

How Your Spiritual Fragrance Is a Sweet Aroma to God

She shares about the beautiful journey the Lord took her on through the Song of Songs, teaching her about the significance of the different fragrances. As a candle-maker, this spoke profoundly to her heart, and now she reveals incredible revelation about our fragrance to God.

Pauline says, “Jesus is the most exciting person that I know,” and you too are invited into this intimate relationship with Him where He shares the mysteries of Scripture with you and the secrets of His heart. The life of the bride is living heart-to-heart with Jesus in the secret place, where all of His virtues are available to you because you are one.
