were possible.”

Christians must not dismiss the UFO phenomenon as irrelevant or fantastical. Marzulli urges believers to stay grounded in Scripture, vigilant in prayer and prepared for the spiritual deception that may accompany increased disclosure.

As the government releases more information, Marzulli’s message is a sobering reminder that not all that glitters in the night sky is from the heavens. Whether one views UFOs as scientific anomalies or spiritual threats, Marzulli’s insights challenge us to ask deeper questions about what lies beyond—and within—our world.

Living Prophecy: How Zechariah's Writings Apply to Today

In a time of global upheaval, Pastor Matt Freeman sees biblical prophecy coming alive. Speaking on Prophecy Watchers, Freeman [connects current events to Scripture](#), particularly the book of Zechariah, calling on believers to recognize the prophetic significance of our era.

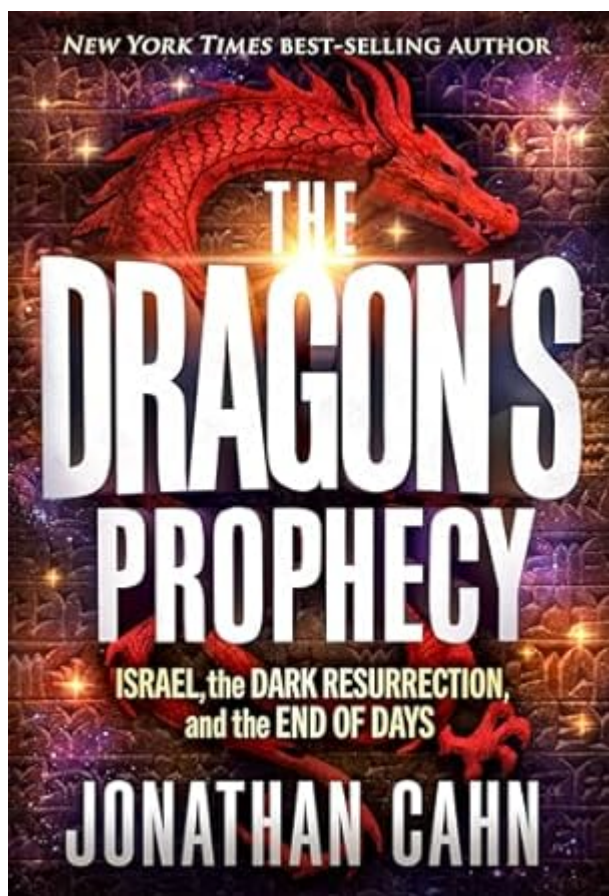
“The land promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob was granted by an eternal decree,” Freeman says. “It had nothing to do with Israel’s obedience—it was unconditional. This land is yours.” Despite this promise, he notes, “Israel is occupying the smallest sliver of it possible.”

The geographical boundaries of the promised land stretch from the Euphrates River through Iraq to the Nile River in Egypt, a vast territory fraught with modern conflicts. Freeman points to recently discovered oil and gas reserves near Israel, which could further stoke global tensions. “Right off the coast of Israel, they found this huge gas and oil reserve,” he explains. “That could be the reason why, in the Gog and Magog War, Russia comes down to seek...wealth.”

Freeman links these developments to Zechariah's vivid prophecies about Jesus and His return. He highlights Zechariah 9:9, which foretells the Messiah's triumphal entry into Jerusalem on a donkey, and Zechariah 11:12-13, which predicts His betrayal for 30 pieces of silver. These events, fulfilled precisely during Jesus' earthly ministry, demonstrate the precision of God's Word.

"When you study the life of Jesus, He always slipped away when they tried to grab Him, saying, 'My time's not yet,'" Freeman says. "But the one day He orchestrated it to fulfill Zechariah 9:9 on the exact day Daniel 9 prophesied."

Freeman also shows [Zechariah's chilling description of the end times.](#) In Zechariah 14, he explains, Jesus returns to destroy His enemies with the word of His mouth, unraveling the atomic structure that holds all matter together. "Their eyes melt in

their sockets, and their tissue melts away,” Freeman says, emphasizing the devastation described in Scripture.

This, he notes, aligns with Colossians 1:17, which declares, “By Him all things consist.” Freeman marvels at the recent scientific discovery that sound waves hold atoms together, a concept long affirmed by the Bible. “Jesus spoke everything into existence, and by the word of His mouth, all things are held together,” he says.

While these prophecies seem daunting, Freeman reminds believers of the hope found in Jesus. “The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy,” he says, quoting Revelation 19:10. “Everything prophetic in the Word of God speaks of Jesus somehow. You just have to find how.”

Freeman calls for discernment as the world grows increasingly tumultuous. “From Russia to Northeast Africa to Turkey, which is where the seven churches were located, the land is as hot as can be right now,” he warns. Global maneuvering, economic interests and spiritual opposition to God’s promises signal that biblical prophecy is unfolding in real-time.

As Freeman’s insights reveal, now is not the time for complacency. Christians must remain observant, grounded in Scripture and prayerful.

Biblical prophecy is not just a prediction—it’s a call to action.

Zechariah’s words, written thousands of years ago, remain a powerful reminder that God’s promises are eternal, and His plan is in motion. Believers today are called to watch, discern and hold fast to the hope of Christ’s return, trusting in our God who fulfills every word.
