

Is This Proof of Jesus' Resurrection? New Shroud of Turin Evidence Revealed

- Pollen embedded in the fibers traces a path from Jerusalem through ancient trade routes into Europe

- The image formation cannot be replicated, even with modern technology
- The wounds on the figure match the Gospel accounts of Jesus' brutal scourging and crucifixion

Marzulli points to all of this as converging evidence. Not coincidence. Not mystery for mystery's sake. Evidence.

A Moment That Changed Everything

Perhaps the most striking idea Marzulli presents is how the image may have formed. He suggests a burst of supernatural energy at the moment of resurrection, what he connects to the "holy fire" seen throughout Scripture. A flash of divine power. A moment where death was defeated and eternity broke into time.

That moment, he argues, left a mark.

Not just on history. On linen.

Is the dramatic rise in demonic oppression, occult practices and spiritual torment a sign of the times?

A growing number of Catholic exorcists are urging the pope to appoint trained practitioners in every diocese as demand for deliverance intensifies worldwide.

In a recent reaction video, deliverance minister Daniel Adams says this surge is not surprising. He says the increase in darkness is leading to a measurable rise in spiritual attacks and in people desperate for freedom.

The Surge in Occult Practices

Adams points to a global explosion in occult activity as a primary driver of demonic oppression. Tarot cards, witchcraft, crystals, psychics and necromancy are becoming mainstream, especially among younger generations.

“People are playing around with more demonic mess than ever before,” Adams says.

He warns that these practices are not harmless trends. They are open doors to spiritual bondage, torment and long-term destruction.

Why Demonic Oppression Is Increasing

Adams connects the rise in oppression directly to increased sin and separation from God. As people move further from truth, they expose themselves to spiritual darkness.

“People are engaging in sin more than ever and it’s causing them to become demonically tormented more than ever,” he says.

This pattern is producing a surge in fear, anxiety and spiritual distress that many cannot explain through natural means.

The Church's Missing Piece

Adams delivers a direct challenge to modern churches. He says many congregations are preaching messages but failing to address spiritual bondage.

"Some people are so trapped they don't know what to do. They go to church, hear a good message, worship and leave and they stay the same," he says.

Without deliverance ministry, people remain oppressed even while sitting in pews.

Deliverance Is Not Optional

Adams makes it clear that casting out demons is a core part of the Gospel. He points to the ministry of Jesus, where deliverance was central rather than secondary.

"One-third of Jesus's ministry was casting out demons. So we all should be doing it as Christians," he says.

He emphasizes that authority over demonic forces is not reserved for a select few. It belongs to every believer through Jesus Christ.

A Global Spiritual Crisis

The call from exorcists for more trained practitioners reflects a deeper reality. This is not confined to one denomination. It is a global spiritual crisis.

Adams says the spirit realm is intensifying in its interaction with the natural world, bringing increased oppression, torment and desperation.

“Oppression is getting more real. The spirit realm is colliding with this world like never before,” he says.

The Danger of Silence

Ignoring the demonic has consequences. Adams warns that when the Church fails to respond, people turn to counterfeit solutions in the occult.

“If we don’t help them as a church, they’re going to go look for occult power. They’re going to look for the counterfeit,” he says.

This only deepens bondage and accelerates spiritual destruction.

The Call to Rise in Authority

Adams issues a direct call to believers. The answer is not fear. The answer is authority, truth and the power of the Holy Spirit.

“We need real people doing real God things in these last days,” he says.

He urges Christians to step into deliverance ministry, share the Gospel and confront darkness with the authority of Jesus Christ.

‘Very Real Threat’: Congress Pushes Pentagon to Release UFO Videos

Doesn't it seem like disclosure events and statements about UFOs have increased exponentially in recent years? What was once dismissed as a fringe conspiracy is now being openly discussed at the highest levels of government, and lawmakers are pressing for answers.

Members of Congress are now demanding the release of dozens of classified videos involving unidentified anomalous phenomena,

raising fresh concerns about national security and transparency.

Lawmakers Push for Transparency

Republican Rep. Anna Paulina Luna has issued a firm deadline of April 14, 2026, for federal agencies to turn over 46 specific UAP videos, many of which were recorded by military personnel.

“The lack of disclosure regarding the very real threat posed by UAPs in and around US restricted airspace is concerning,” Luna said.

She added, “The presence of UAPs in and around the sensitive airspaces of US military installations poses a threat to the security of the armed forces and their readiness.”

Luna also criticized the government’s response to inquiries, stating that the Task Force has found responses from the All-domain Anomaly Resolution Office to be “less than adequate.”

In a separate statement, she emphasized, “The continued lack of transparency surrounding these anomalies and the potential national security threat they pose is troubling.”

Military Encounters Raise Alarms

The requested footage reportedly includes encounters with spherical, cigar-shaped and “Tic Tac”-like objects seen over war zones, oceans and restricted airspace.

Some of the videos show objects operating near U.S. bases,

warships and training zones, with multiple instances of high-speed movements and coordinated activity.

Officials are increasingly concerned these objects may be conducting surveillance or testing U.S. defenses, posing risks to both pilots and military operations.

Pentagon Responds to Disclosure Push

The push for transparency follows an executive order from President Donald Trump directing the release of UAP-related government files.

BREAKING: President Trump announces he will be directing the Secretary of War and other agencies to release government files related to 'alien and extraterrestrial life.'

The decision appears to have been sparked by comments made by former President Barack Obama.

Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth confirmed the Department of War is working to comply.

"I did not have that on my bingo card at all," Hegseth said. "We've got our people working on it right now."

He added, "We're digging in. We're going to be in full compliance with that executive order, eager to provide that for the president."

When asked directly whether he believes aliens exist, Hegseth responded, "We'll see. I get to do the review and find out

along with all of you.”

A Time for Discernment

As government officials speak more openly about these phenomena and push for greater disclosure, the moment calls for careful discernment.

The Bible points us to the importance of understanding the times, just as the Sons of Issachar “had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do” (1 Chron. 12:32, MEV). We live in a time marked by rapid revelations and growing uncertainty; wisdom and spiritual clarity remain essential.

Storms have a way of exposing fear, uncertainty and need. Yet Scripture and lived experience continue to point to a deeper truth. God does not abandon His people in difficult seasons. He sustains them, provides for them and speaks to them even in the middle of chaos.

Alwyn Uys recently shared a prophetic message rooted in a simple but powerful moment during a snowstorm. As he watched birds search for food in harsh conditions, he saw more than survival. He saw a picture of God's faithfulness.

"This was a clear prophetic message that the Lord was speaking through this moment that even despite the storm, despite the uncertainty, despite what is happening all around you, that God is still taking care of you," Uys said. "God still has your provision and your livelihood upon his heart."

He pointed to Romans 1:20, declaring that God is always revealing Himself through creation. "We have no excuse to say that God doesn't exist, that God doesn't speak to us, that God isn't revealing himself to us; it's all around us," he said.

Uys anchored his message in the words of Jesus from Matthew 6, where Christ calls attention to the birds of the air. "Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns. Yet your heavenly father feeds them. Are you not more valuable than what they are?"

The message is clear. If God provides for creation, He will provide for His people. No storm overrides His care.

Uys declared that many are facing situations that appear

impossible, where provision feels out of reach and the path forward is unclear. Yet God is moving. "That God is about to step in," he said. "This will be a great testimony of the goodness, mercy and grace of God upon your life."

He spoke directly to those struggling financially, urging them to remain confident in God's provision. "God has taken care of you and he has not forgotten about you specifically with financial needs, specifically with provision," he said.

He also challenged believers to sharpen their awareness of God's voice. "God is not silent. God loves you. He's not hiding himself from you," Uys said, encouraging time in Scripture and stillness before the Lord.

The storm may rage, but it does not define the outcome. The same God who feeds the birds is actively sustaining us. What looks like lack will become provision. What feels like pressure will become testimony. And in every season, God remains faithful, present and fully committed to care for us as we trust in Him.

Why the World's Major Faiths Are All Talking About the End Times

The Bible is the foundation of the Christian faith and has no equal. It has fundamentally altered human history, shaping nations, laws and lives for generations. Written across centuries, it speaks with a unified authority that continues to stand apart from every other text. One example ties “Genesis 2:9, which describes the Tree of Life in Eden, to Revelation 22:2, where the symbol reappears in the Bible’s final vision of paradise.” Another connects “Exodus 12, describing the Passover lamb, to John 1:29, where Jesus is referred to as the ‘Lamb of God.’”

Prophecy and fulfillment are also unmistakable connections. “Isaiah 7:14” is linked to “Matthew 1:23,” connecting the promise of a virgin-born child to the birth of Jesus centuries later. The suffering servant described in Isaiah is brought into full view in the Gospels, as “Isaiah 53” is cross-referenced with “John 19, detailing the crucifixion of Jesus.”

The connections extend even further, and could fill the pages of a book.

What makes this even more striking is the scope of Scripture itself. The Bible was written by more than 40 authors over roughly 1,500 years, across three continents and in three languages. Yet the report notes that these connections link passages across vast distances of time and culture, revealing what many describe as “remarkable internal consistency.”

Pastor Tony Walliser captured the significance of this reality, saying, “You go wow, it must have had a major, amazing general editor, yeah, it did: God.”

For generations, these cross-references have appeared in the margins of study Bibles, guiding readers through the depth of Scripture. This project brings them into full view, revealing a structure that is both intricate and unified. The report explains that the goal was to reveal “the depth and complexity of scripture in a visually striking format,” allowing viewers to see both the full scope and the detailed connections.
