

# Perry Stone's Bold Message About Slander Is Shaking the Church

A growing number of professing Christians no longer see God's commands as essential, instead choosing lifestyles that contradict Scripture.

In a recent message, Christian content creator Nik Keswani directly addressed this trend, warning that many who claim to follow Jesus are deceived about their spiritual condition.

"My goal as a servant of Jesus Christ is not to please people, but to please God," Keswani said.

Citing a Barna Research study, he pointed out that "out of the 2.4 billion professing Christians in the world, only 30% of them have said that they're born again, and only 3% of them have said that they have an actual biblical worldview."

His conclusion: "This means that 97% of professing Christians will perish in eternal hellfire."

Keswani rejects the idea that ongoing sin is compatible with a genuine walk with Christ.

“No one born of God makes a practice of sinning,” he quoted from 1 John 3:9. He also criticized emotional approaches to faith that ignore Scripture: “Professing Christians nowadays are being led astray by emotionalism rather than biblical truth.”

He challenged believers to take seriously their obedience to Christ. “It’s time Christians stop treating God as their boyfriend and start revering Him as their sovereign master,” he said. “Is your name written in the book of life? And does God really know your name?”

His message closed with a plea: “Don’t let Satan rob you of your eternal destiny... Enough is enough.”

## **Why Do So Many Christians Still Feel Spiritually Stuck?**

In today’s world of distractions and debates, one of the most overlooked and misunderstood spiritual practices in the body of Christ is praying in the Spirit—often referred to as praying in tongues or in a heavenly language. As Sergio Nazir Chavez points out in a recent video, we should be asking a different kind of question: what if this spiritual gift was never meant to be controversial, but rather a divine

## **Beyond Controversy: A Call to Clarity**

“This is not a denominational thing—it is a spiritual thing,” says Chavez.

These words cut through the confusion and invite us to see tongues not as a divisive doctrine but as a unifying force empowered by the Holy Spirit. The gift of tongues, according to Scripture, transcends theological boundaries and invites believers into a supernatural experience that brings refreshment, power, and revelation.

The foundation of praying in tongues stretches back to the Old Testament. Isaiah 28:11–12 speaks of “stammering lips and another tongue,” a prophecy later echoed by Paul in 1 Corinthians 14:21 to emphasize the significance of spiritual language. Far from a novelty of the early church, tongues are a fulfillment of divine prophecy—one that connects the old and new covenants in profound unity.

## **Tongues: A Divine Weapon of Unity and Power**

From the tower of Babel to the upper room at Pentecost, the Bible traces the movement of language as both a divider and a unifier. In the Old Testament, God confounded human language to halt prideful ambition. But in Acts 2, when the Holy Spirit descended, language became the tool of unity once again.

“Now what was divided in the Old Testament we see now the Holy Spirit is unifying... He came to unify us in the Spirit, unify us in one language, one blood, one Resurrection, one God,” Chavez says.

Praying in tongues is more than a mystical expression—it is a divine weapon. It tears down walls of division, builds up the inner man and aligns the believer with heaven’s agenda. The Day of Pentecost was not a one-time event; it was a model for divine outpouring that continues today.

## **From the Outer Gate to the Holy of Holies**

To understand the depth of this gift, Chavez draws a powerful comparison to the Tabernacle of Moses. The believer’s journey in Christ mirrors the movement from the outer court to the holy place, and ultimately to the Holy of Holies. Praying in tongues is not the destination—it’s a doorway. It helps the believer move from justification to sanctification and into deeper glorification with Christ.

“You can have people that just pray in tongues but not have the full understanding of what they’re doing,” he warns. Tongues are not a badge of spirituality, but a means to press into greater depths of God’s presence and power.

## **The True Evidence of the Spirit**

While tongues are often pointed to as evidence of the baptism of the Holy Spirit, Chavez makes an important clarification: the true sign of a Spirit-filled life is not merely speaking in tongues, but bearing the fruit of the Spirit. “You can have tongues, but if you have no love, then it is in vain. The Bible does talk about you can have the gifts but if you don’t

have love then it is not in void, it is empty, it is just as clashing symbols.”

Love, joy, peace, patience—these are the hallmarks of transformation, and tongues are meant to strengthen the believer toward this end.

## **Praying in the Spirit: Your Spiritual Gym**

When a believer prays in tongues, it is spiritual exercise. “He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself,” the Bible says in 1 Corinthians 14:4. The word “edify” means to build up—like constructing a building on the foundation of Christ. Just as the body grows stronger through resistance and repetition, the spirit grows stronger through praying in the heavenly language. It is nourishment for the inner man, power for the journey, and alignment with heaven.

## **A Present Truth for a Prophetic People**

This gift is not just for the early church or past revivals. “It’s supposed to go beyond the former moves,” Chavez declares. God is pouring out His Spirit in these last days in unprecedented ways. The gift of tongues is not a relic of Pentecost, but a present reality for every believer willing to embrace it.

foundational biblical principles: courtship, modesty and male headship. He walks viewers through how biblical courtship gave way to emotionally driven dating, modesty was rebranded as shame and male leadership was reframed as misogyny.

“The veil is not a sign of modesty or spirituality. It is a symbol of segregation,” he quotes feminist Germaine Greer, showing how such views led to veiling and spiritual symbols being cast aside. “What was once courtship rooted in covenant became emotion rooted in confusion. What was once modesty became offensive. What was once male headship became outdated,” Keswani laments.

He calls believers back to the “ancient paths” of God’s truth—not to return to tradition for its own sake, but to rediscover divine order and spiritual rest.

“What I just saw in the comments of this post blew my mind. This lady said she had her phone in, was about to make the call to have an abortion when she saw a clip that Isaiah posted about abortion, and it changed her mind and her baby is now about to turn two years old.”

Now, Coston is hoping that more people of faith will take Saldivar’s lead and boldly share the message of the gospel across social media platforms.

What kind of music are you letting into your life? In a bold question-and-answer segment, Isaiah Saldivar challenges believers to take a hard look at what they're listening to—and whether it lines up with their walk with God.

“I don't see what justification we have listening to ungodly music,” he says. “Guard your heart. That's not a dating verse. Your heart is your thoughts, your intentions, your will, your desires.”

With music playing such a powerful role in shaping our thoughts, he emphasizes the importance of guarding our “ear gates” and “eye gates.” Saldivar asks, “If I’m allowing pollution in... what do you want stuck in your head? Ungodly music or the Word of God?”

He further points out that many popular songs today glorify darkness: “Music about perversion, music about murder, music about drugs... it’s all sinful. It’s all dark. It’s all glorifying darkness.”

The message isn’t about being religious or extreme—it’s about being intentional. “I just think we need to be careful. What am I letting in? Is it edifying? Is it serving the Lord?” asks Saldivar.

In a recent teaching, Bible scholar John Barnett laid out two compelling views on the prophetic “battle of Gog” and its placement within end-times chronology.

“There are two places that this battle of Mog could be,” Barnett said. “One could be right here, uh, right at the front end that launches the tribulation... the other half believe it’s right here, this Jerusalem attack, and it’s right at the end of the tribulation time.”

Either way, Barnett emphasized, what we do know is clear: “God is headed toward this, the Second Coming of Christ and the

launching of Israel as the center of the world and the beacon of hope.”

Barnett pointed to real-world developments aligning with the prophetic timeline found in Ezekiel 38–39.

“Yesterday, Iran displayed the largest collection of armed drones they’ve ever seen in a military parade,” he said. “They are working as fast as possible to develop an atomic bomb.”

With Russia, China and Iran increasingly aligned, Barnett warned, “It could be very soon this whole thing is going to ignite and God is going to climactically intervene and save Israel.”

Regardless of when Ezekiel’s war occurs, Barnett concluded with a sobering reminder: “The next prophetic event for us that we’re looking for is Jesus to return, the judgment seat of Christ.”
