

Faith Leaders Remind Believers That God Is Still in Control After Election Results

With the call of Joe Biden's election to the presidency of the United States Saturday morning, leaders in the faith community chimed in on Saturday to give believers hope and encouragement for the immediate future of the country.

This comes after more than three days of uncertainty following the general election on Tuesday. Several states continued to be contested over the past few days until the official call was made Saturday for Biden.

On Twitter, Franklin Graham called for believers to pray and quoted Psalm 57:5 (ESV), which says, "Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; Let your glory be above all the earth."

Graham's father, Billy, would have been 102 years old Saturday. He died in February 2018.

In this time of disappointment for many conservatives, author,

speaker and conservative radio host Eric Metaxas concisely reminded believers of a staunch biblical principle.
