

Bishop Goes From Church to Charts With New Music

Bishop George Davis' song "Morning Time" is quickly moving up the national Billboard recording industry charts. The pastor of Impact Church in Jacksonville, Florida, recorded the album out a keen desire to penetrate "every area of culture" to share the gospel with this generation.
