

How This Ancient Jewish Rite Reveals the Major Events of Our Time

More than a month after its release, readers and reviewers are still talking about *The Oracle*, the epic new hit by *New York Times*' bestselling author Jonathan Cahn.

Cahn brings to life many fascinating topics in *The Oracle: The Jubilean Mysteries Unveiled*, among them being how an ancient Jewish rite reveals the major events of our time.

Leviticus 25:10 says: "You shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land to all the inhabitants. It shall be a Jubilee to you, and each of you shall return to his possession, and every person shall return to his family."

Could an ancient law from the Bible be determining the events of our times? In the Jewish tradition, the Jubilee Year is a year of rest, restoration and resetting. Agricultural work is put on hold so laborers can enjoy their produce (Lev. 25:12). Everyone returns to their land and their family (v. 10). Debts are taken care of in a way that is fair and not oppressive.

The Year of the Jubilee is also said to have prophetic implications. *The Oracle* unpacks the history of Israel alongside "Jubilean mysteries" regarding what the future holds for the Jewish people.

The Jubilee, the year of restoration, would take place every 50 years. As Cahn reveals in *The Oracle*, one can pinpoint the key prophetic events of modern times by the Jubilean calendar.

"Going as far back as 1867, with an event involving Mark Twain, and then to 1917 and the First World War, to 1967 and

the Six-Day War, and as recently as 2017 and an act involving Donald Trump, the mystery has manifested like clockwork,” Cahn says. “It can only be explained by the reality of the God of Scripture.”

Though what’s revealed in *The Oracle* is real, as with Cahn’s other bestsellers, *The Harbinger* and *The Book of Mysteries*, everything is explained through a narrative, as Cahn takes readers on a journey to find the man called “the Oracle.” One by one, each of the Jubilean mysteries is revealed through the giving of a vision to a traveler. “The Oracle” uncovers the mysteries of “The Stranger,” “The Lost City,” “The Land of Seven Wells,” “The Birds,” “The Number of the End,” “The Man in the Black Robe,” “The Prophet’s Song,” “The Man with the Measuring Line,” “The Matrix of Years,” “The Day of the Lions,” “The Awakening of the Dragon” and many more.

The Oracle promises to reveal the “mystery of the ages”—and of Donald Trump, the White House and more. Cahn also opens up ancient mysteries that lie behind the current events and leaders of modern times. Throughout the book, the reader is taken on a journey of angels and prophetic revelations waiting to be discovered behind each of the seven doors—the ancient secrets that lie behind the world-changing events of modern times—and events that are yet to come.

Jonathan Cahn caused a worldwide stir with the release of his explosive first book, *The Harbinger*, which became an instant New York Times’ bestseller and brought him to national and international prominence. His next three books were also New York Times’ bestsellers: *The Mystery of the Shemitah*, *The Book of Mysteries* and *The Paradigm*.
