

‘Dyed in the Wool’ Conservative Governor Endorses Marco Rubio

Kansas Gov. Sam Brownback, who previously served 15 years in the U.S. Senate, is arguably one of the most conservative governors in the country, and a strong defender of the unborn, limited government and traditional values.

Monday afternoon, he became one of U.S. Sen. Marco Rubio’s biggest fans. In an endorsement statement released by the Rubio campaign, Brownback said the Florida senator was the “true conservative who can unite the party and defeat Hillary Clinton or Bernie Sanders” in the November general election.

“In the past, conservatives have been forced to make a choice between their head and their hearts,” he said. “This year, we are fortunate to not have to make that choice.
