

Tucker Carlson Tells Megyn Kelly a Demonic Entity Attacked Him in His Sleep

Former Fox News host Tucker Carlson told Megyn Kelly during her “Megyn Kelly Live” show that he believes he was physically assaulted by a supernatural entity.

[Carlson explained](#) that he usually went to sleep at home with his wife and their dogs in bed. He said he woke up suddenly at 2:30 a.m. with no ability to breathe. “I wake up at 2:30 in the morning and I couldn’t breathe at all,” he said. “It wasn’t like I was apnea or strong as I could not breathe.”

Carlson said he got out of bed and walked outside trying to regain oxygen. That is when he said physical pain struck him. “All of a sudden I have this horrible pain underneath my arms like on the side of my chest, like bad, I thought I’d been ripped with a knife or something. Very intense,” he said.

Tucker Carlson says he was violently attacked by a demon:

*“I couldn’t breathe. So I get up, I stand in the doorway of our bedroom, and I’m like, wow, I’m dying... I had this horrible pain underneath my arms, like on the side of my chest...I flip on the light, and I have claw marks...

When he turned the bedroom light on he said he saw literal claw marks carved into his ribs. Carlson described them as bleeding scratches. "I flip on the light, I have claw marks on right and left side of my ribs and they are bleeding. There literally claw marks, four, on either side" he said. He said he tried to check the marks himself. "I put fingers in them, [they] don't fit" he said.

After that Carlson said something in his spirit shifted. "Then I have this crazy intense desire to read the Bible, so I read the Bible and I pass out in 2 minutes," he said.

He claims the wounds were still there the next morning. "I woke next morning, man, did I have a wild dream. Then I saw blood on the sheets. I go to the bathroom, and I have these bloody marks," he said. His wife told him she thought it was supernatural. "My wife goes 'I think you were attacked by some supernatural being'" Carlson told Kelly.

Carlson said he tried to be rational about the encounter but had no other natural explanation. "I was like trying to be logical about it," he said. He also said that when he mentioned it to a producer, he was shocked when the producer did not seem surprised.

Carlson's story highlights [a reality many Christians talk about](#) but rarely hear high-profile people publicly acknowledge. Spiritual warfare is real.

describes not just a nightmare or a feeling but a physical manifestation of something he believes was demonic.

The Economic Times (ET) recently published another piece on this bizarre interstellar object. The headline alone tells you how strange this is getting. An object from beyond our solar system is now being linked, by some people online, to the Great Pyramids of Giza.

The new ET report highlights that one of the latest images of 3I/ATLAS shows seven distinct jets coming off the body of the object.

2.8 million kilometers of jets coming off something moving through our solar system.

[Pastor Kap Chatfield](#) said he sees this pattern clearly in Scripture. He said, "I want to not just be successful. I want to be influential. I want to be somebody that people want to follow." His model comes from Daniel chapter 1. Daniel did not

blend into Babylon. He became a voice inside of Babylon.

Here are the five keys Chatfield draws out of that chapter:

1. Be fit

Physical discipline matters. “Your appearance can either work for you or against you,” he said. Daniel 1 shows the young men selected had to be strong, healthy and presentable. How you carry yourself communicates something before you speak a word.

2. Be sharp

Stay a student. “If you want to be somebody of continual influence in the culture, you’ve got to keep on learning.” Daniel and his friends were not narrow. They were “well versed in every branch of learning.” They were intellectually developed.

3. Be engaged

You can learn the culture you are called to reach. “If you want to be a person of influence, you need to be engaged in the culture.” Daniel and his friends were trained in the “language and literature of Babylon.” They understood the ideas and conversations of their environment.

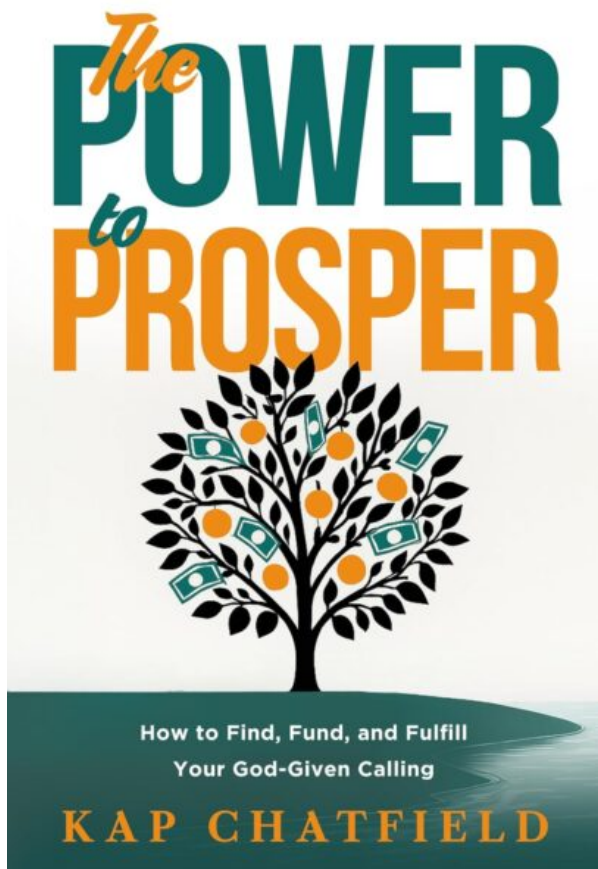
4. Be competent

Excellence creates credibility. “If you want to be somebody that people take seriously, you’ve got to be competent.” Daniel and his friends were “10 times more capable.” They were not just nice men. They were exceptional at what they did.

5. Be holy

This is the part that separates real influence from temporary hype. “If you want to be someone of influence, you’ve got to be somebody of character.” Daniel refused the king’s food because it violated his conscience. His

holiness became the foundation of his impact.

DHS Biometric Expansion Could Pave the Way for Global Digital ID System

Back in May 2017, the Department of Homeland Security quietly signaled where this was going.

John F. Kelly wrote that the agency wanted to expand biometrics beyond fingerprints at the border. The memo literally stated DHS needed to “expand the age of the population subject to biometric collection” and directed the agency to “enhance biometric collection practices” and [“identify opportunities to enhance biometric collection policies.”](#)

At the time, it sounded like a theory. The language was couched in “could,” “should” and “opportunities.”

Now look where we are in 2025.

Homeland Security is no longer suggesting a new biometric authority.

They are proposing [a mandatory biometric identity system](#) to track people “throughout the immigration lifecycle.”

This new expansion according to the latest report would allow DHS to require biometrics:

- from U.S. citizens
- from children under 14
- from anyone connected to an immigrant application
- from anyone encountered or arrested in immigration context

And it would allow the agency to collect:

- face scans
- voice prints
- iris and eye scans
- palm and fingerprints
- signatures
- DNA

They are even proposing continuous vetting which means repeated biometric screening until naturalization.

That is not border control. That is lifecycle control.

And the article notes the agency plans to reuse and share this biometric data across federal, state and local law enforcement and the intelligence community.

We went from “collect prints at the border” to full-spectrum multimodal biometrics on citizens and children inside the country in eight years.

The original memo was the foot-in-the-door. This new rule is the door being removed from its hinges.

How is this a step toward a global digital ID system?

Big government never rolls this back. Once a biometric system exists for one group, it becomes the default expectation for every group. Once identity is required to interact with systems, biometrics become the system.

This is how it escalates:

- The body becomes the credential
- Identification becomes the barrier to access
- Access gets tied to compliance
- Disobedience becomes grounds for exclusion

That is a social credit architecture.

And the Bible describes a final world order where participation in the economy is conditional on identity verification. Revelation 13 does not describe the method. [It describes the outcome.](#) No buying or selling without the system.

A global digital ID platform is the only realistic modern method that can make that possible.

This new Homeland Security rule is one more brick in that

wall.

It normalizes the idea that data must be harvested at every stage of human movement and status. Not just at the border. Not just at airports. Not just for criminals. But continuously.

Continuous vetting is the quiet phrase that changes everything.

Charles Capps' 1978 Prophecy Is Exploding Back Into the

Spotlight

A nearly 50-year-old prophecy from the late Bible teacher Charles Capps is gaining renewed attention.

On Feb. 1, 1978, Capps delivered what he called a word from the Lord that a “financial inversion” was coming. In that prophecy, Capps said the world’s economy would rise and fall. Still, believers who obeyed Scripture, walked by faith and sowed financially would see an unusual transfer of resources into the work of the Gospel. He spoke of vast “reservoirs of wealth” stored up by the wicked and said the time would come when those reservoirs would be “drained into the Gospel of Jesus Christ” so that “there shall be no lack in the kingdom.”

At the time, the prophecy was treated as interesting but distant. [Capps died in 2014](#), and the word was archived among many of his teachings on faith, confession and biblical prosperity. Today, the 1978 word is being pulled forward again as many believers ask where this season is heading.

Bishop Alan DiDio says the timing Capps foresaw is not generic or timeless but tied to real economic cycles. In a recent teaching, he said he believes a new reshaping is forming as we approach 2026. He points to AI disruption, looming layoffs and what he believes could become the popping of an AI investment bubble. DiDio says this convergence may serve as the delivery system for the “financial inversion” Capps described.

Satan's Yearly Trick: Convincing Christians Halloween Is Harmless

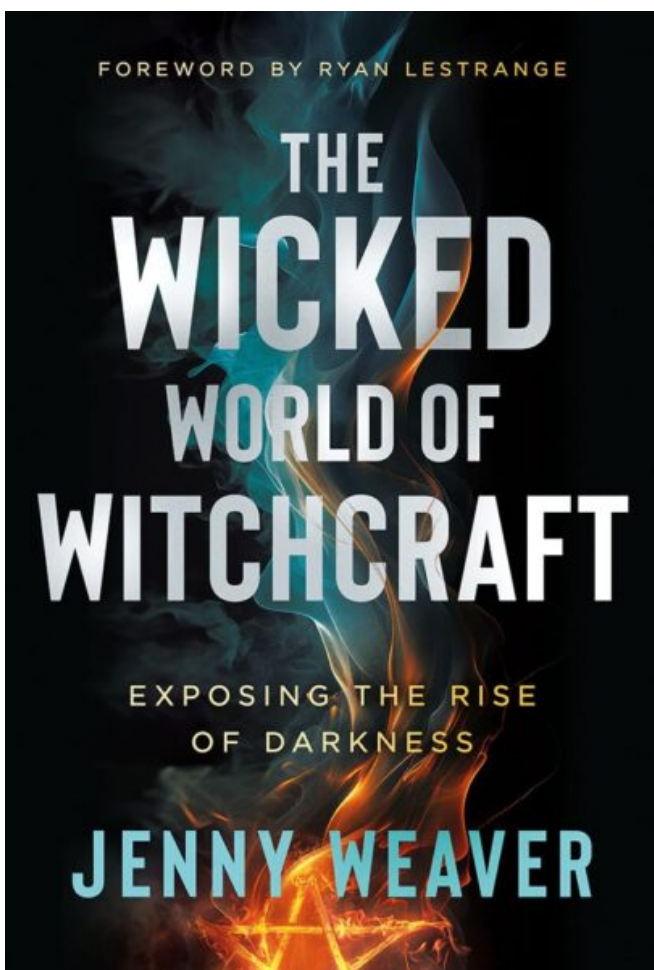
Two former occultists say what many call a night of fun and candy is actually a celebration of darkness that Christians should avoid entirely.

Ex-witch Jenny Weaver says [Halloween is a spiritual trap](#). “What parents think is a one-day thing—it’s not,” she said. “It’s an open door that allows children, teens and even adults to go deeper into darkness.”

Weaver traced the holiday back to Samhain, an ancient festival honoring the dead. “That’s where costumes came from,” she said. “People disguised themselves so spirits wouldn’t take revenge on them. Everything about it was tied to death and evil.”

She warned that attempts to make Halloween “Christian-friendly” don’t erase its roots. “You can’t change the origins,” she said. “You can’t take something birthed in darkness and make it holy.”

Former warlock John Ramirez agreed, saying Christians cannot celebrate Halloween in any form without inviting spiritual danger. "It boggles my mind how you can have a one-night stand with the devil and then say you love Jesus," he said.

Ramirez said even church events like trunk-or-treats and harvest festivals are compromises. "You're still celebrating a demonic holiday," he said. "Like the devil's going to stay out of your church that day? When you celebrate Halloween, the devil lives in your church."

He recalled the words of Anton LaVey, founder of the Church of Satan, who once thanked Christian parents for letting their kids celebrate Halloween. "That's a devil worshiper thanking you," Ramirez said. "You're putting your kids on the demonic altar."

Both warn that what seems like innocent [participation gives Satan a foothold](#). "Adam and Eve disobeyed God one time and lost paradise," Ramirez said. "When you celebrate Halloween, you sign legal rights over to the devil."

Weaver says the battle is spiritual, not cultural. "Satan doesn't take a nap," she said. "We need to stop trying to be cool parents and start protecting our families."

National Prayer Altar Returns to Washington, Calling Americans to Renew Trust in God

Christian leaders are preparing to gather at the Museum of the Bible for the annual National Prayer Altar, an event that unites believers in prayer [for the nation's spiritual renewal](#). He said society has embraced ideologies that place personal pleasure and humanism above faith in God, warning that the nation must turn from self-focus and return to reverence for the Lord.

Ward and Robertson discussed the divisive influence of social media, saying many Americans are growing weary of digital isolation. That exhaustion, Ward said, is driving more people back to in-person worship and community gatherings, opening the door for greater revival within the church.

Drawing parallels to the Civil War era, Ward recalled how national division once led preachers and political leaders [to call for repentance](#). He believes America faces a similar moral and spiritual test today and must once again depend on divine intervention rather than political solutions.

Ward emphasized that the kingdom of God is not advanced

through government systems but through the gospel of Jesus Christ. True change, he said, begins in the hearts of individuals. He also underscored the urgency of spreading the gospel globally as nations like India and China impose tighter restrictions on Christianity.

America's prosperity, Ward said, is a product of God's grace and its longstanding support of Israel. Maintaining that covenant relationship, he added, is key to preserving divine favor.

Justin Bieber Opens Up About His Faith, Says Jesus Is 'the King of Hollywood'

Pop star Justin Bieber is opening up about his Christian faith in a recent livestream that's gaining widespread attention. In the candid discussion, the 31-year-old singer shared his

thoughts on God, morality, and what it means to be a man trying to live with purpose and integrity.

The livestream, clips of which were shared on YouTube, shows Bieber sitting over fast-food takeout with friends [as he speaks about the Bible and life's challenges](#). "It rains on the just and the unjust," he said, emphasizing that everyone faces hardship regardless of who they are. "Bad ____ happens to everybody, you know? Bad ____ happens to good people, good ____ happens to bad people. ... Everyone's on the same equal playing ground, and that's hard for people to really comprehend or want to digest because I think it makes us feel better to be like, 'Well, I'm better than this guy.'"

"I don't want to think I'm better than anybody 'cause you don't know what someone's born into," he added.

The conversation also turned to morality and personal responsibility. Bieber referenced Jesus' Sermon on the Mount when talking about purity and self-control. "If you even think of a woman with lust it's the same thing as actually doing it; committing adultery or whatever," he said, referring to Matthew 5:28. "So if it even just crosses your mind for one second, if you treat a man with anger or something, it's the same as killing a man, Scripture says."

Bieber also spoke about God's mercy and how many people struggle to feel loved or worthy. "Someone's probably struggling with their own self-image of like, 'You know, am I worthy of love?' And God says you are," he said. "You know what I mean? I don't make the rules. But Jesus says that, and I really believe Him."

He went on to describe [his belief in Christ's sacrifice in vivid terms](#). "He put on skin and bones and came onto this Earth as a person, as a human," Bieber said. "Lived a sinless life so that we don't have to be focusing on sin because none of us can do the right thing all the time. And then He literally went to the cross, was lashed, whipped, made fun of, then He rose on the third day defeating death, Hell, and the grave. Now we get to live free and rather than focus on sin, now we can focus on Jesus, the wonderful savior. And I really think He's the king of the world, bro. He's the king of Hollywood. He's the king of L.A., bro. He's the king."

Later in the discussion, Bieber reflected on his approach to relationships and business, saying he's no longer interested in partnerships built solely on mutual benefit. "That's what, like, business is these days," he said. "It's just like, 'I scratch your back, you scratch mine.' And you guys, it's not based on love."

When asked how he first learned about his faith, Bieber recalled memorizing Bible verses as a child because his mother rewarded him for doing so. "I would get a gold star. So I would just memorize it," he said. Although he doesn't always remember the exact reference, Bieber said the words return to him when he needs them most. "The Scripture says, 'I will remind you the things that I've told you' and He just reminds me," he said. "Because He knows what I want. He knows that I

want this for other people. So I think He puts it to my brain.”
