Our conferences frequently welcome international visitors and prominent individuals who travel across the world to receive prophetic direction and impartation, under an atmosphere of open heavens.

Throughout my years of ministry—especially prophetic ministry—I began to understand the certain realms in which those who occupy the “office of the prophet” would prophesy.

I believe this is crucial for the current modern-day prophetic movement.
