

Donald Trump Compares Himself to Beloved Evangelist Billy Graham

Donald Trump told Alabamians his favorite tome is the Good Book and he knows how Billy Graham felt.

With a turnout of 30,000, Trump told attendees, “Now I know how the great Billy Graham felt.”

For comparison, Graham’s last rally boasted a whopping 242,000 people.

But the politician didn’t stop with the similarities at the numbers: “What’s my favorite book? The Bible! The Bible. ... We take the Bible all the way,” Trump said, according to a *Washington Post* reporter tweet.
