

Donald Trump's Event Just Scored 2 Big Names

It's very likely FOX News didn't see this one coming.

"A Baptist, a Catholic and a businessman walk onto a private university campus" might sound like the setup for a bizarre joke, but in the chaotic final days of the race of the Iowa Republican Caucus, it's more like a headline. And, no, the headline isn't running on *The Onion* anytime soon.

Donald Trump's "alternative event" to Thursday night's FOX News Republican Presidential Debate just added two big names: former Arkansas Gov. Mike Huckabee and former U.S. Sen. Rick Santorum.
