

MAGA Rally Saturday: It's Time for Christians and Republicans to Get Vocal

As the president prepares for his second term with initiatives on religious freedom, protecting life and peace in the Middle East and more, two forces are hindering his efforts.

One hindrance is the RINO, "Republicans in name only."

The name represents shameful Republicans who control the statehouses of Michigan, Arizona, Georgia and Pennsylvania. They are weak, compromised and facing the unabashed anger of the "forgotten men and women" who are sick and tired of their lack of principles.
