

Franklin Graham's Response to Woke Bishop's Trump Rebuke

Reverend Franklin Graham criticized the statements of the leader of the Episcopal Diocese of Washington, Bishop Mariann Budde.

Graham told Newsmax that Budde was “wrong” to politicize the inaugural prayer service. “That was really a national forum, a national stage pulpit that she was standing in. And for her to use that for her own political agenda was wrong,” he said.

Discussing the bishop's statements on immigration and LGBTQ children, Graham said that while “people suffered a lot to come here illegally,” illegal immigrants “need to go back and come in legally.

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“It has nothing to do with compassion. It's to do what's right to do. If you want to have compassion, then have the law the same for everybody,” he stated. “Don't have a law for one group and another law for another group. No, it's one law fits all.”

Speaking to Piers Morgan, Graham emphasized that the bishop “took advantage of that national pulpit for her own personal agenda – and that was wrong.”

“Because the president talks about having a new policy ... of two gender, male or female, but somehow the LGBTQ community is going to be maligned somehow. That's just not true,” Graham said. “She said they're going to feel unsafe. Why? Nothing's changed. They still have their freedoms and their rights as we all do.”
