

Bruce Jenner and the 2 Thessalonians Delusion

In recent weeks the media has gone out of its way to applaud the sad and tragic story of Bruce Jenner's journey from adulation, as a gold medal Olympian, to emasculation. What causes a man with a physique like Hercules to seek the body and mind of a woman, only to end up with neither one?
