

Michigan Farmer's Stand for Faith Triumphs in Landmark Court Ruling

A federal district court's ruling on Monday delivered a resounding victory for a Michigan fruit farmer and his family, signaling the end of a six-year legal battle centered on their [steadfast commitment to religious freedom.](#)

The decision underscores the principle that no individual should be coerced into violating their religious beliefs to appease the government, a core tenet upon which America was founded.

Steve Tennes, owner of Country Mill Farms, found himself embroiled in a legal battle with the city of East Lansing after he expressed his Catholic beliefs about marriage on Facebook. As a devout Catholic, Tennes stood firm in following the teachings of his faith, which include his perspective on marriage. The city officials, in response, excluded him from the local farmers market.

On Monday, a U.S. District Court judge upheld Tennes' right to exercise his religious beliefs without government interference. The court deemed East Lansing's actions a violation of Tennes' First Amendment rights, recognizing that depriving an individual of their rights based on faith dissuades religious expression.

Located in Charlotte, Michigan, Country Mill Farms is a second-generation, 120-acre family farm owned by Steve and his wife, Bridget Tennes, both military veterans. The farm had been participating in the East Lansing Farmer's Market since 2010 until 2017 when the city implemented a policy that unfairly targeted them.

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The legal battle wasn't an easy journey for the Tennes family. Steve Tennes, reflecting on their decision to sue the city, highlighted the weight of the choice they faced seven years ago. As parents and veterans, they stood at a crossroads between maintaining their family's livelihood and upholding their religious convictions.

The court's ruling affirms the broader principle that [government cannot arbitrarily penalize individuals due to their beliefs.](#) This victory underscores the importance of living in accordance with one's faith, as highlighted in verses like Acts 5:29, "We must obey God rather than men," and Matthew 22:21, "Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's."

Kate Anderson, senior counsel for Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF), which represented the Tennes family, emphasized that the court's decision is a triumph for all individuals seeking to live out their religious beliefs without fear of government retribution.

As Tennes looks forward to putting this legal battle behind him, his commitment to serving people of all backgrounds remains unwavering. This victory stands as a reminder that the foundational principle of religious freedom remains an essential cornerstone of American society, even in the face of modern challenges.

John 10:27-28 emphasizes how His sheep hear His voice and follow Him, while John 14:6 reminds us that Jesus is the way, the truth and the life. No AI can replicate the spiritual intimacy and guidance that comes from knowing and walking with Jesus.

While “Text With Jesus” offers a unique exploration of faith and technology, it’s essential to recognize its limitations. The app’s creators clarify that it doesn’t provide divine insights or possess divine consciousness. It simply generates responses based on a compilation of religious texts. We must remember that AI lacks the spiritual depth and connection that only Jesus can offer.

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Furthermore, the app introduces a controversial feature—conversations with Satan. While it claims to align with Christian teachings and values, interactions with the entity the originates all evil and temptation raises concerns. We’re cautioned in 1 Peter 5:8 to be vigilant against the devil’s schemes, and engaging with AI representations of Satan might inadvertently downplay the spiritual warfare described in the Bible.

“Text With Jesus” invites us to contemplate the evolving nature of faith in a digital era. However, as we explore these new frontiers, [we should remain grounded in the foundational truths of our faith.](#) Technology should never replace our genuine relationship with Jesus or our understanding of His teachings.

As Christians, we are warned against idols and false gods in Exodus 20:3-6. Placing our trust in AI interactions, no matter how sophisticated, can inadvertently become a form of modern idolatry. We must prioritize seeking God’s presence and wisdom through prayer, studying His Word and fostering authentic relationships with fellow believers.

While the future might bring more innovative ways to engage with faith through technology, we must tread carefully. Proverbs 3:5-6 advises us to trust in the Lord with all our

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Hospital Executive's Prayer Reveals Demonic Side of DEI

A recent prayer service hosted by Ryan Polly, a hospital executive involved in diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI), has raised eyebrows within the Christian community.

The video, reviewed by Fox News Digital, showed Polly, a biological female identifying as a male, leading a prayer service that had White participants apologizing for their perceived internalized racism as white individuals.

Fox reports that the video has since been removed.

Polly, who serves as the vice president of DEI at MaineHealth, a hospital system with a workforce of over 20,000 employees,

has been ordained as a “minister” of the group, One Spirit Learning Alliance. In the video, Polly instructs attendees on antiracist practices through a prayer dedicated to “loving spirits who are known by many names.”

[This DEI ideology is deeply rooted in critical race theory and Marxist principles.](#) Polly, attributing personal “racist narratives and biases” to skin color, urged participants to challenge systems designed to provide advantages to some while oppressing others.

However, from a Christian perspective, Polly’s claims and practices are raising serious spiritual concerns.

Praying to “spirits known by many names” veers into syncretism and leads individuals away from the truth of Jesus Christ. The Bible teaches that our identity is found in Christ alone. Verses such as Galatians 3:26-28 highlight the importance of being one in Christ, transcending human distinctions.

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The Christian view of unity emphasizes our shared identity as believers, regardless of external attributes. Romans 12:4-5 underscores this unity within the body of Christ.

It is not just the ideologies that [the DEI initiatives push that are dangerous,](#) but also the spiritual doors that are opened when people pray to false, pagan entities. This influence is demonic in nature and aims to draw people away from the salvation, redemption and freedom found in Jesus Christ. 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My First Deliverance Session Changed the Trajectory of My Life

Just before I got up to speak, a lady came to my book table and said, "Pastor Locke, you're my online pastor. I love you; thank you for your stand. I appreciate your boldness. I drove all the way here tonight from Oklahoma [because I need deliverance.](#)"

I nervously said, "Oh no, ma'am, you should have found a deliverance minister in Oklahoma before you came to Arkansas. I've never done that." Can you imagine? I just didn't think I was ready.

But she said, "I know, I watch every sermon, and I pay close attention to every word that comes out of your mouth. I told you, you're my online pastor, and I'm telling you right now I'm your guinea pig. The Holy Ghost told me to come here tonight to get some deliverance from you. I need it that bad. I'm so desperate that I'll stay till three in the morning in the cold if I have to, but you're gonna have to pray over me before I leave!"



Again, can you imagine? I was nervous as a long-tail cat in a room full of rocking chairs, so I just said OK and headed for the platform to preach.

My message that night was about the lukewarm church from Revelation chapter 3. All the while as I preached, I was thinking to myself, "I hope she gets offended or has some sort of emergency and just has to leave." I was that nervous.

When I got through preaching, I went back to the book table where it's customary to shake hands with folks and sign some books and get some pictures taken. I dragged it out as long as I could. I guarantee you I spent an hour and a half standing in the meet-and-greet line, and she patiently sat there in her little seat in that freezing cold tent with her husband and sister by her side.

When I finally ran out of people and realized my delay tactic had failed, I took a deep breath and walked over to her. My heart felt like it was about to beat out of my chest, and I simply said, "Well, here we go, ma'am." I pray for thousands of people every week, but it's never felt like this. I've discovered that it requires an entirely different level of faith to truly walk in the authority that God has given you, and before that night I didn't realize I had that kind of authority.

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I then said, "Are you ready?"

And she said, "Are you ready?"

And I'm thinking, "that's to be determined." Then I said, "Just bow your head"—not because that was necessary, but because I didn't really know what else to say or do! For that moment, I felt as dumb as a box of bricks. I had read books and listened to all of Derek Prince's CDs, but I never really spent time thinking about the "how to" part of it all. I didn't know any spirit names. I had yet to truly study Leviathan or Jezebel or their ilk. And I certainly didn't have a deliverance manual to reference.

But I knew how Jesus and the disciples did it, so I just tried to keep it simple.

I put my hand on her and said, “Evil spirit, I don’t know who you are, but you come out right now, in the name of Jesus.” She immediately slumped out of her chair, hit the floor and started convulsing. I thought, “You gotta be kidding me! It can happen that quick?”

Then I said, “In the name of Jesus, come out right now. You hear me? You hear me, you foul devil? You hear me, you foul spirit? You better come up and out right now. You’re coming all the way up and all the way out. I don’t know what your name is, but I’ll stay here all night. You come out right now in the name of Jesus!”

At this point she was wallowing around on the ground screaming and throwing up all kinds of white foamy stuff. Then she suddenly stood up, squalling and crying out, “I’m free! I’m free!” She immediately started praising God and using her prayer language, while hugging her sister and husband. Then she looked at me and said, “My back is straight. I’ve been freed from the heaviness. I’ve been freed from infirmity. I’ve been freed tonight!”

On the ride back home, I felt like a little kid. I kept saying to the guys on the bus, “It works! It not just a theory, it actually works!”

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False Accusations, Persecution Testing Educators Faith

In a heart-wrenching incident that exposes the challenges faced by Christians in India, police in central India recently arrested a Christian educator, Liju Kuriakose, [and falsely accused him of human trafficking and fraudulent conversion.](#)

The incident unfolded on July 26 in Manikpur, Chhattisgarh state, as Kuriakose was escorting a group of eight Christian students to a Bible institute. The baseless charges have cast a harsh spotlight on the ongoing persecution faced by believers in the country.

Kuriakose was apprehended by police after boarding a bus in Manikpur, en route to safely accompany the students to the railway station. It is being reported that the police officers coerced the students, including minors, to provide false statements suggesting that they were being trafficked. However, the students, valuing their faith and integrity, steadfastly refused to lie about Kuriakose, who had traveled from Kerala to ensure their secure journey to the Bible institute.

As one of the youths, Govardhan, recounted, “We all had vehemently refused and told the police that we have been Christians for a while and are not new converts. We cannot tell lies about the brother who came all the way from Kerala to help us.” Despite their courage, their resistance led to their detention by the Child Welfare Committee.

Kuriakose’s intent was to safeguard the students, ages 15 to 22, and hailing from tribal Christian families, on their journey from Manikpur to the Bible institute in Kochi, Kerala state. The circumstances took a distressing turn when Kuriakose was seized by an unidentified individual, prompting the bus to be stopped at Manikpur police station.

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The subsequent hours turned into a harrowing ordeal for Kuriakose, who faced violent interrogation and physical abuse. His efforts to establish his innocence were met with hostility, as he was treated as if he were a criminal. Despite the challenges he endured, Kuriakose’s steadfast faith and resilience continued to shine through.

In the midst of this trial, Kuriakose’s experience resonates with the words of 1 Peter 4:12-13: “Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that is taking place among you to test you, as though some strange thing happened to you. But rejoice insofar as you share in Christ’s sufferings, so that you may rejoice and be glad also in the revelation of His glory.”

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Former US Ambassador to Israel Shares Spiritual Journey of Rediscovering Biblical Landmarks

In an exclusive interview with Charisma News, David Friedman, former US ambassador to Israel during the Trump administration, unveiled his personal journey of breaking

through diplomatic norms to connect with the biblical heartland of Judea and Samaria.

Friedman's insights resonate deeply [with Christian supporters of Israel](#) who view the Jewish people as God's chosen nation.

Friedman, who took office as US ambassador in early 2017, was the first diplomat appointed during the Trump administration. Where the great messages, the great thoughts, the great prayers came from.”

One of Friedman's most striking revelations is his decision to challenge the State Department's rule and personally visit these sacred lands. Undeterred by potential obstacles, he recounted his determination to break free from bureaucratic restrictions, allowing him to personally experience the inspiration these places hold. He referred to his visit to Bethel, where the story of Jacob's Ladder unfolded, as a poignant example of the spiritual depth found in the heart of Israel.

Friedman's passion for fostering a deeper understanding between the Jewish and Christian communities fueled his ambition to create lasting change. Over his four years of service in Israel, he grew increasingly convinced that experiencing these sacred places was crucial to promoting understanding and unity.

"People that have been [to Israel] to Tel Aviv into Haifa, which are great places and important places to visit, haven't been to Shiloh Bethel, Bethlehem, Hebron, Rachel's Tomb," explains Friedman.

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"They just haven't been there, and they haven't been able to make the essential connection between these places and the incredible biblical heroes who lived their lives there."

To achieve this goal, Friedman collaborated with TBN and his friend Matt Crouch to produce a documentary. The documentary would feature a route stretching from Nazareth to Beersheba, [encompassing the core biblical landmarks](#) that hold immense spiritual significance. Joined by former Secretary of State Mike Pompeo, the documentary aimed to bridge the gap between the Jewish and Christian perspectives on these sacred sites.

The collaboration was met with enthusiasm, and the result is a breathtaking and thought-provoking documentary that showcases the beauty and spiritual resonance of these often-neglected areas. Friedman commended TBN's commitment to the project, highlighting the extraordinary resources dedicated to capturing the awe-inspiring landscapes and the essence of the biblical heroes who once walked those paths.

"We had a film crew at every place. We had five or six cameras on every shot. The scenery is breathtaking, and that's how this came about," says Friedman.

Friedman's account also touched on the personal impact these visits had on him, including a moving connection to Rachel's Tomb. He shared the story of his granddaughter's birth, which coincided with the observance of the day Rachel passed away, a poignant moment of joy amidst the tomb's history of tragedy. He also recounted the heart-wrenching tale of a bride-to-be whose life was cut short by a suicide bombing, leading her family to drape Rachel's Tomb with her unworn wedding dress as a tribute.

"It's a wedding that never happened," Friedman soberly recounted. "My cousin's fiancé, the night before her wedding, was sitting with her father...in a café in Jerusalem. [A] suicide bomber blew up and killed everybody inside, including the bride and her father. ...The family decided that they would use her wedding dress that was never worn, and make it the curtain over Rachel's Tomb, it continues to sit there to this day."

In sharing his experiences, Friedman underscored the importance of building a connection between the biblical heritage of these lands and the hearts of those who hold faith in high regard. His journey offers Christian supporters of Israel a unique opportunity to deepen their understanding of the land and its spiritual significance, fostering greater unity and appreciation between these communities.
