

Bruce Jenner's Daughter Kendall: I 100 Percent Identify as Christian

Model and reality TV star Kendall Jenner says, "I 100 percent identify as Christian" in a recent post on her website, according to *People*.

The daughter of Bruce and Kris Jenner told her followers her family raised her to believe in God, even sisters Kourtney, Kim and Khloe Kardashian.

Jenner says she was also taught "to believe that He has a plan," which pulls from Jeremiah 29:11. "Even though I'm more spiritual than religious, I pray every night and I 100 percent identify as Christian," Jenner says.

The faith of the reality stars stirs speculation whenever it hits headlines—whether it's Bruce, who now identifies as Caitlyn, who attended Pastor Ed Young's father's megachurch, or Khloe Kardashian tweeting Bible verses.
