

‘God and Donald Trump’ Author Stephen E. Strang: Ridiculing People of Faith Like Mike Pence Will Only Alienate Millions of Americans

“To make matters worse, if the FBI were not so intent on bringing down President Trump, they would not have neglected to follow up on Nikolas Cruz leads,” Strang added. “The result is that 17 people died in Florida. This is an abomination, and

there is absolutely no excuse for it.”
