

Historic Angelus Temple and Dream Center Split After 25-Year Partnership

A serious issue is spreading through the body of Christ. Offense and accusation are dividing believers and weakening churches. This is not a personality issue. It is spiritual warfare.

Landon Schott, senior-lead pastor of Mercy Culture, identifies the source clearly: "I saw the spirit of offense going rampant in the body of Christ." The attack is intentional and it is already inside the church.

Dishonor Removes Spiritual Authority

Dishonor is not a small matter. It separates believers from God's authority and protection.

"Every time you engage in dishonor, it causes you to walk out from spiritual authority and it causes you to lose your fear of the Lord," Schott said. "Dishonoring people will never honor God."

Honor is defined as assigning heaven's value to people. It keeps believers aligned with God. Dishonor does the opposite.

"Dishonor welcomes the demonic just like worship welcomes the Holy Spirit," Schott said.

This is why many believers feel resistance in their spiritual lives. The issue is not always external pressure. It is internal posture.

Dishonor Stops the Move of God

Scripture shows what dishonor produces.

In Jesus' hometown, miracles were limited because of how people treated Him. "He could not do mighty works there" (Mark 6:5). The issue was not ability. It was dishonor.

"Where there is dishonor, there will be no miracles," Schott said.

Numbers 12 gives another example. Miriam spoke against Moses with a critical spirit. God responded, and she was struck with leprosy (Num. 12:10).

This situation was not about sin or doctrine. It was rooted in preference.

"How many ministries are destroyed over people's personal preferences?" Schott said.

Five Ways to Live Out Honor

Schott lays out practical ways to walk in honor:

1. Honor God with your money

Giving and stewardship confront the pull of mammon (Matt. 6:24). Honor in finances reflects trust in God.

2. Honor God with your body

Purity resists lust and perversion. "Your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit" (1 Cor. 6:19).

3. Honor God with your worship

What you go to first reveals what you value. Honor places God first (Ps. 29:2).

4. Honor God in your marriage

Faithfulness guards against sexual sin. “Let marriage be held in honor” (Heb. 13:4).

5. **Honor spiritual authority**

Respecting leadership protects against offense and preserves covering (1 Tim. 5:17).

The Issue Is Already in the Church

The greatest threat is not outside pressure. It is dishonor within the church.

“You have to leave the presence of God to dishonor,” Schott said. “But honor keeps you in the presence of God or keeps you in the protection of God.”

This battle is active now. Honor determines whether a believer walks in authority or steps out from it.

Honor is not optional. It is how the battle is fought.

The Line Between the Prophetic and the Occult

Uys draws a sharp and necessary distinction that many ignore.

“If you look at the occult, they also can get accurate information about people, but that’s where it stops.”

Accuracy alone is not proof of truth. Psychics, tarot readers and other occult practices may access information, but they cannot produce anything redemptive. They do not point people to Jesus or align with the will of God.

“The enemy cannot create something new. He can only counterfeit.”

True prophecy carries the heart of the Father. It reveals not just information, but purpose, direction and redemption.

“What good is it if it doesn’t point back to Jesus?”

Why Discernment Matters More Than Ever

Uys makes it clear that the responsibility does not fall solely on the person giving a prophetic word. The burden is also on the one receiving it.

“We have to test the prophetic word.”

That testing starts with Scripture.

“Nothing goes above the Word of God. No prophetic voice, no prophecy, nothing can go above the Word of God. Nothing may contradict the Word of God.”

From there, believers must rely on the Holy Spirit and wise counsel. A lack of discernment opens the door to confusion, manipulation and spiritual error.

Hearing God in a Noisy World

One of the most practical parts of the conversation centers on how to actually hear God’s voice.

Uys compares it to tuning a radio. God is speaking, but many are not tuned in.

The solution is not complicated, but it is costly. It requires a life set apart.

Being mindful of what you watch, listen to and engage with matters. The noise of the world dulls spiritual sensitivity, while holiness sharpens it.

“Be holy as I am holy.”

This is not about performance. It is about positioning yourself to hear clearly.

Prophetic but Misunderstood

Uys also addresses a reality many overlook: prophetic people often feel out of place early on.

“Most prophetic people do have a little bit of weirdness in them.”

That “weirdness” is often unrefined sensitivity. Without guidance, it can feel overwhelming. With maturity, it becomes a powerful tool in the hands of God.

Not everything revealed needs to be shared. Growth in the prophetic includes learning restraint, interpretation and timing.

Massive Boom Shakes Ohio as Meteor Blazes Through Daylight Sky: Is This a Warning of Coming Judgment?

A rare celestial event shook Ohio, but the spiritual implications are impossible to ignore.

A massive boom that rattled homes across northeast Ohio and echoed into neighboring states was confirmed to be caused by a meteor streaking through the daytime sky. According to a New York Post report, “a massive boom that shook northeast Ohio and was reportedly heard as far away as New York was the result of a rare daytime meteor.”

The fireball appeared just before 9 a.m., with witnesses describing a shocking display in broad daylight. One motorist said, “I’ve never seen anything like that on such a bright day.”

Residents reported the blast was strong enough to shake houses and knock pictures from the walls. Meteorologist Jeff Tanchak explained the force behind the event, stating the boom came from the meteor breaking the sound barrier, meaning it was traveling at least 767 mph.

A Sign in the Heavens

Scripture makes clear that signs in the heavens are not random. Throughout the Bible, celestial events precede moments of judgment, warning and divine intervention. What unfolded over Ohio may not have been just a scientific anomaly. It may have been a signal.

This event comes after Ohio voters passed Issue 1 in Nov. 2023, embedding abortion rights directly into the state constitution. The measure legalized the shedding of innocent blood, a sin that has historically brought God's judgment upon nations and peoples.

The timing is unmistakable. A state that once stood firmly in conservative alignment has now codified policies that stand in direct rebellion to God's law.

And let's not forget former Gov. John Kasich's actions.

In Dec. 2016, Kasich vetoed the heartbeat bill that would have protected unborn life once a heartbeat is detected, choosing instead to sign a weaker 20-week ban. He repeated that decision in 2018, blocking another attempt to advance stronger protections. Those choices set a precedent in Ohio, opening the door for the erosion of pro-life laws and paving the way for what would eventually become Issue 1.

A State at a Crossroads

Ohio has long been a political stronghold for President Donald Trump, who carried the state decisively in three consecutive elections. In 2016, Trump won Ohio with 51% of the vote compared to 43% for Hillary Clinton. In 2020, he expanded that margin, securing 53% to 45% over Joe Biden. In 2024, Trump

dominated again, taking 55% to 44% against Kamala Harris.

Despite that consistent conservative dominance, the passage of Issue 1 signals a deep fracture within the state.

Now, Ohio faces a critical gubernatorial race that will define its future direction. Democrat Dr. Amy Acton, who led the state's COVID-19 response, is positioned as a leading contender. Her record is clear. She enforced sweeping lockdown measures, backed the closure of businesses, restricted gatherings and supported the shutdown of schools across the state. Her leadership represents a model of government control that directly suppresses individual liberty.

Her opponent, Vivek Ramaswamy, has secured Trump's endorsement but has struggled to unify the Republican base after a series of missteps and controversial remarks. Even with national support, the path forward remains uncertain.

Judgment or Warning

The convergence of these events is striking. A state that overwhelmingly supports conservative leadership has simultaneously embraced policies that defy biblical truth. A sudden and violent sign appears in the heavens. Political instability follows.

This raises a necessary question. Is Ohio entering a period of divine judgment?

The Bible establishes a consistent pattern. When a people turn away from God's commands and embrace the destruction of innocent life, consequences follow. Just look at the nation of Israel. The legalization and protection of abortion stands as one of the clearest violations of God's law.

The meteor over Ohio serves as a visible reminder that nothing escapes His attention.

Ohio now stands at a crossroads. What comes next will reveal whether it chooses repentance or continues down a path that invites judgment.

Time will tell.
