

Election Warning: Don't Make the Mission Field Your Enemy

Petruska sees these public displays of witchcraft as part of a larger, more disturbing trend: the normalization of occult practices within global organizations. She points to institutions like the United Nations, the World Economic Forum and CERN, questioning the strange and often ritualistic events that take place under the guise of "art."

"Why would they choose to do ritualistic, Luciferian or Satanic things?" she asks. Petruska recounts an encounter with a hacker who allegedly witnessed occult rituals at CERN during its 2012 reopening. "She hacked into the security cameras because she was curious," Petruska explains. "And she said they were doing Luciferian rituals before the opening of CERN."

These revelations, Petruska believes, point to a larger spiritual battle that has been unfolding for decades, one that her father also foresaw. She references occultist Aleister Crowley, a well-known figure who claimed to have opened a "doorway" through occult practices in the late 1800s or early 1900s. According to Petruska, what came through this portal was a being named "Lamb," which she describes as eerily similar to modern depictions of gray aliens. "It was after that that people began to have these experiences of being abducted by the little gray aliens," Petruska says, linking these paranormal events to occult activities.

Petruska also connects these occult practices to pivotal moments in modern history. She suggests that a deal made

during one of these rituals in 1972, involving military psychics and remote viewers, led to the landmark Roe v. Wade decision in January 1973. She notes that this same period also saw the founding of the World Economic Forum by Klaus Schwab, an organization she views as part of the globalist agenda prophesied by her father.

“My dad prophesied about the rise of the Fourth Reich,” she says, recalling Kim Clement’s warnings of a spiritual battle that would spread across nations. “He prophesied that from the Netherlands and from France.” Petruska sees the growing influence of occultism and globalism as signs that these prophecies are coming to pass. “The spirit of God said truth will prevail,” she quotes from her father’s words. “The spirit of the Fourth Reich shall be overcome.”

A call to action is being issued to the body of Christ in response to the growing satanic influence in society. We, as Christians, must pray and engage in spiritual warfare, recognizing the spiritual battle taking place behind these cultural and societal shifts. As stated in Ephesians 6:12, “For our fight is not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, and against spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.”

The Bible’s message is clear: Christians must remain vigilant and spiritually aware as these changes unfold. The time has come for believers to stand firm in prayer and take action. The body of Christ is being called to rise up, recognize the spiritual battle and use the weapons of faith and prayer to combat these forces. It is essential not to ignore what is happening but to confront these challenges with spiritual strength.

Miracle Baby Born as Hurricane Milton Strikes

As Hurricane Milton barreled toward Florida's Gulf Coast, a miracle unfolded in the midst of chaos.

Kenzie Lewellen and her boyfriend, Dewey Bennett, braced themselves not just for the storm, but for the arrival of their baby boy. At 4 a.m. Wednesday, with the hurricane looming, Lewellen went into labor at their Port Charlotte home.

"My mind was just running a million miles an hour, like, what am I going to do?" Lewellen said according to NBC News. For Bennett, memories of Hurricane Irma in 2017 added to the tension. His father had passed away during the storm when emergency services couldn't reach them. "My dad had a massive heart attack because the ambulance could not come out to us during the storm," Bennett shared.

Now, with his own child on the way, Bennett feared history might repeat itself.

The couple faced another dilemma: their home was taking on water before Milton even made landfall. "If she didn't start having contractions until during the storm, the roads would have been flooded," Bennett said.

As the storm raged, Lewellen labored for over four hours

before they embarked on a risky drive to Sarasota Memorial Hospital. Her mother drove them cautiously through heavy winds and rain. At the hospital, only Bennett was allowed to accompany her, leaving Lewellen to FaceTime with her mom, a source of strength and comfort for her.

In the delivery room, Lewellen's view of the hurricane was a surreal backdrop to the most intense moment of her life. As trees uprooted outside, the real storm came when she learned the baby was in the wrong position, requiring a cesarean section. In pain from epidural complications, she leaned on the hospital staff. "If I didn't have the doctors and nurses that I had, it would have been a whole lot worse," she said.

At 11:45 p.m., amidst the storm, their son, Dewey Lester Bennett IV, was born—a healthy, 8-pound baby boy. It was a moment of overwhelming relief and joy.

"He is a miracle baby," Lewellen said, holding him close.

The timing of Dewey's birth, in the heart of a natural disaster, serves as a reminder of something greater. No matter how big the storms of life are—both literally and figuratively—God is always bigger. As Psalm 107:29 says, "He made the storm calm, and the sea waves were still. They were glad because the waters were quiet, so He brought them to their desired harbor."

Jimmy Evans Reveals Satan's Influence in the White House

On a recent segment of "Off the Wall with Will and Pete," hosts Will Cain and Pete Hegseth discuss the one-year timeline of Israel's ongoing war with Hamas, which began on Oct. 7, 2023.

That day, Hamas launched a coordinated terrorist attack, firing 3,000 rockets into Israel and leaving devastation in their wake. Nearly 1,200 Israelis were killed, and 257 hostages, including four foreign nationals, were taken by the militant group.

Cain and Hegseth emphasize the attack's unprecedented nature, describing it as the deadliest strike on Jews since the Holocaust. Among the hardest-hit areas were southern Israeli communities and a music festival where many civilians lost their lives. The hosts shared the harrowing stories of families caught in the chaos, with individuals grabbing any weapon they could find to defend themselves as terrorists infiltrated their homes, committing atrocities at every turn.

On Oct. 8, 2023, Israel declared war on Hamas. The military launched airstrikes followed by ground operations to root out the terrorists in Hamas and rescue hostages. Although a few pauses in the fighting allowed for some hostages to be released—mainly women and the elderly—many remain in captivity. As of today, 97 hostages are still held, including seven Americans.

By April 2024, Iran directly attacked Israel, which retaliated with airstrikes. In September, Hezbollah officially entered the fray, leading to a tactical Israeli airstrike that killed senior Hezbollah leader, Hassan Nasrallah. The situation has only escalated, with missile strikes from Hezbollah and Iran increasing tensions across the region.

In the United States, the war has sparked heated protests, especially on college campuses. Major institutions like Harvard and UPenn faced public backlash for their handling of the Oct. 7, attacks and growing anti-Semitism on campus, leading to the resignation of several college presidents. Jewish students continue to express concerns over safety as tensions on campuses remain high.

Hebrew Year 5785: Prophetic Call to Anoint Kings and Priests

In a recent YouTube video, evangelist Perry Stone delivers a stern warning to Christians about the dangers of harboring unforgiveness, revealing it could send them to hell.

Stone begins by citing what he calls “the most frightening verse in the Bible,” from Matthew 7:22-23: “Many will say to Me that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did I not prophesy in Your name...?’ And He will say to them, ‘Depart from Me, you worker of iniquity, I never knew you.’”

Stone explains that while some may perform religious works, such as prophesying and casting out demons, their hearts may still be full of iniquity, which will ultimately lead to their rejection by Christ. “There would be a group of people in the congregation, in the church, that would be doing the work of God,” he says, “but yet their heart was full of iniquity.”

One of the most pervasive issues he sees in the church today

is unforgiveness. Stone points to numerous near-death experiences from credible individuals who claim that bitterness and grudges landed them in hell. "They attended church but had bitterness and unforgiveness toward people. They gossiped, they talked about people, they cut people down," he says. In many of these accounts, the individuals were only spared from hell after being given a second chance to forgive those who wronged them.

He backs up his point with Scripture, referencing Matthew 6:14-15: "If you forgive men their trespasses, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive you." Stone warns that failing to release bitterness and grudges could cost Christians their eternity.

Stone calls on believers to examine their hearts and forgive those who have hurt them. "Eternity is at stake, and I don't want to see people enter into eternity and have to face Matthew 7 and not be able to enter the kingdom," he says. He lifts those suffering from a hardened heart in prayer, asking God to "help everybody watching me to be able to forgive and release the people that have hurt them and harmed them."

"Forgive, so that you may be forgiven," Stone urges, echoing Mark 11:25: "And when you stand praying, forgive if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father who is in heaven may also forgive you your sins."
