Nashville, Tenn., pastor Peter Wilson's *Plan B: What Do You Do When God Doesn't Show Up the Way You Thought He Would?* is a book whose title speaks for itself. The call is to be faithful even when it seems He is far away, Wilson says. Plan B offers encouragement to those struggling to redeem their decisions or who are facing doubts about their direction in life. Wilson's pastoral heart speaks clearly, pointing to the cross of Christ as the ultimate solution of love and hope.
