Pagani points out that people sometimes avoid getting the advice or opinion about the person they are dating from a spiritual mentor because they already know that they will be advised to step away from their boyfriend or girlfriend.

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"My heart [is] breaking for people and I go, 'why [did] you marry them then? Why are you marrying them? Because you never asked apostle's advice because you knew I was going to tell you no,'" Pagani says.

He also points out that people will then say that the Lord told them someone was the one for them, even speaking in tongues, which makes it impossible for others to say anything differently.

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“...cause now I’m blaspheming the Holy Spirit according to you,” Pagani says. “‘The Lord said marry this person,’ I’m like, they don’t even really go to church.”
