“These guys, in a nutshell, are basically building the foundation for what the Bible calls the Antichrist kingdom,” Crone states, referencing Revelation 13:16-17: “He causes all, both small and great, both rich and poor, both free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their forehead, so that no one may buy or sell, except he who has the mark...”

Crone further argues that the WEF’s agenda extends beyond economic control to altering humanity itself, dubbing it the “human reset.” He links this to a repeat of the “days of Noah,” as described in Matthew 24:37: “As the days of Noah were, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.” Crone points out that just as wickedness and genetic corruption marked Noah’s time, today’s global elites seek to redefine humanity through technology and genetic manipulation, which he refers to as “Human 2.0.”

Drawing shocking parallels between Schwab’s plans and biblical warnings, Crone urges believers to recognize these developments as signs of the nearing end times and to stay vigilant. “This is not a conspiracy theory. This is what the other half of the Great Reset is,” Crone cautions. According to him, the agenda set by the WEF and its allies is not just a global power grab but a direct fulfillment of prophecies leading to the rise of the Antichrist.

Local Church Astonishes Town with \$8 Million Blessing

One church, The Altar Fellowship in Johnson City, Tennessee, is putting their money where their faith is and blessing the community around them to the tune of \$8 million.

Leader of The Altar Fellowship, evangelist, pastor and author Mattie Montgomery, told The Christian Post that he dreamed of helping relieve people of crushing medical debt. After sharing this dream with a friend, the decision was made to partner with a debt negotiation group called RIP Medical Debt.

By doing so, The Altar Fellowship was able to purchase and consolidate \$8 million worth of debt from the church's six neighboring counties for only \$50,000 after negotiations.

"And essentially, we became the collection agency for \$8 million of medical debt," Montgomery said to The Christian Post. "Instead of pursuing it any further, we just sent a letter to everyone whose debt we had taken, and we just said, 'Hey, Jesus loves you, we love you. And it's our privilege to cancel this debt entirely.'"

This act of kindness and love has led to amazing testimonies about the goodness of God.

“And then one day, his dad called him in and said, ‘Hey, that church you go to is called The Altar, right?’ And he said, ‘Yeah?’ And the dad said, ‘Your church just paid off all my medical bills,’” Montgomery recalls. “And he was just really confounded by that. He thought, ‘Why did they do this?’ And his son got the opportunity to share the Gospel with his father because of the giving of the church.”

Pointing to Ephesians 5:15-20 (MEV), Bradley says that God has intentionally offered us five distinct blessings in these verses, if we are willing to take hold of them.

See then that you walk carefully, not as fools, but as wise men, making the most of the time because the days are evil. Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is. Do not be drunk with wine, for that is reckless living. But be filled with the Spirit. Speak to one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord. Give thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

According to Bradley, the five blessings found in this passage of Scripture are:

- The Holy Spirit: “When you decide to follow Jesus, the

Holy Spirit dwells in you,” he says. “The Christian life is supernatural. We can’t live it merely on our own strength.”

- **Wisdom:** Bradley points out that knowledge and wisdom are two very different things. “Knowledge includes information—but wisdom leads to transformation. Wisdom is applying knowledge through practical life decisions,” he explains. “God is generous and will give wisdom to anyone who seeks and honors God.”
- **Courage:** No matter what difficulties or fears we may be experiencing in life, Bradley says “ask God for courage to do the next right thing and trust Him with the results.”
- **Words:** As Christians, Bradley says that we should always “speak to others what is full of love and truth. Your tongue is like a rudder that steers a big ship. Words flow from your heart. Jesus knocks on the door—so let Him in.”
- **Gratitude:** Bradley explains that gratitude must be intentional, and that “a gritty gratitude learns how to give thanks even when you do not feel like it. Complaining, gossip, slander and negativity are not coming from God.”

Not the Bee said it best reporting on this exchange of faith:

But the Lord works in mysterious ways. Here's the dude who wrote and sang "Save a Horse, Ride a Cowboy" presenting the Gospel to one of the greatest conservative intellectuals in a way he can't get around.

Rich left no room for maneuvering with Peterson, which seemed to catch him off guard. The Canadian psychologist has made a living breaking down and eviscerating far left-wing tropes which in turn harm those who adopt the ideology. But when discussing the role of Jesus Christ as the Savior of humanity with Rich, who is coming from a biblical perspective, there is no room for Peterson to move.

You either make the leap of faith and proclaim Jesus your personal Lord and Savior, or you don't.

"I know you want to wrap up, so obviously we will. But it [the Bible] does say 'go out and preach the Gospel to every nation, every human being out there,'" shares Rich. "...when it talks about go out and tell everybody about the truth of who I [Jesus] am and what the Bible says, and what the stakes are, the eternal stakes, you are supposed to go say that."

Rich was 100% correct when he told Peterson to his face that one day every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord. Pray that Peterson will do this before it is too late.

AI Aims to Reveal the True Face of Jesus

The authenticity of the Shroud of Turin, a piece of cloth believed by some to have been the burial shroud of Jesus Christ, has been debated for centuries.
