All the sudden, my jeep started shaking and then died. ... And it just felt that Satan was doing everything he could that day to keep me from getting to my co-writer’s house.”

When Hope finally arrived at her destination, she and her co-writer were able to quickly finish the song.

“I can see how Satan was trying to keep that song from being written,” she says.
