

Kansas GOP Leader Named Ted Cruz State Chair

Kansas State Rep. Kahrs (R-Wichita), who has been active in Kansas politics for more than 25 years serving in various offices within the Kansas Republican Party, has been named the Kansas State Chair for the Ted Cruz presidential campaign.

“This is an extremely critical election for conservatives,” Kahrs said. “We need a leader that will stand up and fight the Washington establishment to restore the power back to the people and stand up for conservative values.
