

# **BREAKING NEWS: School Shooting in Nashville leaves 2 Dead, 2 Injured**

In a tragic incident on Jan. 22, 2025, Antioch High School in Nashville, Tennessee, became the scene of a devastating shooting. A 17-year-old male student opened fire in the school cafeteria, fatally wounding a female student and injuring another, before turning the gun on himself. The injured student suffered a graze wound, while another required treatment for an eye injury at Vanderbilt Pediatrics.
