

Perez Hilton Opens Bible, Declares Faith While Defending Gay Identity

[Perez Hilton is stepping into a new season](#), openly sharing his first time reading the Bible while inviting millions into his personal life, struggles and beliefs.

“I am reading it from start to finish for the first time, and sharing scripture that resonates,” Hilton said, describing what has become a deeply personal spiritual journey.

He pointed to Genesis 24, reflecting on Isaac and Rebekah, and connected it to his own desire for love. “Love, however, is something that I would love and I see it coming in the future,” he said. “It’s going to be a mature love.”

At the same time, Hilton addressed the intense public focus on his sexuality and faith. “I am gay. I am very gay,” he said. “This is how God made me.” He added, “I know that God is real. I know that God saved me. And I know that God loves me.”

His openness about God’s presence in his life marks a significant shift, and it is right to recognize the importance of that step. A hunger for Scripture and a willingness to speak about God publicly is not something to dismiss. It is the beginning of something that must now be grounded in truth.

What Scripture Clearly Says

The Bible speaks directly and consistently on sexual ethics, both in the Old and New Testaments.

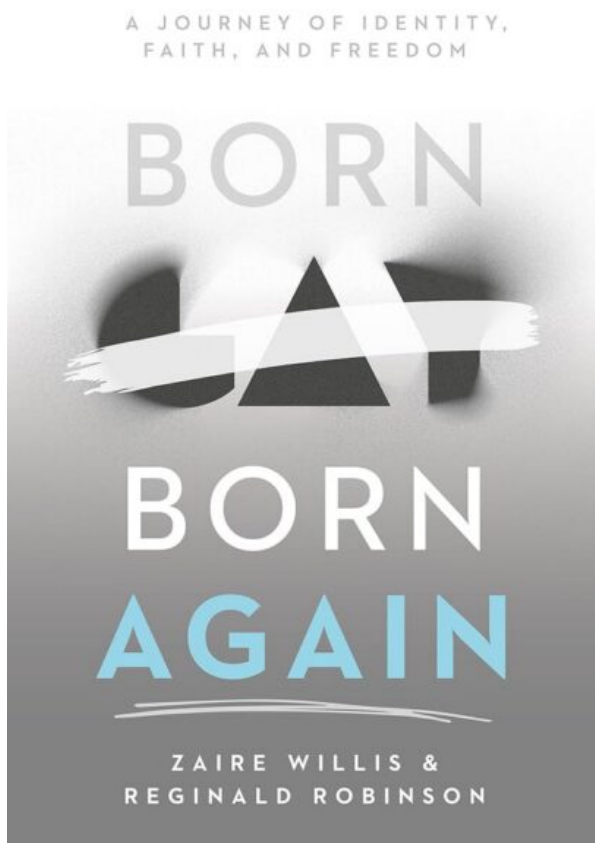
In Leviticus 18:22, Scripture says, “You shall not lie with a male as with a woman. It is an abomination.”

The New Testament reinforces this teaching through Paul the Apostle in Romans 1:26–27:

For this reason, God gave them up to dishonorable passions. Their women exchanged natural relations for unnatural ones. Likewise, the men, leaving the natural relations with women, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the due penalty of their error.

Paul's words are not vague. He identifies same-sex relations as outside God's design, [describing them as unnatural and contrary](#) to God's created order established in Genesis.

He continues this teaching in 1 Corinthians 6:9–11, declaring that those who practice sexual immorality, including homosexual acts, will not inherit the kingdom of God. Yet the passage does not end in judgment. It declares transformation. "And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified."

The Call to Repentance and New Life

Hilton's statement, "I don't believe in everything that the Bible says. I believe in what I know," reveals the critical crossroads he now faces.

Faith in Christ is not built on selecting truth. It is built on surrender to the full authority of God's Word.

Jesus calls every believer to be born again. That means leaving behind every part of the old life that conflicts with Scripture and walking in obedience to what God defines as righteous. This call is not unique to one sin or one struggle. It applies to all.

Hilton has already taken a meaningful first step by opening the Bible and acknowledging God's reality. Now comes the deeper step. Repentance. Surrender. Transformation.

A Loving but Firm Encouragement

God's love is real. Hilton is right about that. But God's love does not affirm every lifestyle. It calls people out of sin and into holiness.

Hero 5-Year-Old Saves Brother From Icy Creek, Now Fighting for His Life

A 5-year-old Minnesota boy is being hailed for his courage and selflessness after saving his younger brother from an icy creek on Easter Sunday, [a moment that has become a powerful testimony of love, sacrifice and faith.](#)

Ashkan Thibodeaux and his younger brother, Wyatt, were exploring near a creek in Itasca County when tragedy struck. As reported by Breitbart, Wyatt slipped into the freezing water and could not get out. Without hesitation, Ashkan jumped in. As a GoFundMe page described, "Ashkan didn't hesitate for a second. He saw the danger and jumped in to save his brother, guiding him to safety and saving his life."

Both boys survived, but Ashkan suffered serious injuries in the process. He endured internal damage and slight brain trauma and was placed on life support before doctors were able to stabilize him. He has since undergone multiple surgeries, including procedures involving his appendix and portions of his intestines.

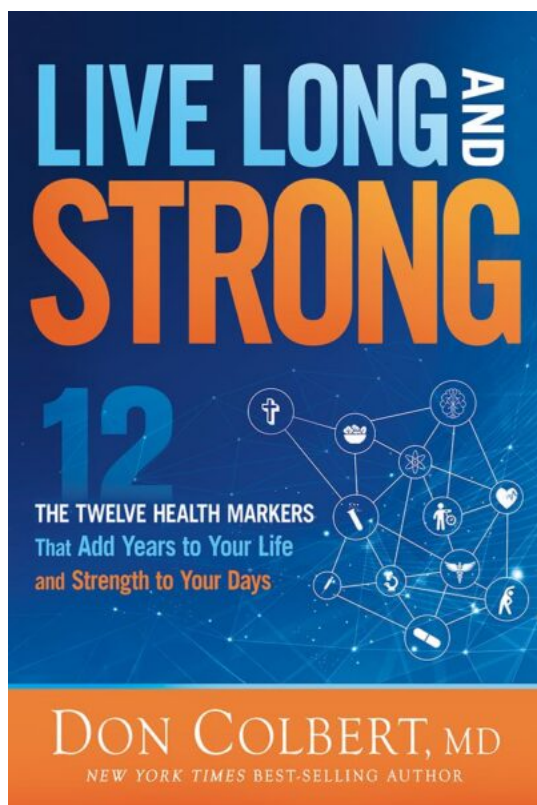
Toxic Air Emergency: Stay Indoors Advisories Issued as Dangerous Smoke Chokes Multiple US States

Air quality alerts stretched across multiple states on Wednesday [as wildfire smoke and pollution](#) pushed conditions into dangerous territory, forcing officials to urge residents to remain indoors.

“Thousands of Americans are breathing in toxins on Wednesday morning, prompting advisories to stay indoors whenever possible,” the Daily Mail reported.

Air quality maps showed “Unhealthy” zones across parts of Georgia, Alabama, Florida and New Mexico, driven by elevated levels of PM2.5. The report described these as “microscopic

particles consisting of toxic organic compounds or heavy metals... creating hazardous conditions.”

Forecasters said the situation is being fueled by wildfire smoke drifting across state lines and settling over communities. "Pollution zones are likely to persist through the weekend," the report stated, noting that calm winds and overnight conditions are trapping smoke near the ground.

The hardest-hit areas include:

- Central Georgia: Macon and Warner Robins in the most severe zones
- Southwest Georgia: Albany, with pollution spreading toward Valdosta
- Coastal Georgia: Brunswick and areas near Savannah
- Northern Florida: Counties along the Georgia border
- North-central Florida: Lake City, Gainesville and Putnam County

- Central Florida: Areas near Ocala seeing fluctuating conditions
- Florida Panhandle and Jacksonville region: Moderate to unhealthy levels
- Southern New Mexico: Las Cruces and the Mesilla Valley

Health officials warned of serious risks tied to prolonged exposure. “Health experts caution that prolonged exposure can trigger respiratory problems, aggravate asthma, strain the heart and contribute to long-term lung damage,” according to the report.

Authorities across the affected states are urging residents to limit outdoor activity. “Officials have issued air quality advisories, urging residents in the hardest-hit areas to avoid strenuous outdoor activity and remain indoors when possible,” the report said.

Dry conditions continue to worsen the crisis. “[As long as dry weather continues](#), experts say the region will remain vulnerable to sudden swings in air quality,” the Daily Mail reported.

Relief remains uncertain. “Meaningful relief is unlikely until steady rainfall moves into the region,” forecasters said, with drought conditions expected to keep fire danger and smoke risks elevated into May.

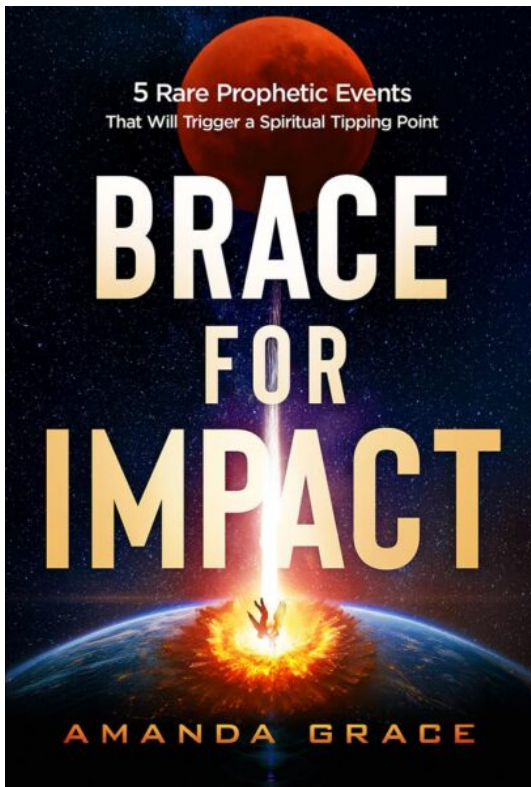

Iran AI Video Depicts Statue of Liberty as Baal, Then Blows It Up, in Ominous Warning

An AI-generated video linked to Iranian state media is drawing global attention after depicting a missile strike on the Statue of Liberty, perhaps the most symbolic image of American freedom.

The video ends with the message [“One vengeance for all”](#) and presents a dramatic portrayal of retaliation against the United States.

The clip uses a rapid montage of historical events, including the Vietnam War and the atomic bombings of Japan, to frame the United States as a long-standing global aggressor. It culminates in a digitally altered Statue of Liberty, portrayed with the head of a false god and holding religious imagery, reinforcing a message that blends political conflict with spiritual symbolism.

The video is part of a broader surge in AI-driven propaganda tied to the ongoing Iran conflict, where state-linked content is designed to shape perception, influence audiences and escalate psychological warfare. Experts warn that such content is becoming increasingly sophisticated and difficult to distinguish from reality, amplifying its impact across social media platforms.

Rising Wave of End-Times Dreams and Warnings

Alongside the slew of geopolitical messaging, a separate trend has emerged among Christian voices, in which individuals report vivid dreams and visions centered on end-time events.

These accounts consistently describe:

- Sudden nuclear attacks on major U.S. cities

- Multiple explosions occurring within a single day
- Widespread destruction across both coasts
- Foreign military involvement and global conflict

Many of the visions share [similar themes of “sudden destruction”](#) following declarations of peace, echoing biblical passages often associated with the end times. The repetition and consistency of these experiences have led some to view them as warnings tied to a broader spiritual awakening.

The messages often interpret current global instability, moral decline and rising conflict as signs pointing toward prophetic fulfillment, with a focus on urgency and preparation.

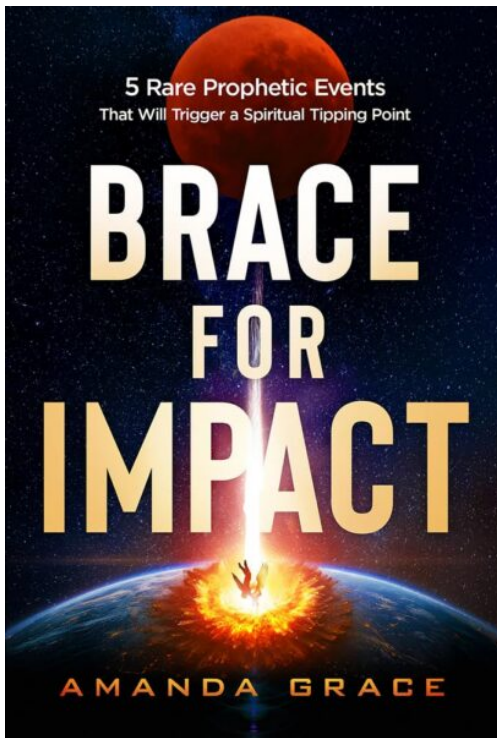
Man Claiming World's Highest IQ Declares: 'Jesus Is Coming Soon'

A viral video featuring South Korean figure YoungHoon Kim is drawing widespread attention after he declared that [Jesus Christ is coming soon](#), delivering a message filled with urgency, conviction and bold claims about the end of history.

He points to global instability, moral decline and rapid technological change as evidence, adding, "When you see these things begin to happen, know that I am near, right at the door."

While emphasizing urgency, Kim also addresses timing directly: "I do not know the exact time. But I believe the return of Jesus is very near, perhaps within 10 years." He reinforces the call to readiness with a simple message: ["Be ready... Time is very near."](#)

His message centers on the certainty of Christ's return as both warning and hope. "Jesus will come again... it will be the return of the King," he says, describing a visible, global event that brings judgment and restoration.

Scripture teaches that no one knows the exact day or hour of Christ's return, while calling for watchfulness and readiness, as seen in Matthew 24 and 1 Thessalonians 5.

Claims surrounding Kim's reported IQ continue to face

scrutiny, with experts noting that extremely high scores are difficult to verify and often exceed the limits of standardized testing.

Oil Prices Plunge After Iran Reopens Strait of Hormuz to Shipping

Oil markets reacted swiftly on Friday after Iran signaled a temporary reopening of one of the world's most critical shipping routes, [easing fears of prolonged disruption](#) to global energy supplies.

The Strait of Hormuz will remain accessible to commercial vessels during a 10-day ceasefire tied to the Israel-Lebanon conflict, Fox News reported. Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi confirmed the passage would be open, while a senior Iranian official said ships would move through designated safe lanes, though naval vessels remain restricted.

In line with the ceasefire in Lebanon, the passage for all commercial vessels through Strait of Hormuz is declared completely open for the remaining period of ceasefire, on the

coordinated route as already announced by Ports and Maritime Organisation of the Islamic Rep. of Iran.

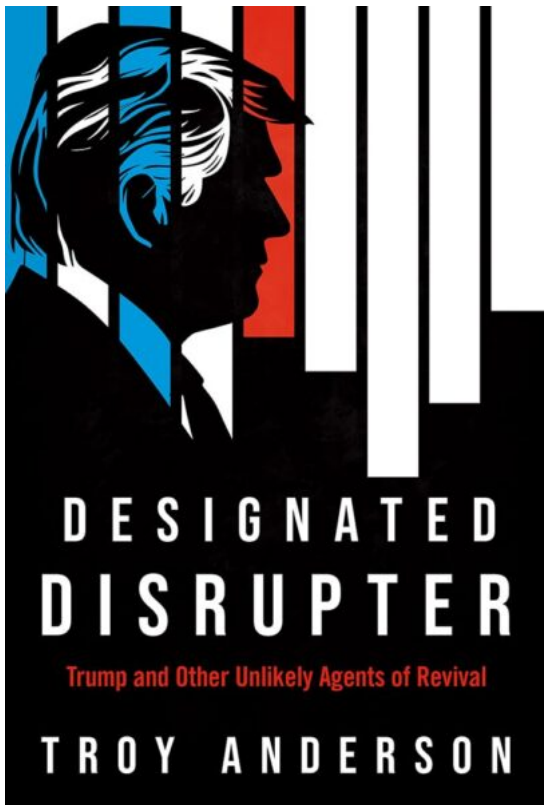

President Donald Trump confirmed the strategic balance in place, posting that the strait is “COMPLETELY OPEN AND READY FOR BUSINESS AND FULL PASSAGE,” while adding that the U.S. naval blockade targeting Iran will remain “IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT... UNTIL SUCH TIME AS OUR TRANSACTION WITH IRAN IS 100% COMPLETE.”

Oil prices tumble on reopening news

The announcement sent oil prices sharply lower after weeks of volatility driven by conflict in the region. West Texas Intermediate crude fell more than 10% to under \$85 per barrel, while Brent crude dropped more than 10% to around \$89.

Markets had previously surged during the height of tensions, with WTI peaking near \$113 and Brent climbing above \$119. Analysts now see the potential for a continued decline. Brian Therien, senior analyst at Edward Jones, said, “While U.S. restrictions on Iranian ports remain in place, oil futures markets are also retreating, now implying crude prices could move back toward the low-\$70s by year-end.”

The Strait of Hormuz remains a vital artery for global energy, carrying roughly one-fifth of the world's oil and liquefied natural gas. Its earlier closure amid threats of Iranian attacks and sea mines had rattled markets and raised concerns about supply shocks.

[Shipping companies are proceeding carefully.](#) Some firms have delayed transit while evaluating safety conditions, citing ongoing uncertainty. Industry leaders welcomed the reopening but warned that risks such as sea mines and unclear enforcement measures remain unresolved.

Still, the reopening of the strait and the sharp drop in oil prices signal a potential turning point. If the downward trend holds, Americans could soon begin to feel some long-awaited relief at the gas pump.

NASA Astronaut Breaks Down After Seeing Cross Following Artemis II Space Mission

Astronauts on the recent [Artemis II mission](#) are offering a rare glimpse into how seeing Earth from deep space is stirring something far deeper than science. It is awakening a sense of wonder that points straight to the Creator.

Commander Reid Wiseman, who has traveled more than 250,000 miles to the moon and back, described one of the most emotional moments of his life not in orbit, but after returning home.

“I’m not really a religious person but there was no other avenue for me to explain anything or experience anything,” Wiseman said. “So I asked for the chaplain on the Navy ship to just come visit us for a minute. When that man walked in ... I saw the cross on his collar and I just broke down in tears.”

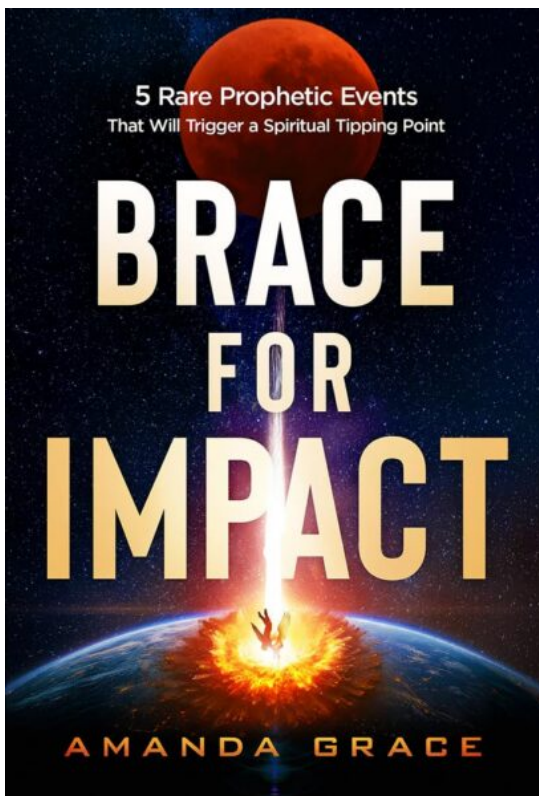

For a man who does not claim faith, the experience left him searching for language beyond science. He described the mission as “other-worldly and amazing,” admitting it is “very hard to fully grasp what we just went through.”

Yet Wiseman was not alone in that response. [Pilot Victor Glover, an outspoken Christian](#), said his experience aligned completely.

“The only thing I would add is I am a religious person, but everything else is the same,” Glover said.

That unity between belief and disbelief speaks volumes. Whether approaching space with faith or without it, both men encountered the same overwhelming reality.

During the 10-day mission, the crew witnessed Earth appearing to set behind the moon, a rare solar eclipse and the vast depth of the galaxy stretching into darkness. Wiseman recalled one moment in particular: "I don't think humanity has evolved to the point of being able to comprehend what we are looking at right now."

Astronauts have long described this phenomenon as the Overview Effect, a shift in perspective that brings awe, humility and a deeper awareness of humanity's place in creation. From that vantage point, Earth is no longer divided by borders or politics. It is fragile, suspended in the vastness of space.

The Artemis II crew, which also includes Christina Koch and Jeremy Hansen, set a new record for the farthest humans have traveled from Earth. Their mission tested the Orion spacecraft ahead of future lunar landings, with NASA aiming to return astronauts to the moon's surface by 2028.

But beyond the technical milestones, something else is becoming clear. When men and women step outside the boundaries of Earth and gaze back at creation from the edge of the cosmos, the response is often the same.

Awe. Wonder. And a recognition that what they are seeing cannot be explained by science alone.

Mystery Deepens After 11th Scientist Death Linked to UFO and Anti-Gravity Research

A growing pattern of deaths among scientists tied to advanced aerospace and energy research is raising serious concerns after the mysterious death of anti-gravity researcher Amy Eskridge.

According to a recent Daily Mail report, Eskridge, 34, was found dead in Huntsville, Alabama, on June 11, 2022, from what was officially described as a self-inflicted gunshot wound. No detailed findings from law enforcement or medical examiners have been publicly released, leaving lingering questions about the circumstances surrounding her death.

Before her death, Eskridge had been working on anti-gravity propulsion, [a field with the potential to transform space travel and energy systems](#). She had also warned publicly that her life was in danger as she pushed forward with plans to disclose her research.

“I need to disclose soon, man. I need to publish soon because it’s like escalating. It’s getting more and more aggressive,” Eskridge said in a 2020 podcast. “Over the past 12 months, it’s been escalating, like more aggressive, more invasive digging through my underwear drawer and sexual threats.”

Eskridge co-founded the Institute for Exotic Science with her father, retired NASA engineer Richard Eskridge, to bring transparency to anti-gravity research. She explained the purpose clearly: “If you stick your neck out in public, at least someone notices if your head gets chopped off.”

Since her death, her institute has shut down, and its online presence has disappeared.

Retired British intelligence officer Franc Milburn, who investigated Eskridge's claims of harassment, concluded her death was not a suicide. He documented repeated incidents of intimidation, including alleged attacks involving a "directed energy weapon."

"Somebody was after her work," Milburn said. "One, trying to get her to desist from doing the work, and two... to actually stop her, to debilitate her so she was unable to do the work."

Those findings were later submitted to Congress by independent investigators in 2023.

Journalist Michael Shellenberger also testified before a public hearing on Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena that Eskridge was "murdered by a 'private aerospace company' in the U.S. because she was involved in the UAP conversation."

Eskridge's case does not stand alone.

Her death is now being cited as part of a troubling pattern involving at least 10 other scientists and researchers connected to space exploration, nuclear technology, and advanced propulsion systems who have either died suddenly or disappeared under unclear circumstances in recent years.

Since 2022 alone, at least five additional researchers have died, including two who were murdered in their own homes. Others tied to sensitive research fields have reportedly vanished without clear explanations.

While officials have not confirmed any direct connection between these cases, the clustering of deaths among individuals working in highly specialized and often classified areas has fueled growing concern among national security observers and independent investigators.

The U.S. government has repeatedly [denied the existence of alien technology](#) or secret anti-gravity programs. However, Eskridge herself claimed her work was part of a broader push toward public disclosure of advanced technologies long discussed in connection with UFO and UAP research.

For years, Christian author and researcher L.A. Marzulli has warned that these kinds of cases point to something far deeper than isolated incidents. Marzulli states that advanced propulsion, UFO encounters and the sudden silencing of key voices all connect to a growing global deception rooted in the supernatural. He has repeatedly argued that what is unfolding is not just technological but spiritual, echoing the days of Noah when fallen knowledge and non-human influence shaped human history.

The pattern of intimidation, suppression and death surrounding cutting-edge research signals that the truth behind these phenomena is being actively hidden as the world moves closer to full disclosure.

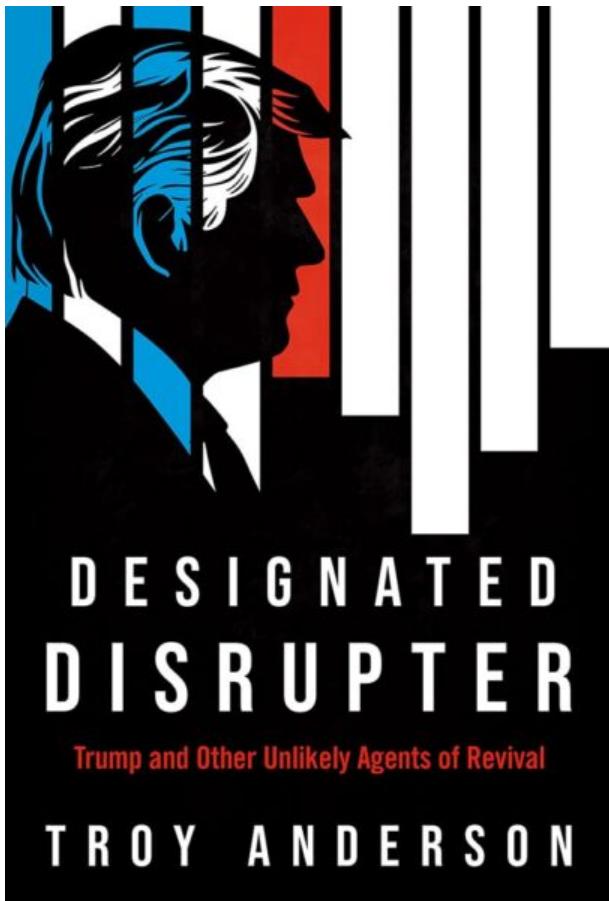
Trump Border Czar Tom Homan Fires Back at Pope Leo as Immigration Clash Escalates

A growing clash between the White House and the Vatican is intensifying as border czar Tom Homan pushes back against criticism from [Pope Leo XIV](#) over immigration and global policy.

Speaking outside the White House, Homan said he is ready to engage directly with Vatican leadership. "I welcome discussion with any of them," he said. But he made his position clear, adding, "I wish they'd stay out of immigration, they don't know what they're talking about."

Homan, a lifelong Catholic, pointed to the human cost of illegal immigration. "Illegal immigration is not a victimless crime," he said. He described firsthand scenes from the border, including "a 9-year-old girl that got raped multiple times" and standing "in the back of a tractor trailer with 19 dead aliens at my feet, including a 5-year-old boy that baked to death." He said those realities shape his view and would change minds if others experienced them.

He also defended Donald Trump and his border policies. "He's saving thousands of lives a year because he has a secure border," Homan said. "Where President Trump had the most secure border in the lifetime of this nation, right now, lives are being saved." He added that enforcement has crippled criminal networks, saying, "Human traffickers are out of business. The cartels are going bankrupt because of that secure border."

[Pope Leo has taken a different tone.](#) He said, "I think every country has a right to determine who and how and when people enter," but raised concerns about how enforcement is carried out. "When people are living good lives, and many of them for 10, 15, 20 years, to treat them in a way that is extremely disrespectful, to say the least, and there's been some violence, unfortunately," he said, urging Americans to listen to church leaders.

The disagreement has spilled into sharp public criticism. Trump wrote that "Pope Leo is WEAK on Crime, and terrible for Foreign Policy," and called on him to "get his act together as Pope" and "focus on being a Great Pope, not a Politician."

Trump also addressed the pope's stance on global threats, telling reporters, "We don't like a pope that's going to say that it's OK to have a nuclear weapon." He added, "We don't

want a pope that says crime is OK in our cities. I don't like it. I'm not a big fan of Pope Leo."

[Pope Leo responded](#) with a steady tone. "I have no fear of the Trump administration," he said. "The things that I say are certainly not meant as attacks on anyone." He pointed to a broader mission, saying, "I will continue to speak out loudly against war, looking to promote peace, promoting dialogue and multilateral relationships among the states to look for just solutions to problems." He added, "Too many people are suffering in the world today. Too many innocent people are being killed. And I think someone has to stand up and say there's a better way."

Vice President JD Vance struck a more measured tone. "In some cases, it would be best for the Vatican to stick to matters of morality and let the president of the United States stick to dictating American public policy," he said. At the same time, he dismissed the tension as manageable, noting, "We certainly have a good relationship with the Vatican, but we're also going to disagree on substantive questions from time to time. I think that's a totally reasonable thing."

The back-and-forth highlights a widening divide over immigration and only appears to be getting worse by the day. Let us join together in prayer that there be a moment of reconciliation between the White House and the Vatican.

Jack Hibbs Breaks Down Angels, Fallen Angels and Demons in Eye-Opening Teaching

[Pastor Jack Hibbs](#) is diving into a topic that many churches skip right on over, and people are paying attention. In a recent teaching, he walks through what the Bible actually says about angels, fallen angels and demons, and why it matters right now.

“These topics are answered in the Bible,” Hibbs said, pointing out that many believers are asking questions because “your church or your pastors won’t touch these things.”

Created Beings With a Purpose

Hibbs starts with a key distinction that sets everything else in motion. “The Bible says in numerous places that God created angels,” he said. Then he adds something that often gets overlooked. “There is no reference to God creating demons.”

That difference becomes the foundation for understanding the spiritual world.

Angels, according to Hibbs, were created by Christ and exist in a structured spiritual realm. They serve God and worship Him. “Good angels serve the very will of God,” he said.

They are not just abstract beings either. Scripture shows they can show up in physical form. “Lot saw these two angels with his natural eyes,” Hibbs said, pointing to Genesis 19.

Fallen Angels vs. Demons

This is where Hibbs slows things down and draws a firm line. "I will never mix angels with demons," he said. "I believe that there's a difference."

He lays it out in a way that makes it easy to follow:

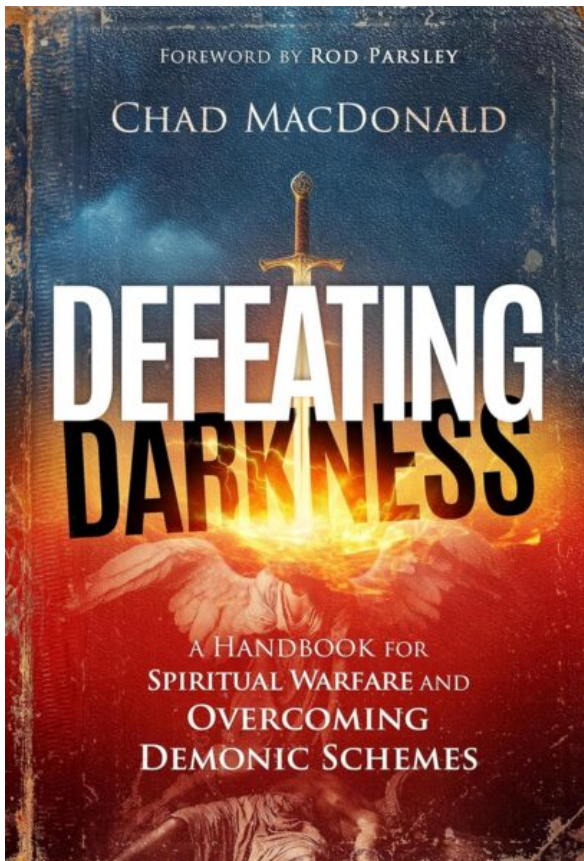
Fallen Angels

- Created by God as angels
- Joined Satan's rebellion
- "Satan... influenced a third of the angelic host"
- Still angels in nature, but now opposed to God
- Lucifer "was perfect... until iniquity was found in you"

Demons

- Not described in the Bible as created by God
- "There are no good demons. They're all bad demons"
- Identified as unclean spirits
- Seek to possess people or animals
- "My name is Legion, for we are many"

Hibbs makes the distinction simple. Fallen angels are rebels. Demons are something else entirely, and they are corrupt from the start.

The Fall of Lucifer

Hibbs points to Ezekiel and Isaiah to explain how everything unraveled. "You are the anointed cherub who covers," he said, describing Lucifer's original position.

Lucifer was not just another angel. He held authority, carried beauty and wielded influence. But pride took over. "I will ascend... I will be like the Most High," Hibbs said, quoting Isaiah.

That decision triggered a chain reaction, pulling a third of the angels into rebellion.

Why This Matters Right Now

[Hibbs ties all of this back](#) to what believers are facing today. "The Bible warns us that in the last days... doctrines of

demons” will spread, he said.

He also pointed to Jesus’ words about the last days resembling “the days of Noah” and “Sodom and Gomorrah,” pushing listeners to turn to the Old Testament for context.

What stands out in Hibbs’ teaching is his ability to connect these ideas to everyday thinking. “Deceiving spirits... will infiltrate our logic and our reason and theology to deceive,” he said.

This is about recognizing what is happening spiritually and not getting caught off guard.

Knowing the difference is about keeping us anchored in truth when deception starts sounding convincing. When we understand what Scripture actually teaches about angels, fallen angels and demons, we are far less likely to be pulled into confusion or false doctrine.

As Hibbs warned, “deceiving spirits... will infiltrate our logic and our reason and theology to deceive,” and that makes it all the more important that we stay rooted in the Bible so we are guarded and ready.
