

El Niño Comeback Ahead: What It Means for the Rest of 2026

After months of cooler ocean conditions shaping weather around the globe, a major shift is now underway.

Scientists say [the current La Niña pattern is fading fast](#), and something very different is on the horizon.

According to the latest update from the Climate Prediction Center, “a transition from La Niña to ENSO-neutral is expected in the next month,” signaling the end of the current phase that has influenced weather since last year.

For us everyday Americans, that means the atmosphere is entering a temporary calm period before a likely flip in the opposite direction.

From La Niña to Neutral

La Niña has been marked by cooler-than-normal ocean temperatures in the Pacific. That trend held steady into February, with “below-average sea surface temperatures persisting in the east-central equatorial Pacific Ocean.”

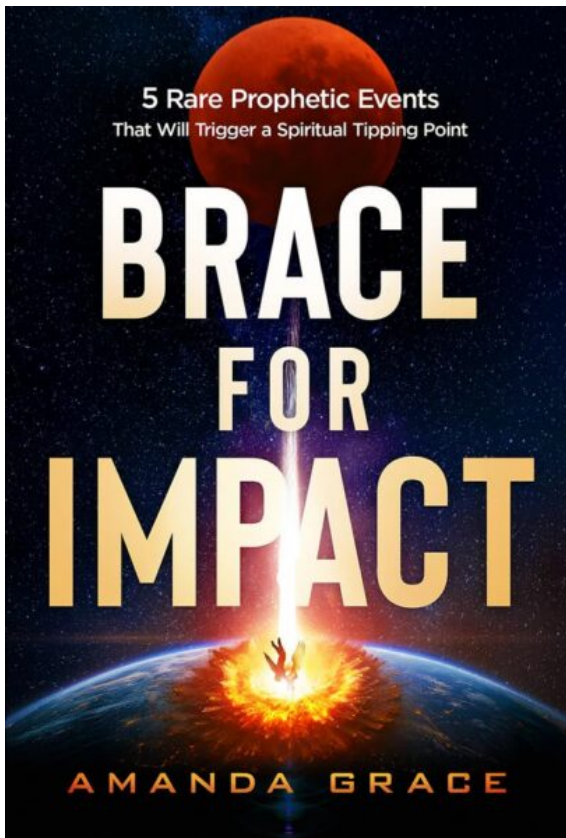
But signs of change are already building beneath the surface.

Scientists report that ocean heat is rising below the surface, a key signal that the system is preparing to shift. At the same time, wind patterns and storm activity are beginning to loosen their grip on the La Niña pattern.

In simple terms, the engine driving La Niña is running out of fuel.

Forecasters now say ENSO-neutral conditions are most likely through early summer, with a “55% chance” of neutral

conditions lasting from May through July.



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El Niño Likely by Summer

After that, the pattern is expected to flip.

"In June-August 2026, El Niño is likely to emerge (62% chance) and persist through at least the end of 2026," the report states.

[El Niño is the opposite of La Niña.](#) Instead of cooler waters, the Pacific Ocean warms up, which can dramatically shift weather patterns across the globe.

That can mean wetter conditions in some regions, drought in others and an increase in extreme weather events.

While it is too early to know exactly how strong this El Niño will become, forecasters say there is "a 1-in-3 chance that it

would be ‘strong’ during October-December 2026.”

That is where the term “super El Niño” begins to enter the conversation.

What a Strong El Niño Could Mean

If a strong El Niño develops, it can have widespread impacts.

In the United States, that often means:

- Increased rainfall across the southern states
- Higher risk of flooding in certain regions
- Warmer winters in the northern U.S.
- Fewer Atlantic hurricanes due to increased wind shear

Globally, strong El Niño events have been linked to heat waves, crop disruptions and unusual storm patterns.

The current forecast stops short of guaranteeing a “super” event, but the building conditions are enough to keep scientists watching closely.

The report notes that rising subsurface heat and weakening trade winds are key reasons why “the increasing odds of El Niño are supported.”

Forecast Comes With Some Uncertainty

There is one important caveat.

Forecasts made during the spring are known to be less reliable, meaning there is still room for changes in how this develops.

La Niña is on its way out. Neutral conditions are next. And El

Niño is increasingly likely to take over before the year is out.

For now, the world is entering a transition phase. What follows could shape weather patterns across the globe through the rest of 2026.

Does God Want Us in Space? Astrophysicist Connects NASA Missions to Genesis

As space exploration surges back into focus with [the launch of the Artemis II crew](#) and their moon mission, questions about faith and science are rising with it. But Christian astrophysicist Hugh Ross says the deeper we go, the clearer the Bible becomes.

“He made us curious. I mean, we’re unique amongst all life on planet Earth in that we’re curious about everything,” Ross said to conservative commentator Glenn Beck. “I think God gave us a curiosity for a reason. He really does want us to explore.”

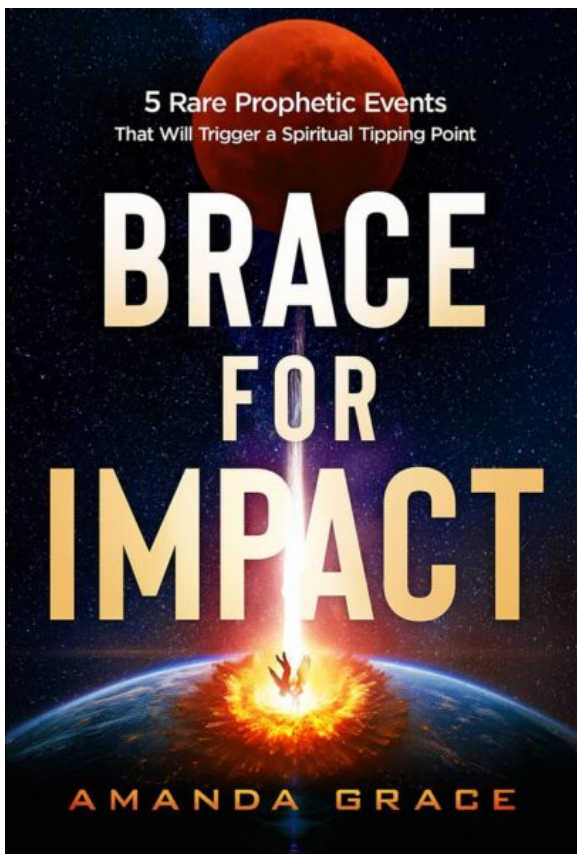
That curiosity, he explained, does not compete with faith. It strengthens it.

Does God Want Us Exploring Space?

As debate grows over missions to the moon and beyond, Ross pushed back on the idea that space exploration is a waste or an act of pride.

“We want to know what’s beyond the universe,” he said, pointing to humanity’s unique desire to explore what no other creation even considers.

Rather than a rebellion against God, Ross framed exploration as something rooted in design. The drive to discover is not accidental. It is intentional.



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A Different Look at Noah's Flood

Ross tackled one of Scripture's most debated events head-on. "The Bible tells us that the flood lasted 375 days," he said. "There had to be a lot of melting ice and snow for the flood to last that long."

He pointed to massive ice age melt events and said the flood wiped out all humanity at the time without covering the entire globe. "It also puts the flood early enough in human history that the flood can wipe out the entire world of humanity."

He also reframed the purpose behind it. "Humanity was literally in danger of self-extermination," Ross said. "At least nine out of 10 people died as a result of being murdered."

Genesis and Modern Science Align

Ross said the most striking detail is not just accuracy, but order. "It's not just that the descriptions are correct, everything is in the correct chronological sequence."

He pointed to scientific discoveries that now mirror Genesis, including atmospheric changes tied to oxygen levels. "When the oxygen hit 8% the atmosphere... cleared you could see through it."

He added that Scripture described key features of the universe long before modern astronomy. "The universe has a beginning... expands... and gets progressively colder."

The Sign That Matters Most

[While many look to the skies for answers,](#) Ross pointed to a different sign. "Jesus told His disciples that He would return the moment that His followers take the Good News... to all the people groups of the world."

The mission is within reach. “We have the wealth, the technology and the people... All we lack is the motivation.”

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This 1 Passage of Scripture Left John Bevere Stunned, And He's Finally Explaining Why

For years, the timing of the rapture has sparked intense debate across the body of Christ.

Now, [Bible teacher John Bevere](#) is stepping into the conversation with clarity and conviction.

“I’ve never shared this before,” Bevere said on his podcast as he addressed the question: When does the catching away of the church occur?

“We’re going to talk about the catching away of the church... does it occur prior to the tribulation... or post tribulation?”

Not About Division

Bevere made it clear this issue should not divide believers.

We Are Not Appointed to Wrath

[At the center of Bevere’s argument](#) is a clear biblical distinction.

“First reason why I believe we will leave before the tribulation begins... we are not appointed to wrath,” he said.

“Tribulation is the wrath of the world against believers... the tribulation is the outpouring of God’s wrath on a sinful world.”

He pointed to Scripture declaring, “God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation.”

A Sobering Reality

Bevere underscored the severity of what Scripture describes during the tribulation.

“All the water on earth is going to be turned to blood,” he said. “There will be terrible storms with hail... 75 pounds.”

“In just the fourth seal... one fourth of all mankind will be killed.”

Then he posed the key question: “Does this sound like the language directed towards His bride?”

A Revelation From Scripture

Bevere also shared a moment of personal breakthrough.

“It took me three solid days,” he said. “I have never heard anybody preach this in my life.”

Pointing to Isaiah 26, he explained that believers are brought into “chambers” before judgment falls.

“These chambers have to be in heaven,” he said. “This shows... the resurrection... will happen before the... indignation is poured out.”

Hope, Not Fear

Ultimately, Bevere said this teaching should lead us to urgency and hope.

“There are people that no matter what God does, they don’t want to be saved,” he said.

For us, this is not about winning arguments or proving timelines. It is about staying ready, staying faithful and making sure no one around us misses what God is offering right now.

The conversation about when He comes will continue. But the call to be ready is already here.

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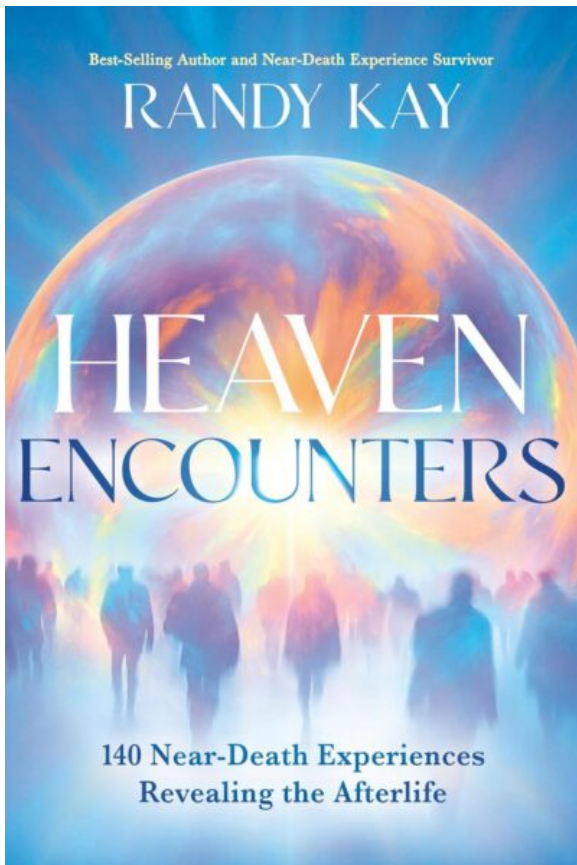
Perez Hilton Breaks Down in Tears Reading the Bible, Opens Up New Life in God

"I didn't care who I hurt. I just cared about the views, the attention, the money," he said.

Now, he says his focus has shifted.

"What matters is today. How I behave today, how I behave tomorrow," he said. "God gave me a new lease on life... to truly be better and do better."

From Crisis to Conversion

This moment builds on his earlier revelation after a life-threatening hospitalization with severe sepsis, where he said God revealed Himself to him and changed his life.

Raised Catholic but not previously committed in faith, Hilton described that experience as the turning point that led to his current spiritual journey.

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‘No Known Parallel’: Ancient Christian Artifact Discovered

Near Sea of Galilee Stuns Experts

A stunning archaeological discovery near the Sea of Galilee is shedding new light on the earliest practices of the Christian faith, revealing a depth of tradition that has remained hidden for centuries.

Archaeologists working in the ancient city of Hippos have uncovered a rare artifact that could reshape understanding of early baptism rituals, as reported by Fox News.

[The 1,400-year-old object](#) was found inside a ceremonial baptism hall known as a photisterion, a place where new believers entered into one of Christianity's most sacred acts. Officials described the discovery as "a rectangular block bearing three hemispheric cavities, found beside a baptismal font in a newly revealed ceremonial hall."

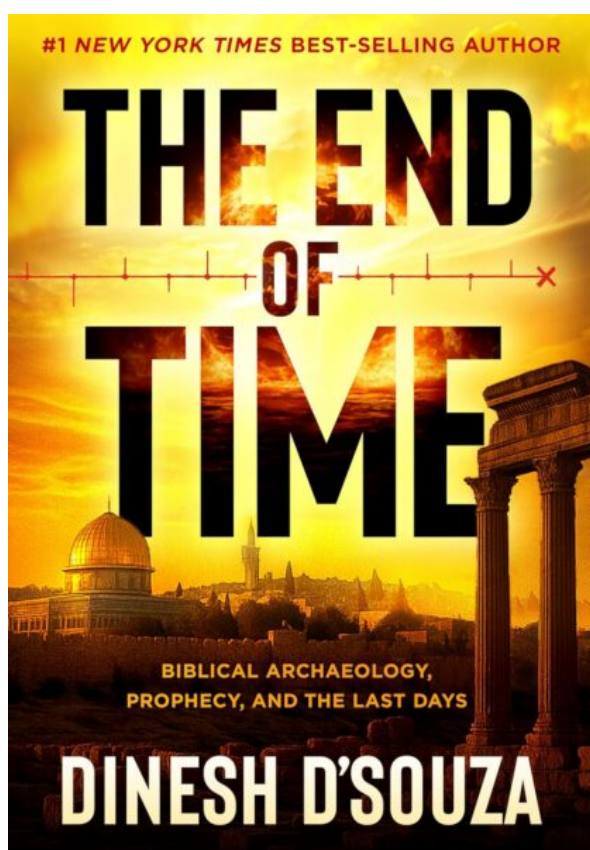

Researchers believe the unique design points to a deeper layer

of early Christian worship. The three cavities may have held oils used in a threefold baptismal process, a structure that stands apart from what is typically known. Early Christian baptisms more commonly involved two anointings, making this artifact especially significant.

“After extensive examination and comparison, the scholars concluded that no known parallels to the artifact exist,” officials said.



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The artifact was preserved when the structure collapsed during an earthquake in 749 A.D., [protecting it beneath rubble for more than a millennium.](#)

Today, it stands as a powerful witness to the devotion and detail that marked early Christian communities in a region closely tied to the ministry of Jesus.

Archaeologist Michael Eisenberg said the significance of the

find was not immediately clear. “The object was ‘nothing special at first glance,’” he said to Fox News. “But here is exactly where the archaeological and liturgical studies came into play.”

“Realizing that it is a one-of-a-kind artifact that may fill unknown regional and perhaps wider lacunae in one of the most ancient and sacred Christian ceremonies was a complete surprise,” Eisenberg added.

He noted that the discovery may “open a portal” into how baptism rituals developed across different regions of the early church. “In different regions, distinct liturgical traditions developed, many of which are not documented in written sources,” he said. “This find offers a rare glimpse into how the baptismal rite was shaped and practiced in the Byzantine Christian community of Hippos.”

This discovery does more than fill historical gaps. It points back to the enduring power of baptism as a public declaration

of faith, a practice rooted not only in Scripture but in a living tradition that has carried through generations.

As new pieces of the past come into focus, they remind us that the foundations of our faith were laid with intentionality, reverence and unwavering devotion to Christ.

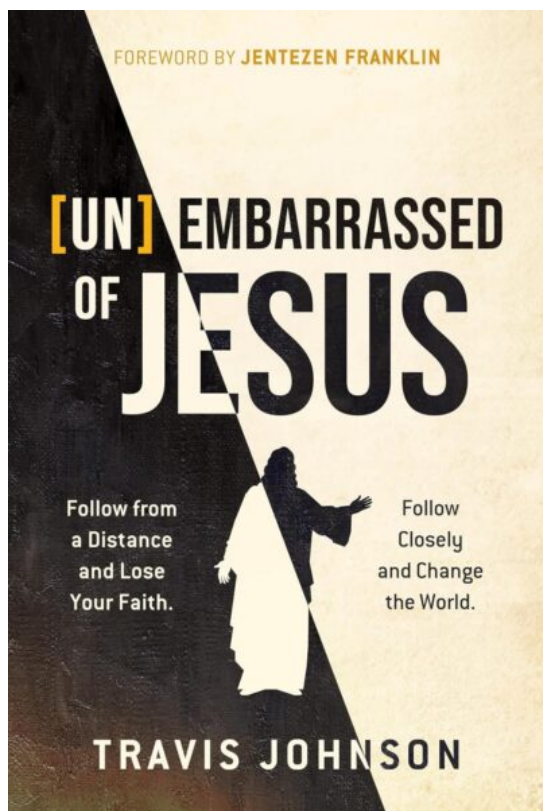
Underwood said. “You are going to have to stand strong in your faith and remember who got you here, because it wasn’t you.”

That foundation was on full display during the “Songs of Faith” episode of [“American Idol,”](#) which aired during Easter week. What unfolded was not just another themed show. It became a moment where worship, prayer and testimony took center stage in front of millions.

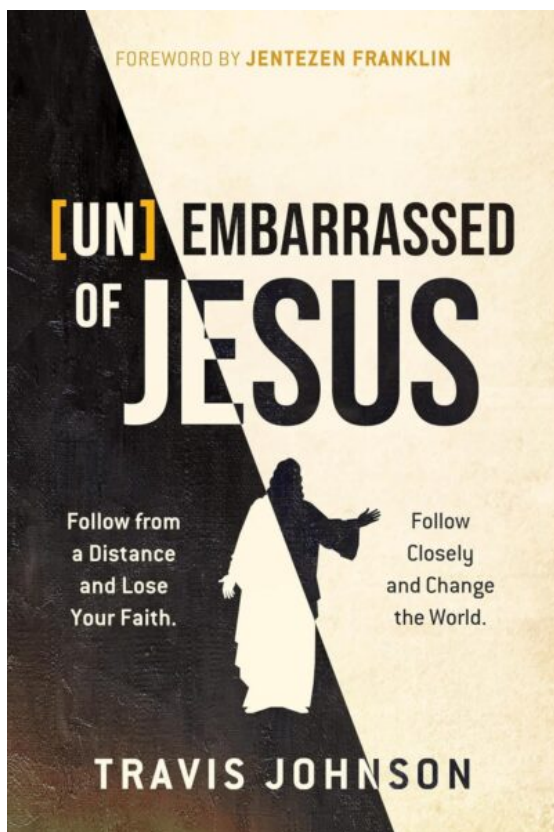
During a live interview with CBS News, as part of the Artemis II crew's journey beyond Earth's orbit, Glover delivered an Easter message that carried unusual weight. He was not addressing fellow astronauts. He was speaking to humanity

watching from home.

“I don’t have anything prepared. I’m glad you brought it up, though; I think these observances are important,” Glover said when asked about the holiday.

Floating in the void, with Earth suspended in the distance, Glover described a perspective few humans have ever experienced, sharing it in real time with those still on the planet.

“As we are so far from Earth and looking at the beauty of creation, I think, for me, one of the really important personal perspectives that I have up here is I can really see the Earth as one thing,” he said.



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That view does something. It removes borders. It silences noise. It reveals design.

“When I read the Bible and I look at all the amazing things

that were done for us... You guys are talking to us because we're in a spaceship really far from earth, but you're on a spaceship called Earth that was created to give us a place to live in the universe and the cosmos."

From deep space, Earth does not look ordinary. [It looks intentional.](#)

Glover made it clear that his words were meant for those listening back home.

"Maybe the distance we are from you makes you think what we're doing is special, but we're the same distance from you. And I'm trying to tell you just trust me you are special," he said. "In all of this emptiness this is a whole bunch of nothing this thing we call the universe you have this oasis this beautiful place that we get to exist together."

It is a striking picture. Endless darkness surrounding a single, life-filled world. Not random. Not accidental. Set apart.

Easter, Glover said, is the perfect moment for those on Earth to pause and recognize that truth.

"I think, as we go into Easter Sunday, thinking about all the cultures all around the world, whether you celebrate it or not, whether you believe in God or not, this is an opportunity for us to remember where we are, who we are, and that we are the same thing, and that we've gotta get through this together."

From millions of miles away, the message is not distant at all. It is directed straight at those living on the very world he described.

“People are playing around with more demonic mess than ever before,” Adams says.

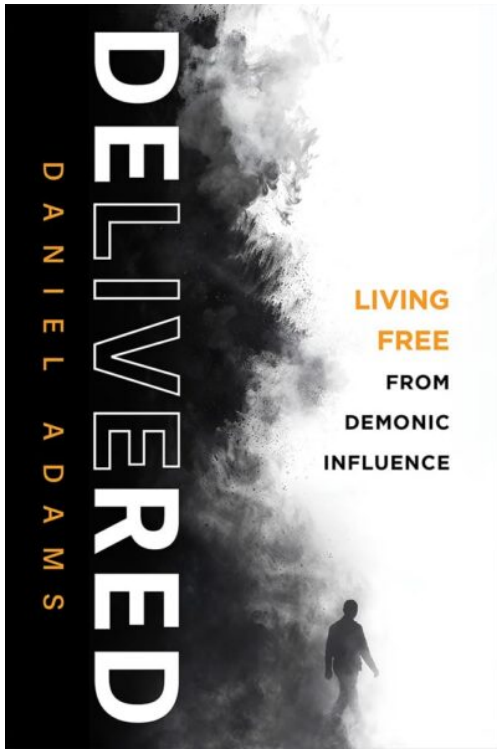
He warns that these practices are not harmless trends. They are open doors to spiritual bondage, torment and long-term destruction.

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'Very Real Threat': Congress

Pushes Pentagon to Release UFO Videos

Doesn't it seem like disclosure events and statements about UFOs have increased exponentially in recent years? What was once dismissed as a fringe conspiracy is now being openly discussed at the highest levels of government, and lawmakers are pressing for answers.

Members of Congress are now demanding the release of dozens of classified videos [involving unidentified anomalous phenomena](#), raising fresh concerns about national security and transparency.

Lawmakers Push for Transparency

Republican Rep. Anna Paulina Luna has issued a firm deadline of April 14, 2026, for federal agencies to turn over 46 specific UAP videos, many of which were recorded by military personnel.

"The lack of disclosure regarding the very real threat posed by UAPs in and around US restricted airspace is concerning," Luna said.

She added, "The presence of UAPs in and around the sensitive airspaces of US military installations poses a threat to the security of the armed forces and their readiness."

Luna also criticized the government's response to inquiries, stating that the Task Force has found responses from the All-domain Anomaly Resolution Office to be "less than adequate."

In a separate statement, she emphasized, "The continued lack of transparency surrounding these anomalies and the potential national security threat they pose is troubling."

Military Encounters Raise Alarms

The requested footage reportedly includes encounters with spherical, cigar-shaped and “Tic Tac”-like objects seen over war zones, oceans and restricted airspace.

Some of the videos show objects operating near U.S. bases, warships and training zones, with multiple instances of high-speed movements and coordinated activity.

Officials are increasingly concerned these objects may be conducting surveillance or testing U.S. defenses, posing risks to both pilots and military operations.

Pentagon Responds to Disclosure Push

The push for transparency follows [an executive order from President Donald Trump](#) directing the release of UAP-related government files.

BREAKING: President Trump announces he will be directing the Secretary of War and other agencies to release government files related to 'alien and extraterrestrial life.'

The decision appears to have been sparked by comments made by former President Barack Obama.

“I did not have that on my bingo card at all,” Hegseth said. “We’ve got our people working on it right now.”

He added, “We’re digging in. We’re going to be in full compliance with that executive order, eager to provide that for the president.”

When asked directly whether he believes aliens exist, Hegseth responded, “We’ll see. I get to do the review and find out along with all of you.”

A Time for Discernment

As government officials speak more openly about these phenomena and push for greater disclosure, the moment calls for careful discernment.

The Bible points us to the importance of understanding the times, just as the Sons of Issachar “had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do” (1 Chron. 12:32, MEV). We live in a time marked by rapid revelations and growing uncertainty; wisdom and spiritual clarity remain essential.

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
