

Ben Shapiro Calls Out Boston Children's Hospital for Transgender Surgeries

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In recent months, Boston Children's Hospital implemented the first transgender surgery unit for children nationwide. Since opening the new service, they have announced that 1,000 families have used the program to perform transgender treatments on underage youth.

On their website, the hospital paints the Gender Multispecialty Service (GeMS) as a beautiful model of love and support to the kids receiving life-altering and often irreversible treatments. Some of these treatments include, genital, chest and face surgeries on minors.

In a video posted on his YouTube, Ben Shapiro calls out the hospital for the roughly 300 surgeries they have already performed in the last four years.
