And thou shalt hang up the veil under the the veil shall divide unto you between the holy place and the most holy.

—Exodus 26:33

The Ark of the Covenant was also called the Ark of the Presence, for the presence of God was with it. God instructed Moses to keep the Ark of the Covenant in a room separated from the people.

Those who do not partake of the new covenant do not understand the character of God. They may even believe He is cruel and unyielding, indifferent and unconcerned. But a veil of sin separates them from God.

Under the new covenant, the veil has been torn, and God's presence is fully available to us (Matthew 27:51).
