Acknowledging God's existence is only part of the equation. If that's all you are drawing from, you'll only go so far. Something else must be activated.

Genuine faith possesses a heart-changing revelation about the

nature and character of God. It comprehends that God is truly a rewarder.

Engagements that are not rooted in the kindness and benevolence of God will always be constrained.
