

Guilty But Blameless

Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. **—Hebrews 10:19-22**

In the Old Testament, covenant partners would plant a tree and sprinkle it with blood as a memorial to their covenant union.
