

Dolly Parton, 'Safety,' 'Infidel' Win Big During Movieguide's Movies That Inspire

Safety was selected as the Best Movie for Families of 2020. *Greyhound* was selected as the Best Movie for Mature Audiences of 2020. *Infidel* won the Faith and Freedom® Award, and the Epiphany Prize® for Most Inspiring Movie of 2020 went to *I Still Believe*.
