

# Donald Trump's 'Huge' Night In New Hampshire

Thursday evening, Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump received a key endorsement for the upcoming New Hampshire Primary.

Following a private meeting between the GOP front-runner and the New England Police Benevolent Association, the organization officially endorsed his candidacy.
