When Jordan Feliz’s hit single, “The River,” reached Christian radio, it was the culmination of a long musical journey for him. “I want people to know when they listen to the music that, first off, I want them to feel uplifted, and then I want them to understand no matter where they are, what they’ve done, what they’re going to do, there is absolutely nothing that would separate them from the love of Christ.”
