

Atheists Crucify Mayor Who Gives God Official Ownership Over Town

"I'm going to step on a lot of people's toes but there's not but one God and, that one God, to Him be the glory," says

Price. "There's no other way; there's no other God. There are a lot of religions out there but only one God."

It's no surprise that Hemant Mehta, the so-called friendly atheist, mocked Price for his bold stance for God. Mehta assured his readers that God "has better things to do" than take over our cities. Of course, Mehta doesn't know God and cannot pretend to speak for Him—but he does seem to speak for millions of atheists.
